The 2014 Toyota Cup featured 14 teams made up of golf professionals representing clubs throughout the Eastern Shore. This season the 14 teams were broken into 2 divisions. Teams would play each member of their division for a total of six regular season matches,

in four-ball match play format. In

each match, teams were awarded 1 point for winning the front nine, 1 point for winning the back, and 2 points for the overall winner. Leading the season in points was the defending Toyota Cup Champion, Bear Trap. Along the way, Bear Trap won 5 of their 6 matches for a total of 19.5 points, earning the No. 1 seed in the playoffs and home field advantage until the finals. Heritage Shores also managed to finish their season winning 5 of 6 matches for a total of 18.5 points, giving them the No. 2 seed as well as home field advantage until the finals. Wild Quail G & CC won 5 of their 6 matches with 17.5 points and earned the No. 3 seed and a first round home match. Ocean City GC was seeded No. 4, having accumulated 16 points. The other four teams to make the playoffs were Kings Creek CC, Hooper's Landing, Talbot CC, and Glen Riddle GC.


The No. 8 seed Glen Riddle traveled up to Bear Trap and gave the defending champions a run for their

money. Down 4 with just 6 holes to play Glen Riddle managed to fight their way back but fell just short losing to Bear Trap 1 down. Heritage Shores needed all 18 holes to put away No. 7 seed Talbot Country Club, winning that first round match 1 up. Third seeded Wild Quail was down 1 with just 2 holes to go against Hooper's Landing, but went on to win the final two holes for a 1 up victory. The last guarterfinal match turned out to be a

Neither team took advantage of the Par 5 11th and hole #12 was also halved in pars. On the always tricky par 3 #13, Brooks hit the best shot of the bunch and was able to make the birdie putt to square the match once again. Bear Trap got themselves into trouble off the tee on #14. Heritage Shores took advantage and went on to win the hole with a par. Heritage Shores once again found themselves in the lead with just 4 holes to play. All four players made par on the difficult par 3 15th and the match remained in Heritage Shores' favor. On the 16th hole, Heritage Shores' Massey got on the green in regulation. Then Michael Rushin, with few options for his second shot, played a tremendous shot off the cart path to within 15 feet of the hole. After Brooks' par was conceded, Michael's birdie putt horseshoed around the cup and came out. With their teammates in trouble off the 17th tee, Neil and

Will both played their second shots from the center of the fairway. From just off the green, Neil knocked it close and his par was conceded. Will, with a putt for birdie to close out the match, just missed on the low side. That left just one hole which had to be won by Bear Trap to extend the match. Both Brooks and Will found the fairway off the tee on #18. Michael, taking a very aggressive line, also found the fairway, putting himself in great position to attack the 18th pin. Neil's tee shot found the water which left Bear Trap in a tough spot. Brooks, playing first, hit his on a great line to the difficult pin position and ran just off the green. Will was next to play and hit a gorgeous approach right at the pin, finishing 20 feet from the hole. Michael, with just a lob wedge for his approach, hit his ball just outside of Will's. With the match on the line, Michael made an aggressive effort, just missing his birdie putt. Will, needing just two putts to win, missed the birdie putt but the par was conceded and Heritage Shores was once again the champion of the Toyota Cup!





#### You Can'T Do Both

If you begin this game as a child, I believe you have a distinct advantage. As a child you don't concern yourself with any thoughts of what could happen. You simply step up to the ball and wail away at it. If it goes, it goes. If it doesn't go, you wail away again. If you start to play golf as an adult, it tends to be a bit more complicated. The worst thing that can happen is that you miss the ball completely while others are watching. With that in mind, the main objective becomes make sure you hit it!


So, after trying on your own to play golf while making sure you hit it, you decide to take lessons and get better. You go to the pro and he or she begins to work with you on how you create a more functional swing motion. You try and try, but sometimes it seems to be difficult to do what they say. The problem is you're trying to do what they want you to do and make sure you hit it.

My regular clients have heard this from me often, "you can't do both'. You can only think of one thing at a time. So you can't focus on the new move and then at the moment of impact make sure you hit it. Ultimately, what you're trying to learn when you take lessons is how to move your body to swing your arms, while they're holding a club. You are learning how to create a movement of your muscle groups in a sequence. An efficient, consistent golf swing is moving only what you need to move, only when you need to move

it. If you do this, you will hit the ball every time. Any additional movements complicate the swing. If you are throwing make sure you hit it into the mix, you will most likely move, or stop moving, something else.

