THE ONE SHOT

When I used to teach golf down south, I had a year-long lesson program. I would get together with the client at least twice a week for an hour each day for an entire year. The benefit for the client was that we had a plan with a goal at the end. The benefit for me was that I knew I had a commitment to follow the plan. There are always people who take one lesson and expect immediate, tour-like results. Not going to happen! The player on the plan however, always improved.

With the player's commitment to the year, I knew we could spend three weeks on one shot and not be distracted by impatience. The shot we would work on is the pitch and run.

The reason being is that if you learn this shot, you learn how to properly strike a golf ball in the full swing as well.

The first challenge was to learn how to strike down on the ball instead of trying to get under it. Sometimes this could take a while because they had to get used to a different feeling at impact. We would achieve this by placing the ball well back in the stance, beyond the back foot. Then, strike the ball by chopping straight down on top of the ball, trying to pinch the back of the ball so it scoots out, very low. As the person got used to the striking downward motion, we would progressively move the ball forward in the stance. This helped them get used to impact with the club still on its downward portion of the rotation.

To play the pitch and run, you take a narrow stance with your front foot pulled back slightly to open the lower body more towards the target. You place the ball back in your stance with your weight and the handle leaning slightly forward. Keeping your lower body quiet, carry the arms and club away with your chest. There is just a slight hinging of the wrists and club. How far back you go determines how far the ball will fly. How much you hinge determines how high the ball will go. We want it to be a low shot, so there is less hinging.

The forward move begins with using the lower body rotation to carry your arms and club through the rest of the motion. You want your hands to be as if there is a thin coat of ice around them and you don't want to crack the ice. Very quiet hands will help to keep loft off the club so that we can get a low shot with the lofted club. This shot is handy in the short game because you can hit a shot high enough to carry onto the green and run some, but not all the way off the back. You can use this shot with any of your lofted clubs. If you just add more hinging to the shot you will get more bite and less run out. But, try not to unhinge as you go through impact.


As you get used to striking the ball in this manner, you can begin to include it in the full swings as well for more solid ball striking.







2014 MERCHANDISER OF THE YEAR- PRIVATE MARC KIMMINAU, PGA

TALBOT COUNTRY CLUB EASTON, MARYLAND



With Marc's extensive experience in private clubs, it's no surprise that he has a keen eye for merchandising. He has worked in the hospitality industry for Marriott and Le Meridian as well as in retail for Polo/ Ralph Lauren and these positions, coupled with his golf positions, have taught him the importance of unparalleled service. He continues to grow his merchandising operation and trains his staff to create memorable moments for members and auests which has earned him the 2014 Merchandiser of the Year Award - private category.

Marc Kimminau was born on October 3, 1966 in Wichita, Kansas to Jim and Beverly (deceased) Kimminau. He has two older siblings, Eric and Kathy. When Marc was about five years old, the Kimminau's moved to Kansas City where Marc would first learn about golf from his grandfather, Bud White. The two started playing together at Rolling Hills Country Club when Marc was nine and during these moments, Bud inspired Marc by sharing his love for the game and the life lessons learned.

Following High School, Marc ventured south to Dallas, Texas where he continued to play golf and improve his game. He turned professional in 1989 and spent one year in the College of the Desert's Golf Management program before transferring to Richard Stockton College in New Jersey. While working on his finance degree, Marc enrolled in the PGA's Golf Management program and successfully earned his PGA Membership in 1995. He then graduated from Richard Stockton in 1999 with a Bachelor's Degree in Finance.

Marc's first golf job was at Smiley's Golf Complex in Overland Park, Kans. during

his High School Years. From 1989-1991, when he lived in Texas, he worked at Oakmont Country Club in the north suburbs of Dallas from 1989-1991. His next position was as a Non-Member Head Professional at Blue Heron Pines Golf Club in Egg Harbor City, N.J. In 1995, Marc took an Assistant position closer to the Jersey shore at Greate Bay Country Club in Somers Point and also earned his PGA Membership. He spent four seasons at Greate Bay before accepting the Head PGA Professional position at Stone Harbor Golf Club in Cape May Courthouse, N.J. Marc worked at Stone Harbor until 2007, and accepted his current position, Head PGA Professional at Talbot Country Club in Easton, Maryland, in 2008.

The golf shop at Talbot has experienced a 24% increase in sales throughout Marc's five years on staff. Contributing to his bottom line are multi-vendor Demo Days in both the Spring and Fall. Prior to the Demo Day, he features a vendor in a weekly email blast to the membership which usually sparks conversation in the golf shop. Early in the season, Marc creates a "mobile" golf shop at Talbot's pool facility and hosts a trunk show to highlight the season's latest fashions. 

introduced me to this line. I am forever grateful.

The Oval Maduro comes wrapped in a beautiful Habano 2000 wrapper that's been aged for over four years. The binder is Nicaraguan with a Nicaraguan/Honduran mixed filler.

On The Range
This treat from A.J.F. has a very dark chocolate appearance with a pre-light aroma of cowhide and licorice. The most obvious difference is in its oval shape, hence the name.



Front Nine

The Oval starts out with a definite pepper, spicy taste but soon after the dark chocolate mentioned in the appearance also shows up in the flavor. The shape of the cigar is very comfortable on the lips as well. It has a nice easy draw that allows for a lot of smoke to entertain the pallet.

