



On December 24, 2012, we lost a dear friend and Director of Golf for Bayside Resort Golf Club, Bill "Hammer" Hamilton. Hammer was a member of the Carl M. Freeman Golf family for nearly 15 years. He helped open the company's first golf course, Bear Trap Dunes. Hammer was part of the leadership team as they acquired Hell's Point in Virginia Beach and The Bay Club in Berlin, Maryland. His pride and joy was in being a key player as they developed and opened Bayside Resort Golf Club, a Jack Nicklaus signature golf club located just west of Fenwick Island, Delaware.

Hammer was loved by many and will be remembered in countless ways. He was a teacher to some as an encouraging and expert golf instructor. To some he was a leader as he provided

a vision for the golf courses including exemplary customer service standards. To others he was a mentor as he coached employees and young golfers on the game of golf including etiquette and the gift of conversation. Most importantly, though, he will be remembered as a friend. As a Southern gentleman, his drawl, manners and charm were irresistible. His infectious smile was welcoming and he knew everyone by name. Hammer was a "go to" as a trusted friend.

The truth is that although we will miss him dearly, we will be reminded of the positive impact Hammer made in the world each time we visit or play The Bay Club, Bear Trap Dunes or Bayside.

PENINSULA GOLF ASSOCIATION

The Women's Peninsula Golf Association is a group of 685 women from 25 clubs along the DelMarVa peninusla. It was formed in 1954 by six country clubs: Chester River, Seaford, Maple Dale, Clearview (Cambridge), Green Hill, and Talbot. Ocean City joined shortly thereafter. Their hope was to bring more women into the game of golf and to promote camaraderie and competition between the clubs.

Nineteen of the clubs have golf teams that are divided into four divisions. They have team matches in April and May with semi-final and final playoffs for gross and low net in June.

During the season, there are 12 tournaments with various formats hosted by member clubs. There is also a one day Senior/Super Senior tournament and a two day Championship Tournament. At





the end of the season, the President of the WPGA hosts the Officer's Appreciation Tournament at her home course. At every tournament a 50/50 raffle is held to raise money toward the \$500 which is donated to the Delmarva Peninsula Golf Association Scholarship fund each year.

Golfers belonging to the WPGA must also be members of an 18 Hole ladies group at their home course. By belonging to the WPGA, they are able to play at reciprocal courses on appointed days for cart fee only.

The WPGA is governed by an Executive Board of 10 people. They have two meetings a year and there are 2 general meetings a year where representatives from every club come together to share information.







I'm going to dedicate more time to golf instruction this season. Deer Run Golf Club has been kind enough to allow me to significantly reduce my responsibilities for the Course in order to give more time to my students. I will be splitting time between the Bob Beckelman Golf Academy at Deer Run and the "A" Game Golf Academy at Nutter's Crossing hoping to reach as many golfers in need as possible. Steve Menz and I have been running the "A" Game Golf Academy at Nutter's for three 3 years now, and I'm looking forward to becoming more involved there. Salisbury has a relatively large golf population and Steve and I are happy to offer our services to them. Get "Golf Ready"! We're ready to help!!!

Enough of that, let's shake the rust off. The weather is starting to look better. The clubs are beginning to call, "get me out of this bag!" Let's start with the wedges.

Begin your wind up to the golf season with some ½ and 3/4 wedge swings and make sure to warm up before hitting any balls. We're looking for control, balance, simplicity, and good solid contact, NOT DISTANCE. Work on catching the ball in the center of the club face using impact tape. Work on striking the ball with a "square" club face. The ball should start out straight at the target, not way left or right! The ball should not curve significantly. The ball should NOT go very far, but yes, up in the air. Tee the ball up slightly if you're having difficulty. Repeat, Repeat! Don't hesitate to hit the entire bucket with small, simple swings!

Master this Contact & Square drill, and you will be well on your way to a simply fabulous golf season!





Starting with Athletic Basics

Brandon Havas, Havas Athlete Academy

Golfers are athletes. Your body needs to work like an athlete's in order to produce consistently good shots on the golf course, simple enough. Unfortunately many of our bodies do not work functionally the way they are supposed to, leading to crappy shots, miss-hits, and inconsistent ball striking. Agreed? Now I may have your attention, seeing as I probably just identified your game in one short sentence.

I will keep this pretty short and simple. The basic principle here is this: your body works in a series of mobile and stable joints from head to toe. If just one part of this kinetic chain is not working correctly, your movement pattern is all messed up and you are now looking at having to make compensations to get your body and club head in the correct position. Doing this the wrong way, compensating, can lead to not only inconsistency, but pain on and off of the golf course. Even worse, over a period of time, this can lead to injury. To break this down, I'll give you a rundown of what joints do what in the body. Ankle: Mobile. Knee: Stable. Hips: Mobile. Low Back/L Spine: Stable. Mid Back/T Spine: Mobile. Upper Back/C Spine: Stable. Shoulders: Mobile. Elbows: Stable. Wrists: Mobile. This gives you an idea of how the body SHOULD be working.