So while we are in the winter weather, this is a great time to work on keeping your mind on your body motion and leaving the ball out of the picture. Take your stance and fold your arms tight across your chest. Get your knees flexed and set firmly. From inside, as close to the spine as possible, twist the upper body away from the target side. Feel the resistance in the lower body's connection to the ground. You are only moving the mass of ribs and lungs around the spine, but your hips will move a bit from your upper body's movement. Then begin rotating the hips toward the target side letting them carry the upper body through to the finish. Those two moves are what create your motion and you mind must engrain that image and feeling. Next while now holding a club (check to make sure no furniture, walls or spouses are in the way) close your eyes and feel the same two moves in super slow motion. This will help you get in touch with what your body needs to do to create a simple, repeatable golf swing and help to get make sure you hit it out of your mind.

Golfer Charlie Sifford had the rare honor of being recognized last month on a national stage - and meeting a new generation preparing to follow the cart path he blazed more than a half century ago.

The first African-American to play on the PGA tour after the PGA abolished its "Caucasian Only" clause in 1961, Sifford, received the Presidential Medal of Freedom during a White House ceremony Monday. At the U.S. Capitol a few hours later, the University of Maryland Eastern Shore hosted a reception in his honor to express its appreciation to the civil rights pioneer.

UMES is the nation's lone historically black institution that offers a PGAgolf accredited management degree. UMES President Juliette B. Bell called the presidential medal presentation "a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for our university to showcase the next generation of minority golfers and highlight the Continuing importance of broadening the diversity of those playing and working in the business of golf."

The event, emceed by UMES junior Patrick Harris and Scott Walker of the Golf Channel, attracted more than 150 guests, including Wendell J. Haskins, PGA Senior Director for Diversity and Multicultural Initiatives, Fred Thompson, Jr., chief administrative officer of Thompson Hospitality, a PGA diversity supplier, and Roland S. Martin, TV host and news commentator.

Among the members of Congress paying tribute to Sifford were Rep. Elijah Cummings, D-Md., who helped arrange the event, and Rep. James Clyburn, D-S.C, who led a bi-partisan effort lobbying President Obama to honor Sifford.

"You have been what I call the Jackie Robinson of golf. I feel very strongly about that," Clyburn said to Sifford sitting a few feet away.



proudest moments as a member of Congress."

Regarded by peers during his prime as championship-level admirers competitor, pointed out Sifford broke down barriers without a support network common in team sports. Testimonials during the reception also offered portrayed him as a popular and respected gentleman away from the course.

Among those taking in the tributes was UMES junior Norman Blanco. "I really enjoyed hearing all those stories," Blanco said. "It was an eye-opener. It makes me believe I can do much more with my life."

When Sifford was Blanco's age, he played golf in an era of segregation,

PGA member Anthony Stepney, coordinator of UMES' diversity and inclusion initiatives in the golf industry, challenged reception attendees to draw inspiration from accomplishments Sifford's actively encourage minorities and women to take up the game.

vice president, said "our students, most of whom are minorities and women, are pursuing a dream of working in the golf industry. We have an obligation to let them know of the impact of Charlie Sifford and remain committed to perpetuating his legacy of diversity and inclusion.




### UMES takes third place in the 2014 PGA Jones Cup

The UMES PGA Golf Management Program sent five students to PGA Village in Port St. Lucie, Florida to compete on the Wannamaker Course in the 13th Annual PGA Jones Cup. Team captain, Jesse Williams, said "This competition is designed just like a regular college tournament where each PGA Golf Management University sends a team of five and takes the four low scores each round for the overall team total."

The competition was held on November 4-5 and after the first round the UMES team was tied for fifth place out of 19 universities after carding a 313 total. "The best finish we ever had in this competition was a tie for 13th. Our team goal this year was to crack the top 10. 

# establishes GOLF MANAGEMENT SCHOLARSHIP @UNIVERSITY MARYLAND EASTERN SHORE

NEW PARTNERSHIP WILL PROVIDE FIVE-YEAR, \$100,000 SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENT IN THE ONLY PGA GOLF MANAGEMENT PROGRAM AT A HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGE IN THE UNITED STATES

UMES is one of 18 universities in the United States with a PGA-approved Golf Management program and the nation's lone historically black institution awarding a bachelor's degree in that discipline. The Foundation is the philanthropic arm of Caves Valley Golf Club in Owings Mills, Md., which has been selected as a host venue for numerous USGA, LPGA and NCAA events.



