BAGGIN' IT

By Rob McDonald

I may ruffle a few feathers with what I am about to say, but so be it. Every course or club has them. Almost everyone in the club or at the course who plays in tournaments knows who they are. It's difficult for them to hide. Their name is on or near the top of the results sheet of every event. They are the sand baggers. They guard their handicap as if it were the goose that lays the golden eggs. Because, basically it is just that.

Now I am all for the USGA Handicap System. It makes golf one of the few games where players of different abilities can compete on a fairly equal basis. But, the USGA's formula for handicaps is designed so that you should only actually play to your handicap about 25% of the time. It is a measure of your potential, not your average. It is also designed to give lower handicappers a slight advantage as a way of rewarding those who work on their game to get better.

From the moment I first picked up a club, my goal was to get better and that desire has never left. I have also given lessons to 90 year olds who still want to work to get better. I admire that and if I live that long I will probably still be trying to get better. It is after all, a game of a lifetime. The handicap system is a great tool to measure your improvement. Sand baggers use the system as a tool to win prize money in events. The term sand bagger has it's origin in the nineteenth century, when robbers and hoodlums filled their socks with sand and used it as a weapon to beat their victims.

Why do I let it bother me? Why bring this subject up? I bring it up because sand baggers can ruin a tournament program. Low handicap players will not enter because they feel they have no chance to win. Honest players in all of the flights will feel the same way. Golf is a game of honor and integrity. Golf is still the only game where you are your own referee.

You call your own penalties when they occur. You post your honest score.

All of them, high and low and let the formula do it's job. You enter tournaments and leagues to test your skills and see how they match up

to others. You enter tournaments and leagues to meet other golfers and enjoy the friendly competition. You enter tournaments and leagues with the desire to win, but if sand bagging isn't controlled, you won't have tournaments or leagues in which to play.







I had an epiphany the other day just before a golf match. As we were discussing (negotiating) match for that day I realized that I have been playing golf with this group for



over twenty years and all of us are about the same handicap as we were twenty years ago. There are minor differences between us as far as handicaps go but overall we are all pretty much the same. Twenty years ago I was a better golfer than a few in the group and I am still a better golfer today. Twenty years ago a few in the group were better than me and they still are better than me. Some of us have played more golf, have better equipment, taken lessons, spent hours on the range, but for the most part our handicaps have remained the same. Basically, we are all limited to how good we can be at this game to a certain degree by our athletic ability. You can go from an 18 handicap to a 14 handicap or a 10 handicap to a 7 handicap but if you have been playing golf for over five years, you are unlikely to go from an 18 to a 10 or from a 10 to a 5. Look at the PGA Tour, do you think Hunter Mahan will ever be as good as Tiger Woods or Phil Mickelson? Probably not. So remember, when it's all said and done....it's just a game for most of us. Focus on the good shots and good company. Don't let the game you love drive you crazy.




stymied? Are you Prior to 1952 the rules of golf permitted using your ball as an obstacle to block or "stymie" your opponent's path to the hole, in match play. If your ball came to rest between the hole and your opponent's ball you were allowed to leave it in place and "stymie" or force your opponent to figure out a method to circumvent the obstacle your ball created. Options to the stymie included putting around the ball, chipping over it, conceding the putt and removing the obstacle ball from the green, or even playing a carom shot off the ball. In the last instance, if your ball caused the stymie and was knocked

in the hole by your opponent's following shot, your ball was considered "holed" saving you one stroke. The stymie was removed from the rules of golf in 1952, and relegated to a position of historical trivia. However, I would like to resurrect the stymie as a great way to improve your putting.

