Women's Golf Icon Renee Powell Receives Honorary Degree at UMES

During its 2010 winter commencement exercises today, the University of Maryland Eastern Shore awarded an Honorary Doctor of Public Service Degree to Renee Powell in recognition of her pioneering spirit and accomplishments as a sportswoman and philanthropist.

Powell is the second African-American woman to play on the Ladies Professional Golf Association tour. "I am honored and humbled to be recognized by UMES," said Powell. "This is my first honorary

degree from a college in the U.S. and all because of my dad's vision of teaching me the game of golf." At age three, Powell picked up a golf club her father had cut down to fit her tiny hands. She entered her first tournament at age 12 and won her division. It was a sign of things to come. She went on to play golf at Ohio University and The Ohio State University, serving as captain of the women's golf team

at each institution. She debuted on the LPGA tour in 1967 and competed in 250 professional golf tournaments. She won the 1973 Kelly Springfield Open in Brisbane, Australia.

In the early 1970s, Powell visited Vietnam as part of a USO goodwill tour. In 1979, she made history when she became the first woman to be named head professional at a golf course in the United Kingdom.

Powell finished her LPGA career in 1980 and taught golf in Africa and Europe. She eventually returned home to the Canton area, where she currently serves as the head professional at Clearview, where she learned the game. In 2001, Clearview – the course her father, William, built from scratch – was named to the National Register of Historic Places by the U.S. Department of the Interior.

Also in 2001, the Powell family established the Clearview Legacy Foundation to promote education, preserve the golf course for future generations, develop improved facilities for teaching golf and expand turfgrass research.

Powell received the Professional Golf Association's First Lady of Golf Award in 2003.

Those highlights underscore why UMES, an 1890s land-grant institution, chose to recognized her. UMES is the nation's only historically black institution with a professional golf management program where 43 students currently are pursuing their studies. The program's charter class is scheduled to graduate in the spring of 2012.





А common golf experience is to get in the "zone," make an effortless swing and hit a shot that exceeds all expectations. When this happens, it is one of the true joys of golf. Why it happens seems a great mystery. That it

happens is a source of sincere frustration. As you prepare for the coming golf year, resolve to work on improving your preshot timing, for it is a key to consistently capturing your best performance.

One of the most critical, yet elusive skills in golf is effectively timing a swing. Fortunately, you can develop this this skill away from the course. Timing is more than properly sequencing the movements of a swing; it involves the entire process of preparing and executing a shot. Watch a tournament player prepare to make a shot. You will notice a definite pattern of movement that begins when the club is taken in hand and continues until the shot is complete. Mannerisms will be different from player to player. But, each individual will have a personal style that is the same time after time. The "timing" of these movements is often overlooked, but it is a critical component to consistent shot making. A swing actually begins in the preshot routine as visualization, alignment, setup are prelude to the actual motion of striking the ball. If you timed any great player, you would discover that the time taken from the start of their preshot routine and the beginning of the swing would be almost identical from shot to shot. The tournament player practices the process thousands of times and becomes consistent. However, even the greatest players suffer if any disruption or variation of preshot "timing" occurs.

The occasional player does not have the benefit of practice repetition and is prone to have significant differences in the time taken to execute a shot. One swing is rushed with a poor result. The next swing is too deliberate and allows the demons of effort and expectation to paralyze the mind and body. Finding the right timing can be difficult. Yet, we all experience times when we intuitively feel the shot will be good. So, with confidence we set up, swing, and are not disappointed. This feeling can be learned. Try to control the timing of your actions and relax the urge to think more intently on technique or circumstance.

Find your personal "zone" by practicing your preshot routine and timing it. Experiment to find just the right feel for YOU as you set up to the point of beginning the takeaway., First try to set up a little more quickly than usual. Then try a more deliberate approach. The goal is to learn your preferred pace, and then train yourself to repeat your optimal personal timing repeatedly. Doing this will help you feel the shot rather than think the shot. When you feel balanced and ready just swing. By practicing away from the course, you can build a "good timing" habit without the distraction of the game, the score, and the shot. When you tee it up on the course your "good timing" will contribute to a good time!

TO HOST FIRST ANNUAL EVENT FOR REGIONS GOLFERS



TOOLS OF THE TRADE STEVE MENZ GOLF GEEKS UNITE!