However, we all seem to have physical limitations or "dysfunctional" body parts, and that's what leads to


compensation and injury. What's the most common one I see in amateur golfers? Immobile Hips (they should be mobile) which lead to a necessary mobile lower back and knees (which should be stable) to complete a golf swing. This is why you not only lose power, and a ton of it, but also create a lot of unnecessary stress on the body.


Quick fix? FITNESS. This will enable us to link them to your golf swing. From there, we will assign corrective exercises and training to get you on your way to better, more efficient, pain-free golf!

GOLF FITNESS - COLDS!

During the recent cold weather I have talked to many members at our gym with U.R.I.s (colds). During our discussions I ask what they were doing for it (my specialty when in active practice was E.N.T.). Distressingly, many of them told me they went to their medical doc, were told they had "sinusitis" and were given an antibiotic. With the growing overuse of antibiotics and the rapid developing resistance of bacterial strains, I felt compelled to write this article. While not directly related to golf, many of those I talked to were winter golfers.

A recent study published in the Journal of the American Medical Association took one hundred and fifty people from ages eighteen to seventy years old with sinus-related symptoms for seven to twenty eight, that included facial pain, nasal congestion, drainage, and cough. Half were given pain meds, decongestants and a placebo instead of an antibiotic. The rest were treated symptomatically plus an antibiotic. In a nutshell, all got better with little difference between the groups. The doctors who did the study stated "Nobody disputes that some of these patients had a bacterial rather that a purely viral infection and would benefit from an antibiotic, but the problem is we don't know who they are." They point out that one in five adult antibiotic prescriptions in the U.S. is for the treatment of sinusitis, but eighty percent of them get better on their own within ten days. Yet, about ninety percent of people that go to the doc's office and get the diagnosis of

sinusitis will be given an antibiotic. In our practice, we had ways of diagnosing severe bacterial sinusitis, including X-rays and sinus cultures, but most docs don't bother with these, nor have the expertise to interpret the results. Yet, antibiotic treatment for U.R.I.s is often both expected by the patient and prescribed by the physician. Patients also often quickly discover that if you go into a doc's busy office and pester him/her enough, you will get an antibiotic to get you out the door.

So the bottom line is not to assume that antibiotics in these situations will get you quickly back to work (or back to the golf course). You should really question the reasons for the use of these drugs before the superbugs (bacteria resistant to all common antibiotics) appear. Now that's truly scary.








SHORE UP WITH THE GAME COACH

Sports Journalist Clifton Brown has covered professional athletes for more than thirty years, including Tiger Woods during his first seven seasons on the PGA circuit. At a recent presentation Dr. Bradley D. Hatfield, Professor and Chair of Kinesiology at the University of Maryland, College Park asked the veteran sports writer to identify a trait or characteristic responsible for separating the elite from the crowd of competent performers. Recalling a conversation with a childhood friend of Tiger Woods, Mr. Brown pointed to unwavering confidence as the common thread uniting the greats in sports. The friend described a young Tiger Woods as one who would not internalize defeat. A missed putt or an errand drive could always be explained, and overcome. A poor performance would not alter self-belief and the perceived ability to meet the challenge.


Dr. Hatfield, an expert in sport psychology and physiology measuring the electrical activity within the brain during skilled performances interpreted the anecdote as a broadened awareness. The self-assured athlete has the greatest aptitude for managing the competitive environment because confidence wards off task-irrelevant cues, granting the athlete increased attentive capacity. Worry, doubt, fear and anxiety are examples of emotive and cognitive processes occupying precious space inside a limited area for focus. Self-confidence provides a barrier against an invasion of counter-productive cerebral activity.

Using an electroencephalogram (EEG), researchers are demonstrating the confident brain being "quiet" during task performance, and amplified impulse activity in the mind of the unsure. Understanding and controlling the relationship between thoughts and deeds may lead to a lower handicap and increased enjoyment while Touring the Shore.


REMEMBERING

BILL "HAMMER" HAMILTON

While there are many ways to exemplify the ways a golf professional has made golf a better game for every person to enjoy, I have decided to focus this article on "The Consummate Golf Professional". Our area sustained a major loss to the golf community on Christmas Eve 2012. The passing of James William Hamilton has deeply saddened all who knew him. He was the Director of Golf at Freeman properties which include Bear Trap, Bayside and the Bay Club. Bill Hamilton had been with the company since 1999. Most knew him as Bill or "Hammer" and is kindly remembered as one of the greats of the business. Hammer exemplified the charm of a Southern gentleman coupled with a silky smooth golf swing and an infectious personality. He mentored many of the area's top golf professionals. Any time I travel off of the shore to play golf and tell professionals where I am from, they inevitably ask me if I know Hammer. Bill was instrumental in golf course development, not only in our area but from here to North Carolina, where he grew up. There are not enough words to explain the capacity of his legacy. He was a 4 year letterman at NC State where he made the All Atlantic Conference Team in 1977. He was once asked "What was your greatest moment in golf?" He replied, "Playing 18 holes with Arnold Palmer and him making me feel we had been friends our entire lives." While most would focus on the name Arnold Palmer, he focused on the "making me feel we had been friends our entire lives". Although I have only known Bill for a short time, I sure did feel like I knew him my entire life. I am sure that many of you can make the same statement. We are eternally grateful to have May we known him. all play the course you have in mind for us.