The Stymie-Putt drill will improve your ability not only to read the green, but more importantly to feel the track and pace of the putt. Place a ball on the high side edge of the cup. Scatter 6 balls in a circle 4 to 10 feet surrounding the hole. Now putt each ball in the circle, into the cup aiming at the "Stymie" ball. The goal is to roll your putt to the "Stymie". For all uphill and side hill putts the result you seek is to roll the ball so it slows and drops into the hole before striking the "Stymie". Balls coming down the slope should strike the "Stymie", knock it in the hole, and even follow it, so both balls are holed on the same shot. As you practice this drill you will begin to link the chain of direction, duration, and deflection that define each putt's path and pace. The best part is you will do it intuitively and improve your linear precision and non-linear perception. It is simple and effective.



Physical fitness for any sport involves a combination of strength, flexibility and good cardio-pulmonary function. This is true of golf as well, al-


though the specific levels of training vary depending on the sports activity. One area that golfers often neglect is aerobic fitness; the more you want to improve your game, the more important these areas become. Is just walking or jogging enough? It can be, but it depends upon the intensity. You must work hard enough to improve heart/lung function and this necessitates a level of energy expenditure greater than just casual walking. When you are starting and out of shape, gentle aerobic exercise will suffice. However, as you get more fit, the intensity level must increase. The big difference between walking and jogging/running is time. To get good cardiopulmonary stimulation, you usually have to walk for a longer time than running. In both cases, maximum improvement occurs when you push yourself to near anaerobic levels (getting breathless). It goes without saying that all of this presupposes medical clearance to pursue such a program. One of the types of cardio training that has become popular in our fitness center is interval training. This can get you in aerobic shape faster and with much less time expenditure. Let's look at how this works.

If you are a walker, the principle is to walk at a pace until you are warmed up -usually 5 to 10 minutes- and then increasing your walking pace over a 30-60 second time period until you feel yourself approaching breathlessness. Once you are there, you drop back to your normal walking pace for a few minutes (usually 2), which allows your heart rate to drop and accomplishes "recovery". Next, you repeat this whole cycle. Most exercisers do this 8 times; that has been shown to be about all you need. The time it takes is not great (in this case about 20 minutes after warmup). The same principle applies to runners and the same technique can be used for any form of exercise modality. I personally like to use the stationary upright bike because there is no impact or weight bearing, so there is less knee/hip trauma. However, the key is intensity; as you start to get more and more breathless, you will know the intensity level is high enough. Interval training of this type has been shown to get you in heart/lung shape faster than endurance training (running or walking at the same speed for long periods) and also is excellent for the older person trying to improve fitness.

Again, as with all forms of fitness training, medical clearance is critical and using proper form applies to walking and running as well as strength training. If you are unsure of anything, my repeated advice pertains – talk to a qualified trainer. It is always worth the time and trouble.









Without question, maturity and a change in putting style helps Wie maximize potential; Lucy Li deserves a round of applause for showing the way to play: Free.





TOOLS OF THE TRADE "DIVERSIFY YOUR SCORING CLUBS"

BY STEVE MENZ

If you want to have a better short game, take a look at your wedges. Hopefully you have at least 2 to 3 specialty wedges in your bag. I am talking about a sand, lob and gap wedges. Sand wedges normally range in the 54-56 degree range lob wedges normally 58-60 degrees and gap wedges are normally 50-52 degrees in loft. Even if you only have 2 specialty scoring wedges in your bag make sure they have different degrees of bounce. I like to keep a 56 degree sand wedge with 12 degrees of bounce and a 60 degree lob wedge with 6 degrees of bounce


to give me better options around the green. A pretty good rule of thumb is that if you are on a tight lie i.e.; fairway, approach are or fringe and you need some loft to hit a shot use a club with very little bounce like the 60 degree with 6 degrees of bounce. This will ensure the club shouldn't bounce into the ball hitting it thin and running across the green like a scalded dog. It is also useful in most bunker situations. If I happen to be in the rough around the green and the ball is sitting up, tend to favor a club with more bounce to make sure the club doesn't slide too far under the ball during impact. The extra bounce will help the ball get up quickly

in that situation. I also like a club with more bounce in very heavy sand bunkers while I favor a club with very little bounce in a bunker with very little sand. Understanding the properties of the wedges in your bag will make you more efficient around the greens. If I am unsure of the lie I usually take all of my wedges and possibly a 7, 8 or a 9 iron to the location to make sure I have a club for all situations. More often than not I see amateurs walk to their ball with only one club and it is usually a sand wedge. Take the time to practice your short game with various clubs and you will diversify your short game. A sharp short game is the fastest way to improve your score every time you play!



