


PHILOSOPHY

HISTORY

PAST CHAMPIONS

In 1927, members from Delmarva's golf clubs felt there was a need to form an organization that would share and handle the common interests of all clubs, arrange schedules to avoid conflicts and generally promote the game of golf on Delmarva. Team matches were being played at the various golf/country clubs on an increasing basis and this prompted the need for an organization of some sort. This new organization was to be called "The Peninsula Golf League".

DPGA GOLF COUPON BOOKS NOW AVAILABLE!

The Delmarva Peninsula Golf Association has announced that their 2011-2012 Golf Discount Coupon Book is now available for local golfers to take advantage. The books sell for **\$40** and all the proceeds go into the DPGA scholarship program. The coupon book generally pays for itself after several uses and golfers will continue to save on their golfing from now

until the end of next year.

This year we have 36 different eastern shore golf courses participating in our coupon book. The coupon books are good through December 2012 and can be purchased at Nutters Crossing, Horsebridge Golf Courses in Salisbury, MD, Great Hope Golf Course in Westover, MD and Hog Neck golf course in Easton, MD and Sussex Pines CC in Georgetown, DE. They can also be purchased by contacting Jack Slayton at 410-749-6685.

Each year the DPGA gives out between six to ten \$2000 scholarships to eligible high school senior golfers to help them with their college expenses. If the students keep up their grades, the scholarships are renewed for up to 4 years. The sale of the books is the main fund raiser for the scholarship program. More information on the scholarship program is available at your local DPGA golf club or on the DPGA website at http://home.comcast.net/~dpga-golf

Along with the scholarship program, the DPGA runs junior golf tournaments during the summer which ends with the top four in each age bracket participating in a tournament of champions.


GOLF FITNESS - STRETCHES



This month I want to revisit a very common problem not unique to the golfer but to people in general – back pain. We all know there are multiple causes, some more serious than others, such as herniated disc, etc. Treatments are varied, ranging from rest, medication, physical therapy, etc. up to surgery. For the golfer, modalities to improve the problem can be as simple as using proper back mechanics

when lifting your bag to slowing down your backswing, using a longer putter and so on. However, I want to address another treatment option – exercise.



There was an article in the health section of the Washington Post that discussed this. The bottom line was strengthening the muscles of the "core" - the back and abdomen - can help to improve it and prevent future disabling episodes. The stronger these muscles, the more they can help stabilize the spine, build stamina, reduce the need for pain meds, etc. We have talked about these exercise programs in the past. They include yoga, pilates, aerobic training and water aerobics. The aforementioned article describes a study where yoga and aerobic strength training programs were compared to a self-care program guided by a book. After 26 weeks, the yoga and exercise groups reported more pain relief and return of back function than those doing self-care. Similar studies were done with pilates and aerobic training such as treadmills, stationary cycling and stair climbing. Water aerobics, of course, shifts weight away from the back so strengthening can occur for those who experience too much pain with treadmills, etc.

The bottom line, if you consider these options, is to find a quality fitness facility and hook up with a trainer experienced in these techniques. And let me emphasize experienced. Anyone these days can go online and obtain a piece of paper that states they are "certified". I discovered you can go online and become a minister in a short period of time. You have to do your research; as a physician and gym owner our trainers are rigorously screened. They don't just possess a piece of paper. Would you entrust your spiritual needs to an online minister?

I figured that this topic would fit in nicely with the great holiday spirit... you know...bowling over some lady in a mad rush to get the last dozen Pro VI's at Ruddo's on Christmas eve, or shoving some guy out of the way so you can grab your wife the Taylor Made driver she's always wanted (men's shaft and flex...oh, and she doesn't even play...but a great stocking stuffer). You get the idea. Peace on earth, good will toward men (as long as it does not interfere with my pursuit of buying the best game that I can). Anyway, the knock down (or punch shot...not even going there...yet), is a very handy shot to learn for all levels of golfers. The dynamics involved encourage good impact positions in your regular golf swing. So learn this shot, and practice it with regularity (see your pharmacist).

The set up is key: first, with an iron (start with a short iron, 9 or PW) choke down on the grip ~1" and play the ball a few inches farther back in your stance than normal (with a short iron, 2 or 3 inches back of center). Next, allow your hands to naturally fall slightly forward of your pant zipper (the extra angle on the shaft will encourage this). Finally, put more weight on your forward foot (about 60-70%), and now that you're perfectly uncomfortable, we will try to swing.

Important things to forget (errrr...remember): Do not try to hit this shot far. Think 20 or 30 yards shorter with any given club...we do not want to force distance with this shot. You are trying to hit this shot low in order to control distance, or to keep the ball out of the wind. This is a control shot...not a power shot...so control your movements and effort.

