It's everyone's dream to go and play golf where the game originated so long ago that before there were clubs, the traders coming in to St. Andrews used to hit stones with sticks on their return to the ships anchored in the Eden Estuary.

Other great courses, or "Hidden Gems" as I like to call them are: Craigielaw, Glen Golf Club, Gullane No.2 & 3, Whitekirk, Royal Musselburgh & Haddington. Archerfield (Fidra & Dirlton courses), The Renaissance Club borders with Muirfield also. But I can't forget one other venue that is very close to me. Going back to the roots of golf, I can take you to the where the (British) Open was held 5 times between 1874 & 1889 and whats recorded in the Guinness Book of Records as the Oldest continually played golf course in the world. And yes, you can play with original hickory shaft clubs and gutty balls. Let's go play! YOUR PATH TO PAR

RICHARD ROBINSON - INSTRUCTOR: THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL

Are you a player, a competitor, a hacker, a scrambler? It is interesting how golfers profile themselves and playing companions. The mere fact that such sobriquets exist reveal the influence of self-perception in golf. Self-image is an important component to playing your best, maximizing your skill, and lowering your score. However the mindset of recreational golfers and tournament players need not be the same in order to enjoy the game. In fact the fun of the game may be enhanced, by playing contrary to the tournament player model.

To achieve optimum scoring goals the golfer's mental approach must be in harmony with his or her physical abilities and technical skills, and the setup and design of the course. For example, "competitors" are typically energized by focusing on the score, the ability to make shots under the pressure of a wager or championship, dealing with gamesmanship, attacking the "risk reward" of a hole design or shot requirement. Competitors are believers in the adage, "It's not how it's how many" Playing just for fun or technical excellence often seems meaningless to the "competitor". Conversely, the "player" is more focused on the process, techniques and strategy of the game. Players view the trappings of competition as irrelevant and "winning" as the consequence of playing performance not the reason for it. Competitors tend to be other directed, players self-directed. The list of great champions includes both performance personality types.

If you want to maximize your performance defining your philosophical and psychological approach to the game is important. It is something the best players do. However, the fun of the game can be enhanced by not restricting yourself to the judgment of the scorecard. Every round and every course, presents moments that urge the golfer to "go for it". Accepting the challenge may ruin an otherwise superb round, or provide a cherished memory of a golfing lifetime. Perhaps, rejecting the temptation and outsmarting the challenge with skillful decision making will preserve a memorable round and suggest that there is more to golf than mere numbers. Such decisions are the "choice" part of golf. In the 1966 US Open boldness and skill brought Arnold Palmer to the brink of a record setting score. While Palmer marched toward dominance of the tournament, course and history, Bill Casper played the round one shot at a time seeking only his best performance. Patience and persistence enabled Casper to make up 7 strokes on the final 9 holes and victory.

The 5th annual Player of the Year point total came down to the last day of competition. Salt Pond Golf Course - One of a Few

The Salt Pond Golf Course is a challenging, public 18-hole mid-length (3174 yds. from the black tees) course with a mix of par 3's and 4's. The course is located in the heart of the Salt Pond community in Bethany Beach. The tight fairways and ample water make it a fun, competitive experience for golfers of all ages and skill levels. The course opened in late 1992 with nine holes and later expanded to a full 18 holes.

In 2007, the course owner/developer, Salt Pond Associates, Inc., offered the course for sale to the Salt Pond community. By this act, the SPHA became one of a handful of homeowner's associations across the nation to own and operate a public golf business.

From the beginning, the golf business has been run as a separate "for profit" business of the "not for profit" Homeowners' Association, with a separate five member Golf Course Board of Directors. This Board oversees all aspects of the business using the professional input and guidance of its experienced Superintendent and General Manager, Bruce DeForest, and Golf Professional, Art Whaley (a member of the ESGM Hall of Fame). The members of the Golf Course Board of Directors are all drawn from the community and appointed by the SPHA for rotating three year terms and are selected on the basis of backgrounds needed to run the business. The Golf Course Board and other community volunteers possess a wide variety of skills and experiences, including marketing, finance, legal, insurance, real estate and purchasing.

For the past five years, Salt Pond Golf Course has prospered, generating sufficient profit from its rounds of play each year to provide its operating capital for equipment needs and other needed capital improvements. Future emphasis will be on growth in the rounds played using a variety of advertising and marketing techniques, tied into an up-to-date web site (www.saltpondgolf.com).

The Salt Pond Golf Course is open year round and operates a seasonal snack bar, offering hot and cold snacks and sandwiches plus a full range of beverages. The Pro Shop offers a range of apparel and golf equipment for golfers and the public. Tee times may be reserved by calling the Pro Shop (302-539-7525) during normal business hours. Family and individual memberships with distinct material advantages are available.