"YOU KNOW THE DRILL!"



ENGAGE YOUR CORE

Even though the PGA has reluctantly decided to ban the anchoring of putters to the body by the year 2016, it doesn't mean you can't use the information to make more putts. Try engaging your core during putting strokes or simply, rotate your shoulders and belly to stroke the putter. This practice will eliminate hands and wrists from the stroke allowing you to be more consistent keeping your putts on their intended line. Practice using an alignment stick in the back of your putter grip anchored into your belly to achieve the proper felling of engaging your core. You will become much more consistent and now you know the drill!

If they haven't already started playing why not introduce them to the game of a lifetime? I'd like to spend a few minutes talking about something near and dear to my heart... Junior Golf. For many reading this article they have kids already playing. Some of you are wondering how do I get my child

give you some insight as a PGA instructor who has taught thousands of kids as well as played in a host of junior golf events myself.

started?

I see junior golfers basically one of three areas to start out: Little ones 2-5 years old, Young beginners 6-9 years old and then the geriatrics of the group the 10-16 year olds. Before you read any further, here is the key statement to learning as a junior. You know your kids the best! That being said, you may be the right person to start your kids or you might look for some professional help. In either case, ensuring the kids learn the fundamentals of the game while having fun are paramount to the successes they will have as their golfing careers progress.

For the youngest of thrashers, it is all about just letting them have fun while putting safety first! If it is big plastic clubs from your local chain store or custom fit clubs (don't laugh, yes, I've seen it) this age group is all about FUN! The thrill of just making

contact is what it's all about. One of my favorite things to do with this age group is to fill up water balloons and let them swing away! Sure it just seems like goofing off, but you are actually

working on their coordination skills and it's a lot more fun than swinging and missing a ball on a hot day. Guaranteed the kids will hit the water balloons!!

group is the
one where
I think most
people begin
their junior
golf days. Here
the kids are able to
concentrate and are effective
learners being able to match
the mechanics of the swing to

what they see in the swings of seasoned golfers. For this age group, instructors tend to focus on the fundamentals the game. Drilling into them the proper grip, stance, posture and swing mechanics to shorten the learning curve. Even

with golf professionals it is most often the fundamentals where swing flaws creep in, so the sooner we learn the proper techniques, the easier and more fun the game becomes!

Finally, the oldest of the junior groups. This group is made up of such a variety of players that it is pretty much a crap shoot as to what to expect. From kids who have been playing on junior golf tours for several years to those that are just beginning. As an instructor I like

to see the kids leave this age group with a well-rounded golf game. They should have a firm understanding of the golf swing but just as important if not more is how to behave on a

> golf course. They should know the rules of the game and follow the etiquette so that they can play with anyone.



I've taught both individual private lessons for juniors as well as hosted a golf camp with over 250 kids in a session. The key is to get the right fit for the junior. With the right fit all are effective ways of learning. As the skill level of your junior becomes greater you might even want to get them involved with the many junior golf tours that are available today. A simple search on the internet will yield thousands of results but the Maryland State Golf Association as well as the Middle Atlantic Section of the Professional Golfers Association have programs designated specifically with the junior golfer in mind.

The bottom line is golf is meant to be fun. It is one of the few sports that can be played by kids and adults all on the same playing field. So if you really want to give your kids something to do this summer. Why not give them the experience of a lifetime and introduce them to the game of golf.