Demarkis J. Cooper is the inaugural Caves Valley Scholar, who enrolled this fall in the university's PGA Golf Management program. The Oxon Hill High School graduate was among Maryland's top prep golfers a year ago.

"As we move our program to the forefront of collegiate golf management programs," UMES President Juliette B. Bell said, "our goal is to recruit and enroll the highest caliber student who will represent our university with pride and respect traditions of the game."

The Caves Valley Foundation created the UMES scholarship to reward a deserving student-athlete with a minimum 3.5 high school grade point average, a USGA handicap of 12 or less, outstanding character, integrity and leadership qualities, and who demonstrates a financial need. The recipient must continue meeting those

criteria to remain eligible for the \$100,000 scholarship through  $4\frac{1}{2}$  years of study.

"The mission and accomplishments of the UMES PGA Golf Management Association align perfectly with the Caves Valley Golf Club Foundation's dedication to improving the lives of young people through exposure to golf's customs, traditions and rules of fair play," said Gary Attman, the Foundation's board chair.

The scholarship will cover tuition, room, board, textbooks and other incidental costs for up to 5 years, including a structured internship program designed to provide the student with valuable field experience. Additionally, the Caves Valley Scholar will benefit from the advice and counsel of Caves Valley PGA professionals, staff and members.

The scholarship recipient will have an opportunity to intern at Caves Valley as an undergraduate and will be considered for a post-graduate apprenticeship at the golf club, giving the recipient an opportunity to build a network of professional men and women from around the world.

"We are proud to partner with UMES to expand the reach of the program to offer students of all backgrounds the opportunity to pursue a career in the game of golf," added Attman.

The Caves Valley Golf Club Foundation, Inc. was organized in 1994 for charitable and educational purposes to grant educational scholarships to caddies working at Caves Valley Golf Club. Sources of support for the fund included seed money from the Baltimore business community and donations

from club members and their guests. In 2001, the Foundation expanded its mission to offer scholarships for caddies at other Baltimore-area golf clubs. Its work has continued to evolve with landmark support of the First Tee of Baltimore, and now this new partnership with UMES.

UMES launched its Golf Management curriculum in 2007 and since then every student who successfully completed the program had a job offer at graduation. The PGA Golf Management program is part of the university's Department of Hospitality and Tourism Management.

UMES Golf Management students take a broad spectrum of courses that prepare them for a variety of jobs in and around the sport. Graduates must complete four levels of the PGA Golf Management curriculum, 16 months of internship assignments and pass the PGA Playing Ability Test to qualify for membership in the PGA of America upon eligible employment.

"Given an opportunity," Bell said, "we believe young people who possess the talent and exhibit the values of fair play, integrity and leadership will excel in golf – and in life and inspire other young people to get involved in this great game. We are so very grateful that Caves Valley shares our vision."



One of the things that can hamper anyone's golf game is inflammation of the joints. I am sure you are familiar with all the the common causes (injury, infection, overuse, etc.), but I recently read some data from Mount Sinai School of Medicine that discusses one I hadn't heard about- its called advanced glycation end products (AGEs, for short). To make a long story short they are formed when food of almost any kind (meat, cheese, vegetables – even olive oil) is heated to too high a temp when cooking. When ingested, these particles adhere to many parts of your body, including the brain and joints, where they cause inflammation. They are apparently especially dangerous to people with kidney problems. There are even researchers who feel the presence of these particles may turn out to be the basis of the aging process.

So what might be your defense against these AGEs? Basically it is to lower the cooking temperature of food. Water seems to inhibit their formation, so poaching, stewing, steaming or even boiling proteins (it is the combo of proteins

and sugars in food that are the culprits) are best. Slow cookers fall in this category. If you love to grill meats, you are setting the stage for AGEs. Even cutting most of the fat off a steak, for example, doesn't work, so they feel if you are a steak lover, serving the meat rare to medium-rare, if possible, is better. Also, marinating meat in vinegar or lemon juice before cooking tends to reduce the amount of AGEs produced by heat. Processed foods tend to be bad since manufacturers tend to add AGE-containing flavor enhancers to packaged foods.

Restaurant foods? Fortunately the popularity of the Mediterranean Diet sets the stage for the availability of foods with low AGEs on many restaurant menus. The researchers bottom line? There's no way around it- cooking at high temperature is not so hot for your health – or, ultimately, your golf game.

