

Lateral vs Downward Force

The golf swing is circular by nature. Our body rotates around the spine in a circle and the club swings in a circle. There is also lateral force and downward force. Quite often I see golfers with too much of one and not enough of the other. Lateral force is when we rotate through the ball, for a righthanded golfer, our force is moving laterally to the left from behind the ball and through it. This force is what sends the ball in the direction of the target. Provided we have enough lag in the club head, the force of the club face has a lateral motion to the left, from behind the ball and through it to the target.

So, there is plenty of lateral force being created. What I see missing from a lot of golfers is the downward force. Imagine a musician who is clapping two cymbals together. That is all lateral force. Many golfers who are trying to hit the ball by releasing the club head into the ball end up with the same kind of lateral force, thus adding loft to the club and not striking the ball solidly. Since we already have enough lateral force of the whole club, not just the club head. Imagine slamming a lid onto a spaghetti pot. That's the sensation you want to have as you turn through the impact zone. As your hips and legs are driving through you want to feel as though you are dropping the shaft on top of the ball. This will give you the downward drive to pinch the ball giving you a more solid strike.

To get a feel for this. Set up normally and place a ball well beyond your back foot. Now strike straight down at the back of the ball as if you are chopping off its tail. The ball should squirt out low and hot. Now move the ball a little forward and make sure your turn your hips before striking down the same way. Otherwise, you'll just stab it into the ground. Slowly bring the ball more forward in your stance while continuing to feel the same downward force. You should notice that your hands must be less active to properly feel the downward force. Any early action of the hands will give you more lateral motion. We already have enough of that!





Practice and play so often that the golf course, putting green and driving range become your second homes. Hit balls until it hurts. Serious high school golfers can be found on the course almost everyday during the summer; even in the rain. If your game is suffering, you may need to contact a local golf professional for lessons, or attend an instructional camp.

Bayside golf matches are usually played from tees that are closest to 6,300 total yards for men. Ladies will always play from the forward tees in high school. No matter which course you are playing this summer try to play from that distance or more and count every stroke.

GET INVOLVED IN A JUNIOR TOUR. Summer tours afford young players with experiences in competition that are extremely valuable. In fact, most college recruiters weigh a player's achievements on junior tours more heavily than their high school accomplishments (except for the state tournament).

PLAY THE BALL DOWN. You have to learn how to hit shots from bad lies to be the complete competitor. Not to mention, touching the ball anywhere but the tee and green may result in a penalty stroke(s).

LEARN THE RULES OF THE GAME. Obtain a USGA rule book and study the basics. Penalties can be assessed during practice rounds, qualifying rounds, and matches for any and all infractions. Ignorance to the rules is not an excuse.

LEARN TO CONTROL YOUR EMOTIONS. Swearing, club throwing, kicking objects, etc. will not be tolerated at all. Act with maturity and control on and off the course. Represent your school with class.

GET A PHYSICAL. Physicals are valid in public high school for 365 days. Permission slips, physical forms, emergency forms, etc. are usually required before you may try out for your high school team.

DON'T CONCENTRATE ON DRIVING, AS MUCH AS YOUR SHORT GAME. •Tournaments are won around the green with chipping and putting.

•That's why Long Drive Champions usually do not excel on the PGA Tour.

WALK THE COURSE AS OFTEN AS POSSIBLE WHEN YOU PLAY.

- •You must have strong legs to play competitive golf.
- •Tired legs usually results in bad golf shots.

DON'T TAKE GOLF FOR GRANTED. It's not a right, it's a privilege. However, any player who does not exhibit respect for the game, the facilities, and the people involved could jeopardize their high school experience. You are representing your school and you are a reflection of your coach. Do not embarrass your teammates, coaches, family or yourself.

ENJOY THE SPORT. It is one of the few sports that can be played for a lifetime. Don't let the game control you; you control the game. Everyone has their share of horrible rounds. You may hit a slump this summer and at other times strike the ball with resounding confidence. Don't give up - don't be a quitter. High school players would love to post scores near or below par, however, that takes a great deal of practice and commitment. If you're not committed to getting better, your game may never improve. It doesn't happen overnight while you're sleeping, or in the ocean on your body board, or in your room on the X-Box: it happens on the range, the chipping green, and the golf course.