Come and try the course out. Women, Juniors, Seniors and players interested in sharpening their short game skills will find the Salt Pond Golf Course a well-manicured, rewarding experience, and you can play the course without devoting the day!

Tips FROM THE PRO!

PLAY FAMILY GOLF

For years I tried and tried to get my wife to play golf with me...you know, "quality time" together. Just recently I succeeded. We've been playing together once a week for the last couple of months and we're really enjoying it. Who needs to play golf with buddies...drinking beer, smoking cigars, talking about women, cars, and more golf??? We're talking serious "QUALITY TIME" here! I don't get to wager major denereo, or drink anything more than a couple imported waters. I can't stare luridly at the beverage cart girl, curse loudly, throw clubs, or in general act like a typical he-man golfing fanatic. And I don't miss those things even one little bit... honestly...OK, maybe a little.

The truth is, through this experience I've learned many new important things about golf...things that in 35 years of playing golf I did not notice or realize. I would like to share this newfound knowledge with you:

TRANSITIONS

BY ROB McDONALD, PGA



Merriam-Webster defines transition as a movement, development, or evolution from one form, stage, or style to another.

In the golf swing there are two transitions. The most obvious is the club changing directions from moving away from the target (back swing) to moving towards the target (forward swing). How we create this change of direction is the other transition, moving the responsibility of motion from the upper body to the lower body.

To have an efficient, powerful swing, it's the core muscle groups creating the motion once you set your arms and club in position at address. The inner, upper body coils against a lower body, firmly connected to the ground. This action carries the arms and club away from the ball. As this motion reaches its finish, the lower body begins the rotation towards the target. Picture in your mind, ringing water out of a towel by twisting the ends in opposite directions. This is what your body is doing during the transition. Your lower body delivers the twisted body through impact. If you start the forward motion with the upper body, you undo the body torque, thus wasting the power before you get to impact.

To get a feel for this inner-body transition, take your stance without a club. Fold your arms across your chest and close your eyes. Now feel your chest twist around the spine away from the target against a firm leg position. You will feel the tightness build in your back behind your shoulders. Next feel your left foot press into the ground as your hips rotate towards the target carrying the twisted body through the impact zone. By folding your arms and closing your eyes, you can really feel the inner-body doing the work. Next try and feel the same motion while holding a club. If you are truly using your larger, inner-body muscles, the transition will naturally be smooth.