# SHORE UP Carson Lovett, MA Sport Psychology WITH THE GAME COACH

To kick-start a new year of success 'Touring the Shore', let's revisit one of the most important studies in the short history of Sport Psychology. Researchers investigating elite Sharpshooters in action recorded results that can benefit athletes of all ages and abilities. Sharpshooters, also referred to as Marksmen, maintain a visual focus and a heightened level of attention ideal for measuring the activities of the brain during the completion of a sporting task. The skills required for target shooting allow the athlete to be connected to an EEG that monitors brain activity without interfering with performance, providing a critical and invaluable in-game analysis of the athlete's mental state. The examiners found that expert Marksmen were able to calm the left side of the brain just prior to shot execution; on the contrary, no measurable effect was observed within the right hemisphere. Given that left-brain activity is associated with verbal and analytical functioning while the right-brain is associated with visual and spatial processing, our lesson can be readily applied to the links.

As we grow into well-informed golfers, we rely less on mental chatter. We no longer need to talk ourselves through a shot or question our mechanics. We gain confidence through experience and become better at focusing our attention where it is most needed.

For example, while both Rory McIlroy and I will have an active right-brain before our identical 12-foot putts on 18, during Rory's approach, his left-brain is quiet with a tunnel-vision focus on space and distance. During my amateur approach, I am reviewing the steps of my routine, a mentally verbal and analytical process that increases left-brain activity; and because we have a limited ability to attend to a task, McIlroy sticks it, and until I SHORE UP my game, I wonder.



### YOUR PATH TO PAR

RICHARD ROBINSON, INSTRUCTOR THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL



If the weather outside is frightful at your home course, there are things you can do to keep in touch with your game this winter requiring little space, equipment or time.

Get a grip. Just pick up a club each day and work on developing the correct hand position, finger pressure, and general sensitivity to how the hands feel when correctly placed on the club.

Perfect your pre shot set up routine. The pre shot routine is a transition point between planning and physical execution of the shot.

Make the routine precise and consistent and your shots will be also. Practice a few times each day.

The Ball Box Drill will enable you to feel the relationship of the clubface and shaft, weight distribution, foot pressure and arm movement during take away and through impact. Label one end of a 3 pack ball box as lead end and the opposite side as trail end. Keep the balls in the box so you can feel the weight of resistance. Place the box on the floor and recognize it represents your ball target line or path to the target.

Takeaway: Every great player has emphasized the importance

of a smooth take away the first 10 to 12 inches of the swing. This drill will help you see and feel the correct take away. Using a 6 iron, set up to the box as if making a shot, keep your feet together, touch the back of the club head to the lead end of the box, then move feet to assume a shoulder width stance so the lead edge of the box is centered in your stance. Now begin your take away and simply move your hands so they move over your trail foot, keep the club face square and the club head will move the box straight back. Impact: Assume the same stance but reverse the club position and movement. Touch the clubface to the trail edge of the box square to the "box" target line. Simply move your hands forward over the lead foot dragging the club head along the floor along the target line. Feel the grip lead the shaft angling forward of the box. As you drag the box follow its movement with your trail knee feeling the transition of weight off the trail foot onto the lead foot. Feel the shaft and lead arm form a straight line as hips rotate to the target and your hands move over your lead foot. Feel the trail arm remain slightly flexed. From this position "release" the box by merely extending the right arm to the target bring the shaft parallel to the ground club head toe up.

Two, four, six, eight, do this and you'll be great! Make 9 putts each from distances of 2, 4, 6, and 8 feet. Misses at 2 and 4 feet are bogeys add 1 point per miss. Hole outs from 6 and 8 feet are birdies subtract 1 point for each putt made. 36 total putts. Low score wins. Perfect score -18.

Get the right grip and set up, swing to the target, sink the scoring putts! It will be a great spring in 2015.




## YOU KNOW THE DRILL THE SHOE BOX BY STEVE MENZ = More Power

Why spend money on expensive training aids to make your golf swing better when you probably have items that will help you master the long ball in your own house? Grab an empty shoe box, it has many uses to aid you during practice and won't cost you a cent! You can place the shoe box on its end behind your back leg in line with your calf muscle and make sure it doesn't fall down through out your swing. This will help you keep the flex in your back knee promoting more power. You can also set it on its end outside your front leg by your left ankle (for righties) and make sure you hit the box with your leg before impact for more power! Another great use for an empty shoe box is to place it just outside the golf ball at address, leaving only enough





# PLAYING THE %'s

### MATT REPASS.

In my business I am constantly referring to statistics. I use them to help illustrate points or measure the concern of those I work with most, the retired or soon to be retired American. In addition to statistics, my 29 years of experience in my field provides me a unique insight to people, their shortcomings and the challenges facing them when trying to plan a successful retirement without proper guidance or education. seems funny but explaining how to improve your golf game really doesn't differ much from explaining to the folks I work with the ways on improving their finances; focus on the glaring major statistics and play the percentages.