Remember to always respect and appreciate those who give you the opportunities to play golf. Be thankful to God, your family, and the people who make it possible for you to enjoy the sport.

Good Luck in your preparations for the upcoming season. Practice, play, and learn from those golfers whom you respect for their abilities and passion for the sport.

TOOLS OF THE TRADE DEV STEVE MENZ GOLF GPS NEXT LEVEL ~ ARCCOS"

Recently I read an article about the Arccos Golf GPS Tour Tracking System and it intrigued me. I liked what I read and knew I had to have it! After receiving the product and learning how it worked I am "all in" on this piece of technology. The Arccos system is complete stat analytics. This thing has more charts than Magellan. How does it work? You put a sensor into the grip of each club and pair it with your smart phone. Download the course you are going to play, step on the first tee, select the tees you are playing and hit "start round". The rest is pure awesome. It works like a standard GPS with distances to front-center-back of the green with a fly over point of view then here comes the magic. When you choose your club and pull it out of the bag it "wakes up" and realizes it is going to be used. Hit the ball and simply put the club back in the bag. Proceed to your next shot. The

device measures the length of the shot, whether or not it is in the fairway or the rough and gives you the distance for the next shot. When you select the next club and pull it our of the bag, that club "wakes up" and repeats the process now measuring whether you hit the green, miss it right, left short or long. It will also give you proximity to the hole. It will measure your putting ratio, sand saves, chipping proximity as well as you percentages of up and down. As another useful tool the program offers the distances of each club in your bag. The differences you think you hit each club will probably be a little different from actual yardage. This will allow you to choose your club more accurately. It handicaps 5 major portions of the game: Driving, Approach, Chipping, Sand and Putting. This will identify the weaknesses in your game very quickly and then you will know where to focus



time. practice The program is very simple to set up and easy to use. Arccos recently have added some GPS features like tapping the screen on the hole to choose how far each hazard or desired area may be from your location. It also provides you a "sharing" option if you would like the social media world to see how you are playing instantly. I have only experienced a couple minor difficulties to date. I have two sensors stop reading shots, this was quickly remedied by a simple re-pair of the club to my device by an easy push of the button. Also I had a round stop reading on the 4th hole and resume on the fifth hole as a different round, again no big deal. So if you are serious about your golf game and you want to improve by using complete analytics The Arccos System is THE best system on the market.



YOU KNOW THE DRILL "AIMPOINT" THE BEST WAY TO READ GREENS

If you haven't seen it put to use yet, get ready because people standing looking at a putt with a couple fingers in front of their face is going to be everywhere. I am talking about Aimpoint and it is a great way to find out the exact line of your intended putt. Aimpoint utilizes the sense of feel to read a putt which is important because putting is predominantly a feel part of the game. Here are the basics of how it works. Walk half way between your ball and the hole and feel the weight in your feet. Determine which foot has more weight because of the slope of the green.

Rank the amount of weight on the heaviest foot on a scale of 1 to 5, 1 being almost even and 5 being the most severe. For example if you have more weight in your right foot, the putt will go right and we rank this weight a 2. Next step, hold the coinciding fingers on the opposite edge of the hole, in this case two fingers against the left edge of the hole. Look at a spot against the fingers you have lined up with the hole and putt towards the mark! Bingo! Ranking the weight is initially difficult, but simply by doing it a few times it gets extremely easy. You will be able to read a putt blindfolded! I have already seen this method make mediocre putters instantly better and it will make good putters great. Just watch the players on tour this weekend and see how many are using this method (Adam Scott, Justin Rose, Stacy Lewis to name a few). Do yourself a favor, google developer Mark Sweeney and Aimpoint and start making more putts guaranteed! Now you know the drill!





THE MORAL: FEEL GOOD! CARSON LOVETT, MA SPORT PSYCHOLOGY

One of the most common reasons amateur and professional athletes seek guidance from Sport Psychologists and Mental Coaches is to manage Competitive Anxiety. The challenge for the recreational golfer to develop and master a repeatable swing may feel as unnerving as a Major Champion on the cut line at the British Open in the midst of a years-long drought. Researchers agree: Success at every level greatly depends on the athletes' ability to identify and perform at the optimal level of Arousal.