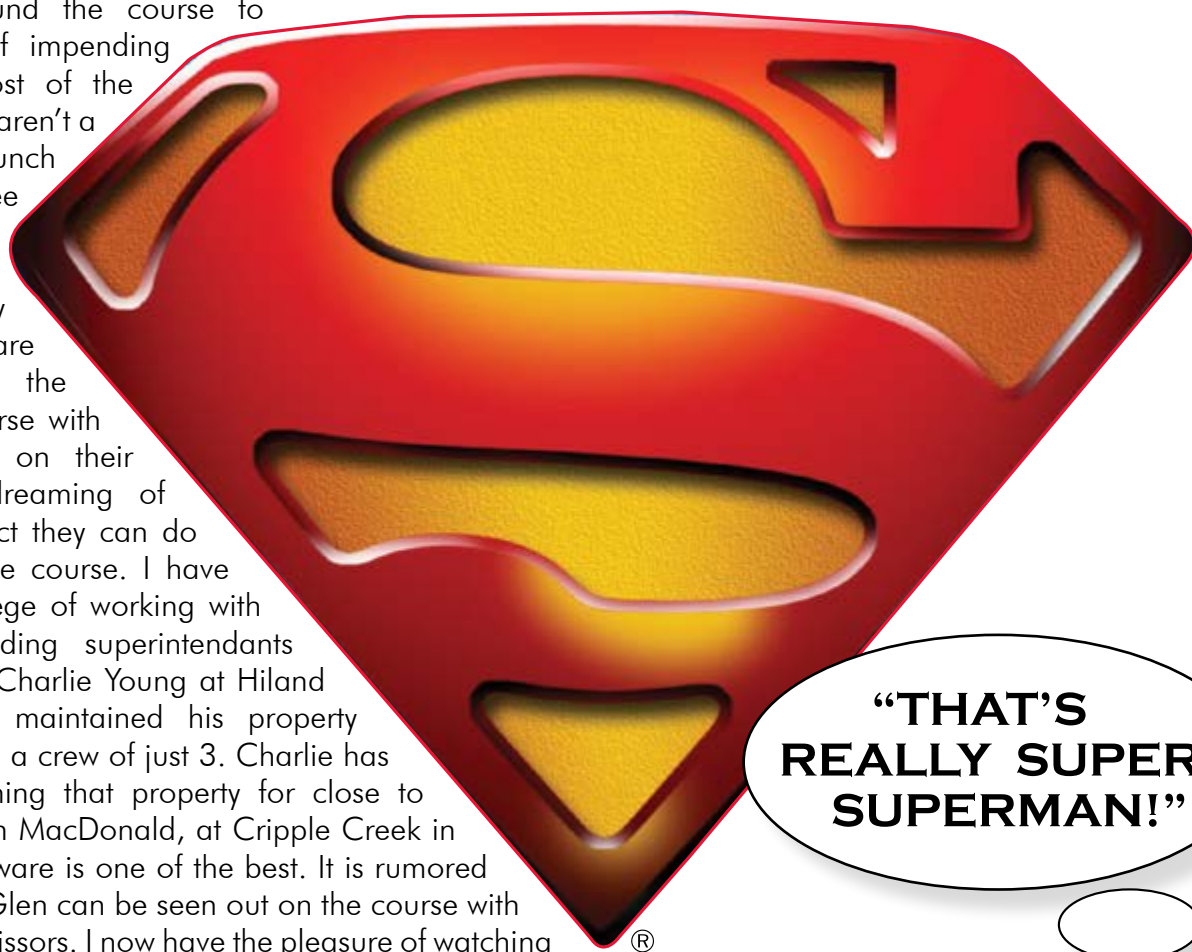

SHORE UP WITH THE GAME COACH

Carson Lovett, MA Sport Psychology

Mid-summer on the Shore and midway through the 2013 golfing season is a great time to revisit the plan of action for success, make revisions where necessary and review the practical tips for sustaining and improving performance. To sharpen the competitive edge during the "dog days" of sport, researchers identified five areas of focus and suggested the following recommendations:

For a motivational incentive to practice and play, list and post the appealing aspects of golf and the consequences of skipping training sessions and rounds.

Should confidence dip, check self-talk and eliminate negative chatter. Express thoughts to include intent instead of uncertainty.

To manage nervous tension, adhere to relaxation techniques. Controlled breathing has been proven to calm the mind and body

Developing visualization skills can enhance the ability to generate acute imagery, leading to vivid recall during practice and competition. Picture the 13th hole of a favorite stop along the Tour on the Shore; visit the course later noting the details of the scenery that did not appear as imagined. Repeat, and recognize.

Strive to strengthen concentration. Cue words and phrases often focus attention during performance. Matching desired outcomes with triggers narrows the thought process. Consider the favored rubber band on the wrist.

As the temperature rises, on thermometers and the competition, stay cool, confident in the vision set forth to focus on achievement.



STRENGTH & FLEXIBILITY!

While everyone should be in reasonable physical condition to play a good game of golf, sometimes people try to get "fit" too quickly. Fitness and weight loss take time. Just as crash dieting to lose weight is dangerous, so is high intensity, short time training. I am referring here to the training methods we have all seen on TV – programs such as PX90, Insanity and similar regimes. In these programs, people engage in high intensity exercise with little rest between routines. Some of them have a clock running while you work out and you are expected and encouraged to keep it up until the clock stops. Some programs use mostly body weight such as pushups. Others use weights and bars involving Olympic-type maneuvers such as squats, dead lifts and cleans (lifting the bar from floor to chest in one motion). While many people can accomplish these, they are really designed for younger and at least partially fit clientele.

What is the risk, outside of sore muscles and damaged joints? The most serious one involves exercises that can cause damage to muscle fibers themselves, especially exercises that use weights. When fibers are damaged (a condition known medically as rhabdomyolysis), they release myoglobin into the blood stream. This product has to be broken down and cleared by the kidneys. If too much is produced, the end result can be kidney failure. This risk is greater in participants who become dehydrated while exercising. While these programs that emphasize intensity and speed can work for

some people, the inherent risk is obvious. Combine this with the fact that many of these programs require little in the way of training to become certified and in short order people become "certified trainers" and start classes.

My point here is obvious- trying to accomplish goals in the fitness area is not something that can or should happen rapidly. If you opt to try these programs, it behooves you to look at the training whomever leads them has received. It could be critically important. As a rule, though, unless you are training for some sort of competition, the old story of the tortoise and the hare should be remembered. In most cases, slow and easy will accomplish your goals in the best and safest manner and get you fit for your golf game.

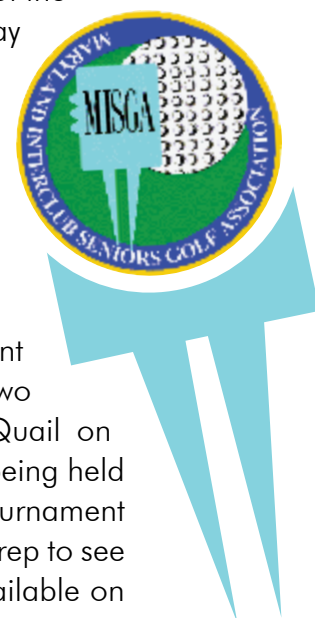