No, I am not talking about a Star Trek convention. I am talking about the PGA Merchandise Show in Orlando, Florida? Obviously the name speaks for itself. You can expect to see all the clothing outfitters, and all the new equipment from the top brand names. But the show offers much more than that. All the stars come out in full force pushing their brands. Hank Haney, Natalie Gulbis, Butch Harmon, Lexie Thompson, Peter Jacobsen and Dr. Bob Rotella were some of the big names there this year. But Annika Sorenstam was by far the most accessible person on the scene. This year the technology was all the rage. Perfect for large golf operations, the Flightscope booth was by far most visible. Flightscope uses Doppler capabilities to scan the golf ball at impact to display exact yardage, launch angle, spin and ball flight. They definitely did not invent the wheel, but they sure put some nice rims on it. The screen display is beautifully addicting and it makes finding your optimal club specifications a breeze. This item is really pricey (around \$11k), but a must have for a major golf operation. For the individual golfer a bright spot was the Bushnell booth. Bushnell has combined the laser range finder with the course GPS all in one unit. They have built the perfect beast, so to speak. This unit comes standard with all of the golf courses in the US that were not built within the last 6 months. This unit requires no downloads or additional fees. The unit starts at about \$499. Though it sounds pricey it actually combines the cost of a laser \$349 and a Golf GPS \$349, without the yearly renewal fee or monthly charge. For those who favor the GPS route the Golf Buddy released a nice, new touch screen unit that blows the competition away. There are no annual fees or costs to download courses. The unit will hold up to 40,000 courses and provide a full lay out view and an overhead view. This sweetie goes for about \$199, very nice! But who made

the loudest noise at the show this year? TaylorMade stole the show. Like white lightning, the new R11 line was blinding. Not because the club heads are white, because they rented out one whole end of the convention center. Initially I was a little apprehensive about trying the R11 being a traditional minded golfer. The first time I hit it, yes I noticed the club head. Then each time after, I realized that I am usually so focused on the golf ball that the color of the head means absolutely nothing. And it felt awesome, by the way. I have said it before, and I will say it again, "I don't care if it is a shoe taped to a stick, if it feels great and reacts well, I will play it!" The head is adjustable up and down one degree and the clubface can be set to open, neutral and closed. The Cobra booth made the most noise. Since being taken over by Puma the brand went young. Walking into their booth on Demo Day was quite the experience. They had a DJ mixing on two turn tables and a color scheme that reminded me of a Wham! video. The only thing missing was a beer pong table. That did not hamper the Cobra S3 line. The drivers performed well, as they always do. I took the time to hit the Nike VR Pro, Ping K15, Titleist 910 series and the Callaway Razr Hawk woods. Each felt as good as the last and this years club market is shaping up to be a great one! If you haven't replaced your Driver in a couple years, this may be the time to do it. Most drivers have gone the way of adjustable head technology. It's here to stay so you may as well get used to it. It really makes sense; just see your local professional and they will get it set to your optimal position. Many of your local golf facilities are setting up Demo days in our area. It is the best way to get fit for your perfect clubs. Check out articles in this magazine to locate demo days near you! If you haven't made it to a show, it is worth the trip at least once. Live well and prosper.





More distance! More distance! More distance! These two words have sold a lot of balls and clubs. But as we all know, the equipment can help, but where does the real distance come from? Why can player A use the same club and hit it fifty yards past player B?


Speed? Yes, but that's only a small part of the equation. You can have a tremendous amount of speed, but if the club face isn't square the ball may go a long way, but not in the direction you want it to go.

A question you might ask is what does the ball care about? Well, it cares about two things. The position of the club, and the position of your body through the impact zone. If you have those two things correct, you have a good shot. After that more speed can help. If distance is the goal, then you need to put maximum pressure against the back of the ball. Unfortunately, many golfers have the idea that you have to get under the ball or that you have to hit it with your hands as you release the hinge. This concept actually leads to weak, ballooning or misdirected shots. The club's handle must be leaning slightly forward with the clubface square for the most solid contact with the ball. The body must be in a torqued position with the hips open and shoulders square to the target line. The trailing arm should be tucked slightly in and under the leading arm and hands under the sternum. With this position you are linking the whole body, with the large muscles, in away to apply the maximum force to the ball, efficiently.



The power lines mentioned in the title is an image I use that helps to deliver the two positions. In the address position, imagine a line along your right palm (facing the target), and a second line on the inside of your right shoulder and a third line in between the two, along the clubface all three lines are parallel to each other and perpendicular to the target line.. Your mission is to deliver those three lines in that order, through the ball. Right palm, club face, right shoulder. Start the swing with the lines in position and keep them there during the swing. Use your torso to create the motion. When you try to make the club head pass the hands at the ball, you end up adding loft to the club while decelerating the arms.

Notice at address the yellow lines at the shoulders and hips are parallel. At impact the hips are open while the shoulders are square. Start slowly, hitting short shots while maintaining the lines. As you feel your rotation creating the strike, you will begin to feel the larger, more powerful muscles doing the job. You can then begin to pick up the pace of the rotational speed to get more distance, but with accuracy as well.