We are going to take a shorter swing than normal. Practice taking the club ³/₄ of the way back on the back-swing, and ³/₄ the way through on the forward swing (like a pitch shot). Again, we are NOT trying to hit this shot full distance, so keep it short and simple. When practicing this shot, set up as described, then control your ³/₄ swing motion with good rhythm just looking to make solid contact. Make sure that you keep your weight moving forward to the finish, and do not be surprised if you lose your balance toward your target (aka Gary Player). This is O.K. at first. You are just not used to shifting that much weight forward (too many holiday sweets). Remember to hold your finish to ³/₄ as well. If you are finishing full, you are over accelerating on the forward swing, or trying to lift. Allow the club to strike the ball as it is still descending. If you practice this shot regularly, you will improve not only your ball sticking, your distance control (assuming you pay attention to how far you hit each club with this technique), and your trajectory control (look under "t" in the dictionary), but you will also add a new weapon into your formidable arsenal...this one for pin point distance control with short irons, or for "knocking down" flags on blustery days.

Well, maybe not in the case where I will be sending him a 1099 or a W2 but he has helped me in many situations. How many times have you been cruising along on the course and you come around the corner to find 2 or 3 groups waiting to tee off? Your round comes to a screaming halt and you completely lose your rhythm. Or how many times have you been playing along nicely, only to hit the 3 or 4 shots in a row completely terrible? In the matter of a moment your swing felt like an unfolding lawn chair, awkward and stuck. How did the same person hit such completely different shots? Here is a quick way to get your swing back on track. Think of the name Freddie Couples during your golf swing. Start thinking the "Freddie" on the take away and the "Couples" to start the down swing. This timing mechanism will hopefully slow down your take away and help you find your rhythm. A slower take away will lead to a better transition at the top of the back swing and normally allow you to make better, more consistent contact. I have heard of many other teachers trying to count to

simulate the rhythm of the golf swing, but the 4 syllable name seems to fit the swing better. Other names that work like Dustin Johnson and Gary Player are fine, but Freddie Couples works for me. Not only does the flow of his name mimic a beautiful rhythm, but the way he carries himself on the golf course and the way he swings the club exude a smooth, rhythmic



sequence. Legendary Teaching Professional Peter Kostis used a similar method when working with Kevin Costner before filming the movie "Tin Cup" teaching him rhythm. You can hear it when Cup was hitting balls saying "dollar bills". He used a three syllable name because he sawed off his swing during the follow through. He said it was because he played in the winds of west Texas. I suggest trying this tip on the range the next time you go to hit balls. You may find that this can take away mechanical swing thoughts and allow you to hit the ball more smoothly.

You Know the Drill by Steve Menz Stay Sharp for just 50 cents!

Place 2 quarters about an inch and a half apart lying flat on the floor. Move back about a foot and try to putt through the quarters without touching them. If you happen to hit one of the coins it will make a sound. You may find that you hit one coin more than the other which will help you understand a putting stroke flaw. Once you have become proficient at this step, move the quarters closer together. Still rolling it between them without touching either coin, move the putt length back another foot. You will come to find how important it is to get the ball rolling straight right off the putter



face. Repeating in the winter your best in Year! Now this drill every few days will help you putt 2012! Happy New you know the drill!



SHORE UP WITH THE GAME COACH WHAT DRIVES YOU?

CARSON LOVETT, MA, SPORT PSYCHOLOGY

As we swing into the 2012 golf season and renew the quest to reach our athletic peak, identifying the individual motivating factors that lead each of us to compete may prove to be a valuable tool for maximizing performance. Sport Psychologists and Consultants have found success applying psychological Need Theories of Intrinsic Motivation to competitive sports, and the results suggest an important link between basic human needs and an athlete's performance tendencies.

In a recent case study, a Consultant working with a struggling professional athlete related a popular Need Theory to the athlete's affinity for action and discovered that the athlete had an elevated need to be accepted. While discussing the finding with the athlete's Game Coach and recognizing the negative effect of disparagement, the Consultant suggested that the Coach develop an approach that would replace his propensity for displaying dissatisfaction while the athlete is competing with calculated post-game constructive criticism. The seemingly elementary intervention led to a marked improvement, increased awareness and ultimately a championship. The close examination of the individual personality yielded the key to unlocking the athlete's potential.

Golfers and their Game Coaches are always seeking an edge, over the course, the competition or the combination. For the first-timer and the seasoned professional, it appears that an ideal place to begin this new year may be Within. Research suggests that by determining the intrinsic factors that motivate the individual, the golfer and those charged with aiding performance enhancement may foster a better understanding of how the athlete will respond to conditioning, thus providing an appropriate framework for goal achievement.



UMES PGA GOLF MANAGEMENT FACULTY STRESSES THE IMPORTANCE OF GOLF 2.0





While I've done a fair share of testing over the last two months, I'm going to put aside my review until the next issue. Your right, as an American adult, to enjoy a wellcrafted cigar is under assault by people radio host Cigar Dave calls the Pleasure Police, in our government. They apparently think they know better than you, how you

should enjoy your leisure time.