Watch Golf Channel or read most golf magazines and you will find one glaring statistic worth focusing on if you hope to improve your game in the New Year; 75% of your score comes from shots played inside of 100 yards! Focusing on this stat not only helped my game immensely but is the first thing I tell other golfers when asked how they can improve as I did. The problem is however, those same golf magazines or shows are full of advertisements enticing us to buy the "new hot" drivers to try and get "more yards" off the tee. Go to any practice range and what will you find; most players warming up by busting ball after ball with their driver. Players who I play with regularly and shoot mid to low 70's each round, hit maybe 4 or 5 drivers but most of their attention and practice is focused on scoring clubs, clubs which will be used for shots under 100 yards. Go to a range where you see a pro giving a lesson and observe; their focus is primarily working with scoring clubs. Consequently this alluring advertising and claims of "hot new" and "more yards" diverts your attention from focusing on the part of your game which can really lower your scores.

Get away from the commercials & ads and there's is one enormous piece of advice worth the investment of your hard earned money on every Golf Channel program...."See your local PGA professional for lessons!"

In the financial world the same advertising and claims divert our attention from focusing on overcoming the biggest challenge facing today's retirees. The glaring statistic worth focusing on here is; In an annual survey when asked; "What's Americans greatest fear?" 61% of these people answered "outliving their money." People now fear outliving their money more than dying and more than speaking in public, which commonly placed 1 & 2 atop this list. However, just like ads for "hot new" drivers boast "more yards", financial ads boast similar "hot new" funds or "better returns."

### TOOLS OF THE TRADE

### "MORE POWER? IT'S ALL ABOUT THE BASE!"

It's funny when you hear a song how it can stick in your head. The song "All about the bass" I saw on The Tonight Show starring Jimmy Fallon performed with classroom instruments is one of those songs. Thankfully, it actually helped me think of this article. True power in the golf swing starts at your base - between your feet and the ground. You have probably heard this while watching golf on television, but it is actually a true statement and here is what you can do to make it happen. It's all about the base. Let's examine your foot position and the relationship with your knee position. Foot position at address should be shoulder width with your knees both positioned over your instep or the inside half of your feet. This creates a stable base and promotes great balance. During the backswing focus on keeping your knees inside your feet and making sure the knee elevation remains level. This will make a downward

pressure of your feet against the ground and promote much more power. The space between your knees will not change very much. Some of the power depleting moves I often see include the back knee (right knee for right handed players) will move outside the back foot causing a player to sway or get stuck. Another power loss move I see is when the front knee during the backswing will actually get lower than the back knee. This will cause you to leave too much weight on your front foot throughout the backswing encouraging a reverse pivot. A reverse pivot is when the weight predominately stays on the front foot during the back swing and switches to the back foot during the downswing. This is the opposite move if you want to create more power. So if it is more power and distance you desire, remember it's all about the base, no trouble!

As long as there is no snow on the ground, I still enjoy teeing it up and lighting up a cigar in the wintertime.

While winter presents challenges

with the golf game, I find that it also can affect my cigar enjoyment as well. The cold air seems to diminish the ability to distinguish the subtle nuances of

many cigars. So I began to try smokes that are a bit bolder in their flavor offerings.

Undercrown by Drew Estate came out as a winter winner!

### On The Range

The deep brown San Andres wrapper presents you with

nutty aroma with hints of wood and coffee. The Brazilian Mata Fina filler and Nicaraguan Cuban seed tobaccos are packed together nicely. There is a firmness to how this cigar is rolled that lets you know it will be a nice, smooth burning smoke.



### Front Nine

As I was hoping, the Undercrown starts out with pepper and spice that does not let the cold air interfere with the flavor. At first the spiciness over powers the undertones of the other flavors, but that's just for a short time and because of the cold. Soon enough, the nuttiness in the pre-light aroma begins to come around. The burn ring remained consistent and tight showing the expert rolling skills.

### Back Nine

As we move to the second half, the pepper takes a back seat to licorice, coffee and a bit of a firewood taste. While the Undercrown is bold in flavor, it is still a medium bodied cigar. It won't get your nerves jumping while trying to make a putt. I've had this cigar in the summer on several occasions, but it didn't make it to the top as a golf course cigar. Now that I've smoked it during cold weather golf, it has a definite spot in the bag!