INDIAN RIVER HIGH SCHOOL

SPRING CLUB PRIMER by Mike Bednarcik Are Your Clubs Ready for Spring?

After this long, cold winter, I'm sure you're probably not physically ready to start playing golf – and how about your clubs? Are they in the best shape possible? If not, what can you do to get them ready for the upcoming golf season?

Perhaps the most important and often most overlooked is getting your clubs evaluated for the proper loft and lie. Golf clubs can easily work their way out of alignment (loft and lie) by simply hitting balls on the range or off hardpan, hitting a tree root, rocks, or just during normal play. It is always a good idea to insure your clubs are set to the manufacturer specifications by having them checked at least once a year.

If the lie of a club is off by as little as 1 degree, this could mean that your shot direction could be off by 3-4 yards. You may not notice this in your long irons, but being off 3-4 yards in your wedge could mean the difference between being in a bunker or being on the green.

Loft is equally important. There is only a 3-4 degree loft difference between clubs as you progress through the set. Do you have two clubs in your bag that you may hit about the same distance? You should see about an 8-10 yard gap between each club. A simple loft check and alteration will cure such distance gaps.

How about your shafts? Are their dent marks in your steel shafts or unusual wear marks or fraying on your graphite shafts? Both of these conditions could lead to premature shaft failure.

Do you hear a rattle in your shafts or clubheads? This could be caused by loose weights or epoxy could have broken loose. Although this doesn't affect play-ability it could be a distraction.

Check your ferrules as well. These are the plastic trim pieces where the shaft enters the clubhead. If there is a separation between the ferrule and head it could mean that the ferrule is loose or worse yet the club head is actually loose. Although this is unusual, it pays to at least have them looked at and corrected if necessary.

Check your grips for unusual wear. Are there indentations caused by your thumb? Are they slick or hard to hold onto? Do you even remember the last time you changed them? If not, you are probably in need of new grips. While you're at it, have your Clubmaker check your grip size. You may be surprised at what a different size grip could mean to the feel of the golf club. Mike Bednarcik Custom Clubs of Frederick Golf Digest -2011 Top Clubfitting Facilities



What about set make up? Do you ever hit your 3 or 4 irons? If not, take a look at the new hybrid clubs. These new clubhead designs are much more forgiving and a lot easier to get airborne. Do you consistently hit a fade (slice)? Perhaps a driver with a closed or offset face will help straighten your drives. These designs will help you return the clubface in a more square position at impact and could result in straighter drives.

If you are a serious golfer, you should have a frequency analysis done on your clubs. This high tech specification check compares each of your clubs to one another to see how they compare. Throughout the set, there should be an equal separation between each club. If a club does not follow the same progression as the others, that club could play noticeably different than the rest. What does this mean to your game? Well, if your clubs are not frequency matched, they may not perform in the same manner or be as consistent.

Whether it is the loft, lie, shaft, or grip, it is wise to have a Clubmaker perform an equipment check-up at least once a year to ensure that you have equipment with the correct specifications to match your individual playing characteristics. The best players in the world are constantly evaluating their clubs. Doing it on a regular basis will help you do the same.

Whoops! Of course I mean Fairway Bunkers. I just got back from a whirlwind family vacation to Disney World, and I guess I have fantasy on the brain. After walking miles and miles to stand in endless lines day after day after day after...I'm surprised that I have any brain left..."It's a small world after all, it's a small world after all" ARGGGGGGGGGGGGGGGGGGGGGG

Sorry, down to business. Anyone who would take small children to Disney World for vacation (vacations are supposed to be relaxing right?) is out of his mind!

So that brings us to how to hit a fairway bunker shot. No worries here. The key is to relax (like you're not on vacation in Disney World). You want to do everything slow and easy here. First, take your time and assess the situation...how is my lie? How high is the lip of the bunker? What club do I need to clear the lip? How far do I need to hit the shot to get back into play? Many calculations and deep thought needed. Take your time and make a good and conservative decision. You're just standing in line waiting for the "It's a small world" ride. You've got time. Use a club that you are comfortable with. Use at least one more club than normal for the distance if possible (if it will clear the lip).

We want to use more club for this shot because:

- 1. We're going to choke down on the club about 1 inch.
- 2. We're going to swing nice and easy...just looking for good, solid contact.
- 3. We're going to swing in great balance so that we don't slip in the sand and fall on our rear.

Final thoughts: assuming a good lie and a lip that's no problemo...aim to hit the shot to a safe place (no heroics), take plenty of club, choke down, dig feet into the sand for stability, swing smooth and easy with great balance (quiet legs), and just look for solid contact (ball first, sand second).

Follow these simple relaxed steps, and you'll hit your ball right out of Disney World...or at least the Mickey Mouse bunker at the Disney course in sunny/warm/lovely Orlando Florida.