Earlier this year, the state of Maryland made it illegal for Marylanders to purchase cigars, a legal product, online. After receiving a very loud negative response, it has temporarily allowed online sales to continue. An even larger threat looms with the Food and Drug Administration. The FDA has posted their intent

to regulate cigars in the Federal Register. Some of the measures FDA could consider, include:

A ban on walk-in humidors, mail-order cigar sales, on all flavored cigars, that are enjoyed by legal-age adults. Ban on cigar



events where free cigars (samples) could be available to adults. Limits on cigar marketing and advertising; Imposition of new 'user fees' [tax] on cigars, to finance regulations; Limits on special release and small-batch cigars, due to mandates that cigar blends be submitted to FDA for pre-approval before release; Limits on nicotine levels on cigars to near zero, severely impacting the flavor of cigars; Ban on marketing cigar merchandise.

The Cigar Rights of America is an organization that is fighting for our right to enjoy a cigar. I urge you to go to their website HYPERLINK "http://www.cigarrights.org" www.cigarrights.org and sign the petition in support of H.R. 1639 / S. 1461 - Traditional Cigar Manufacturing and Small Business Jobs Preservation Act. Follow the links and contact your representatives in Congress and let them know how you feel. If you don't become active in the fight for your rights, they will quietly disappear.

Also, while I enjoy finding deals on cigars online, I also try to support my local tobacconist as much as possible. They can really help you find the right cigar to maximize your smoking enjoyment. They can also help to keep your right to enjoy cigars!

Walking on the Moving Sidewalk

In order to have a simple, functional golf swing you should have as few moving parts as is necessary. Any extra motion has to be timed perfectly to be in a good position through impact. The modern swing utilizes the core muscle groups to create the motion. You set your hands, arms and club in a good position for impact at address, make two turns and away it goes.

At many airports they have moving sidewalks. Basically they're escalators moving horizontally instead of vertically. While riding on one you can choose to let it carry you and your luggage or you can continue walking and cover more ground more quickly.

We use our hands to perform most of our tasks throughout the day. So, it's natural for them to want to help out in the golf swing. Walking on the moving sidewalk is what I call the act of pulling with your hands as you turn away from the ball. If you set your hands, arms and club in a good position in front of you at address and you pull them as you turn away, you are actually pulling them out of position. You must then find a way to put them back into position before impact. Also, if your hands are taking the initiative in starting the motion, it's unlikely they'll re-


linquish control to the core muscles at any time during the swing.


Instead, let your hands and arms be passengers on the moving sidewalk. You want the turning inner-body to carry your arms away without pulling. This way the arms, hands and club stay in position, in front of your chest. Also, because you are using a different muscle group, your core muscles, the hands and arms can remain in a lighter tension level.


To get a feel for this, take your stance. Lift your arms straight up in front of you. Let a breath out to relax your arms and turn away from the target keeping your arms in front of your chest. Do this without changing the tension level in the arms. Then try and feel the same thing while making a golf swing.



YOUR PATH TO PAR Richard Robinson- Instructor The Original Golf School



At first glance, my photo with a statue of Ben Hogan may seem a bit out of context on the Eastern Shore. The closest Hogan ever came to the Eastern Shore was on his historic quest for the US Open at Merion. The photo is a memento of a special personal experience, but it is also reminder that Hogan is the greatest golfer of all time.

Who says? Jack Nicklaus, "Hogan was the best shot maker I ever saw." Tiger Woods, "Hogan owned his swing; I want to achieve that ability." Gary Player." Ben Hogan is still the best player I ever saw". This is high praise from all time great champions, whose records seem to contradict their opinions. Nicklaus and Woods won more majors and more tour events. Player matched Hogan's major total and won more tournaments worldwide. So why such adulation and respect? Arguments can and have been made for several players being equal or better than Hogan, using all sorts of statistical comparisons. Even contemporary rivals Sam Snead and Byron Nelson frequently bested Hogan in head-to-head competition. The three were so close in ability that they became known as the American Triumvirate but such data misses the point. The undisputable facts are that Hogan had the least physical talent, the most disadvantaged circumstances in his youth, and the most dramatic physical and emotional challenges of any of the golfing greats. Despite these obstacles, he became the ultimate self-made champion, failing more than succeeding; a decade on the pro tour without a victory, but in the end reaching a pinnacle of performance and skill that will forever be unsurpassed. A persistent pursuit of perfection lead Hogan to create principles of preparation and technique that form the path followed by virtually every successful tournament player of the last half century. More significantly, Hogan blazed the trail for all who seek proficiency in golf at any age or ability level. Hogan's technical aspects of the golf swing are described in his book The Five Fundamentals. However, his core values were as important as his technique:

- Define and understand your physical limitations.
- •Adopt reliable techniques compatible with your physical abilities.
- Practice correct techniques until success becomes habitual.
- Understand your temperament.
- Concentrate on your goals without distraction.

Self-awareness is a key element to golfing achievement. Hogan exemplified the value of understanding yourself as the first step to improvement. In anticipation of the 2012 season, consider applying these principles as you set your personal goals.