A widely accepted hypothesis of Arousal particularly applicable to golf is the Inverted U Theory. Generally speaking, as psychological arousal increases performance improves, but only to a critical point; increased stimulation beyond the peak diminishes performance. When teeing off, the level of arousal required to reach the fairway differs from that which is needed to tap in from two feet. Being over- or under- stimulated in either situation often leads to an undesirable outcome. Success comes from accepting the symptoms of anxiety as necessary components of the game and having an understanding of what the optimal arousal level feels like during the ups and downs in golf.

When performing at the optimal arousal level or within the Functional Zone golfers declare a heightened touch and feel for the club, a relaxed mind, narrowed focus, and a sense of confidence allowing them to trust intuition. The Golf Coach assists the athlete in determining favorable task-specific arousal levels and identifying performance enhancement techniques to place the golfer into the proper zone during skill acquisition and competition, and in time the golfer realizes and utilizes the power of anxiety as a tool for achievement.

'BAD FAT' 'GOOD FAT'



LDL CONCERNS

My article this month is not specifically about golf, but should concern everyone, golfers and non-golfers alike. It is about the old demon, cholesterol. Having a high cholesterol is bad, right? Not always. A Harvard study of heart attack patients showed that over half of persons studied had normal cholesterol. What seems to be more significant are levels of LDL (bad fat) and HDL (good fat). We have been told that elevated LDL (over 120) is a worse risk, but now scientists have identified subtypes of LDL. There is subtype A, a molecule not associated with atherosclerosis, the underlying cause of most heart attacks, and subtype B, which is the dangerous one and can penetrate artery walls, one of the first steps in heart disease. So when you are tested on your next physical, request the "expanded" cholesterol test, which will measure these subtypes. And this brings us to whether or not you should be put on a statin if your cholesterol is high. If you have a lot of subtype A particles (Pattern A), your cholesterol-associated risk for heart disease is negligible and a statin is probably not warranted. If, however, you have Pattern B (the bad subtype), the studies show that a statin could save your life, especially if you have already had a heart attack. This is because statins are effective for secondary prevention because they stabilize plaque, thin the blood and are anti-inflammatory. So in the Harvard study mentioned above, what did cause heart attacks? They found that heart attacks and other coronary events were linked to smoking, excessive alcohol intake, obesity, lack of exercise and poor diet in about 82% of the people studied – not high cholesterol.

YOUR PATH TO PAR

RICHARD ROBINSON, INSTRUCTOR THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL

SET UP TO "BELT" YOUR DRIVES. Everyone wants to hit the big drive. The thirst for extra distance becomes intoxicating watching modern tour players launching tee shots well over 300 yards. Technique, fitness, equipment, ball design all affect power golf. Those who succumb to the power golf addiction typically display symptoms of great tension, movement, and exertion in their swings. Although power players boom the ball, it is often at the expense of accuracy and distance control. Still the thrill of the soaring smash is not to be denied.

The set up and posture is key to good golf and fundamental to power golf. The effect of a proper set up is to maximize your personal biomechanical profile to maximize arc and leverage, minimize tension, and simplify movement. The big "hit" is best achieved by an effortless blending of sequenced motion and balance. There are three simple things you can do to encourage better results, before you even begin your driver swing.

First, relax your jaw and neck. Tension here will restrict the flow of your overall swing. Keep your chin up, not so much to allow the shoulders to turn under the chin as often suggested, but to create the proper

cervical curve that will enable the entire spinal column to rotate more easily throughout the swing. Note: players who wear multilevel eyeglasses often display the "chin down to chest" posture because it is necessary to look through the proper aspect of the lens. If this applies to you consider a single lens design just for golf.

Second, encourage a balanced finish by pointing the toes of the lead foot toward the target rather than straight ahead. Flaring the foot approximately 25 degrees toward the target makes it easier to turn through the shot and achieve a balanced finish.

Third, raise your lead hip slightly at address. Hold a club so the shaft is parallel to your belt line. Slightly tilt your hips so the lead hip is about 10 degrees higher than the trail hip. When you set up with this posture you will notice a slight bias in foot pressure in your trail foot arch. This promotes initial stability of the right side support during the backswing. As you swing, your "belt line" will naturally level on the back swing and return to the lead side high position coming through, providing a balanced platform for the shallow angle of attack preferred for a teed up drive.