WEIGHING IN ON ANCHORING

It is pretty well known by now that the USGA has come out with a proposal against anchoring the club or forearm against the body while making a stroke. This rule change, if implemented, will take place on January 1, 2016.

While I make no judgments against anyone who currently uses an anchoring method of putting, I agree that the USGA is making the right decision on two counts.

First, let's take a look at two past champions, Johnny Miller and Tom Watson. Both were players who reached greatness in golf. Both players were afflicted with the golfer's dreaded disease "the yips"! The yips are basically what I call impact anxiety. The lack of confidence or fear of a bad result causes a deceleration of the hands and putter at impact and makes it very difficult to make putts. Watson, with eight major wins, was known for charging his putts. When he missed, he always seemed to make the come back putt, no matter how far it went past. When he got the yips, he stopped making those. Miller, with twenty-five victories, including two majors, had an attack style of play similar to Greg Norman. Watson eventually recovered from his poor putting and went on to win three Senior British Opens and Second Place in the 2009 Open Championship. Miller is now broadcasting.

What's this have to do with anchoring? With anchoring and the long putter, it takes the yips out of the picture. You don't have to recover; you just buy a longer putter and anchor it I'm not saying you'll make every putt, but it takes the breakdown out of the picture. One of the two players, through practice and determination, was able to overcome the yips. It's a facet of the game, overcoming adversity.

On the second count, I knew the USGA would make the rule universal. Initially I had thought it would be appropriate for the professional level only. Especially with the USGA and PGA trying to make golf more fun for everyone. But, now I feel that keeping it universal was the right thing to do. It's what keeps our game unique. You can go play the TPC at Sawgrass and play the same game as the best players n the world. When's the last time you played baseball in Camden Yards? Or football in the Super Dome? There's always the question about aluminum bats in college baseball versus wooden bats in proball. Does a record with an aluminum bat get asterisk? Would you want your record round of golf to




PGA Golf Management Students attend PGA Merchandise Show



YOU KNOW THE DRILL

I came up with this title after listening to Dave Matthews Bands latest offering "Away from the World". The title seems appropriate for the news recently passed from the USGA and the R&A. Starting January 1, 2016 you will not be permitted to anchor your belly putter to your body during the stroke. You are still able to use a longer putter, but it may not be controlled by pressing the putter into your body. This is a big deal! The players that have flocked to longer putters normally have had struggles with shorter, more conventional models. The longer version has helped

them remember that the putting motion is made by engaging your core and putting without arms and hands. The belly putter brings back a smooth pendulum action. Last year two Majors were obtained by the help of this flat stick wielded by Ernie Els and Webb Simpson. The PGA Championship in 2011 also belongs to fellow belly putter, Keegan Bradley. I find that people that have struggled with conventional putters greatly improve because of the amount of practice time they use to hone the longer putter skills coupled with a new self confidence. Be assured, if you take the time to practice putting fundamentals with whatever weapon of your choice, you will achieve your desired outcome.



YOUR PATH TO PAR

RICHARD ROBINSON - INSTRUCTOR: THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL

What will be the key to your success in 2013? There is great value in creating specific goals. It is also useful to have comprehensive goals. Physical fitness is a foundation for improved technique and mental focus. Focus and technique determine the consistency and quality of shot making. Shot making skills enable a strategic approach to the game and better scores. There are multiple factors to consider in a game improvement plan. However, when you tee it up to play, having one key and only one, is the best way to unlock your potential. An important distinction to note is the key may be a thought, but is even better as a feeling or visualization of what you intend to do

Defending Master's champion, Bubba Watson, provides a good example. Bubba is an intuitive player who hits the ball prodigious distances. He obviously does the key things correctly, but these fundamentals are disguised in an unorthodox style. Watson's approach is reminiscent of Palmer and Ballesteros; hit the ball far and recover from wherever it lands. In contrast, runner up Louis Oosthuizen is a classic player with technique akin to Hogan and Snead. His performance was near perfection, surpassed only by Watson's incredible recovery shot on the first playoff hole. Bubba's ability to execute this shot was due in part, to the fact that there was no "standard technique" to apply. It was a unique circumstance that required a creative feel and single minded focus.

The other aspect of Watson's success is his ability to hit shots great distances. When asked how he does it, he says, "Make a long swing". This is a great key because it is one phrase, easily visualized, with multiple meanings and benefits. The obvious "long swing" is to maximize swing arc. However, the more subtle clue is to control your tempo. A powerful swing takes time to execute and is unhurried. Bubba's swing speed travels fast at impact, but he feels like it takes a "long" time from start to finish.

Patience and focus brought Bubba Watson a Masters championship. A clear vision of what you want to accomplish and a deliberate approach is the basis for developing your best game. Find your master key this season. Join us at the Original Golf School.