Back Nine

As we move to the back nine, the flavors really transition well into a smooth creaminess with hints of nuts and leather. While this cigar is dark, it remains a medium bodied smoke throughout. There is no harshness or extra kick to through your game off.

One fringe benefit of the shape of the Oval is that you can rest it on the tee marker while you hit and not worry about it rolling off. This cigar is now part of the starting lineup. It's a good thing I picked up a few extra on my last visit to the tobacconist.







THOUGHTS COUNT!

SHORE UP Carson Lovett, MA Sport Psychology WITH THE GAME COACH

Sport Psychologists, Game Coaches and athletes across the sports spectrum agree: Over-thinking during the performance of a motor task ranks as a major stumbling block proven to impede goal achievement. The typical sequence unfolding for a performer falling prey to a debilitating thought process follows a universal path: The pressure to execute an assignment causes an increase in nervous activity and self-consciousness; a critical shift in focus occurs and the attention-draining attempt to ward off mistakes disrupts the trustworthy routine, yielding to the subjective; in the end, the natural flow of performance erodes requiring talent to function under duress, sabotaging the desired outcome. Navigating the most important region of an 18-hole golf course, the six-inch area housing the brain, gives the golf world a profound respect for the negative effect of excessive mental chatter. To avoid analytical over-exertion under pressure and facilitate success research supports developing the capacity to recognize and operate within optimum levels of cerebral stimulation.

Science suggests the inexperienced golfer may gain an advantage through an increase in neurological activity during skill acquisition and performance. The complexity of golf demands terrific attention to detail for progress and to minimize beginner error. However, as the athlete memorizes the movement pattern necessary to accomplish the task and the act becomes custom, the need to contemplate each step of the procedure diminishes. The brain learns to automatically calculate the situation. In preparation for a memorable Tour on the Shore and a gratifying season on the links, identify the fundamental stages of skill development, and think accordingly.

Now that it appears winter is finally behind us, the time has come to prepare for the upcoming golf season. Be aware that if you hung up the clubs last fall, you can't just pick them up and go right back to the shape your body and game was in at that time. Changes will have occurred in your strength and flexibility; your game will not, in all likelihood, be the same. So you have to do a little training. I will list some of the body areas you should start working on 4-6 weeks before you hit the links.


Upper Body- It has been shown numerous times that the big muscles of the upper body are more important for generating clubhead speed than the muscles below the elbow. This area can be whipped into condition with exercises like pushups, biceps curls and triceps extensions. Doing dips from a chair or bench is also a great strengthener. When you start these exercises, start with a weight or situation that permits you to do at least 15 reps without excessive straining.

Core strength – This involves the muscles of the abdomen and back. Abdominal crunches and back extensions are the classic maneuvers. Or, take classes in pilates at your fitness center.

Lower Body – Squats for the quadriceps and hamstring curls for the back of the leg are the most important.

Flexibility – Stretching the entire body after you have warmed up and finished your strength exercises is paramount. The overall most effective step is to participate in some yoga classes. Contrary to what you might think, anyone can do it; it is just a matter of only doing as much as you can comfortably. As I have said before, the old maxim "no pain, no gain" does not apply to general conditioning.

If you are unsure about the things listed or how to accomplish them, my most prudent advice is to consult with a qualified trainer. The time and effort you expend will be more than worth it - and, your game will definitely thank you.

Fad or physics? Does it make "sense" or does it just make "cents"? Counter balanced putters are the hot topic this spring (can I get a hooray for spring). Companies like Boccieri Golf / Heavy Putter and Tour Lock have been trying to get this topic to the front pages for years, and now that the big boys/girls (Taylormade, Odyssey, Ping) are now on board, that message is on a fast track to better putting.

Quite simply, by putting more weight at the grip end of the putter, the center-of-gravity is moved closer to the hands which should lead to better control. The putter becomes more stable throughout the entire length of the club and not just in the head. Being able to increase the entire club's MOI keeps the ball online better. Even though the putter's total mass increases, it should feel more evenly distributed through the entire length of the club.

Many experts feel that this represents a real, lasting change that more players are migrating to. This technology has the potential to benefit all golfers and even though putting is personal, counter balancing should help steady your hands and in turn steady the putter head.





Having trouble keeping a smooth tempo and transition in your putting stroke? Try this drill. Most putters have a cavity in the back of the putter face. Place a coin in the cavity and practice your stroke. Try to keep the coin on the putter throughout the stroke. If you find the coin falling off when you make the forward motion you are forcing the club back to hit the putt and not stroking the putter. Practice keeping the coin on the putter and you will sink more putts. Now you know the drill!





TOOLS OF THE TRADE

"THE GOLF BALL"

Originally I was going to write this article about differences in

golf balls then an interesting conversation arose. Just what is it that makes us love our golf ball and search for them tirelessly? Titleist dominated the world of golf for decades on end. Now there are many great golf balls in the market that all respond equally. I recall playing with the old Titleist balata balls as a youngster. Those things would get a smiley face just by looking at them wrong. A smiley face was a crease in the ball from a miss hit. Those golf balls were so soft. These days golf balls are so resilient. They take a beating and never go out of round. You could play them forever, but you don't. It is because most of us don't own the golf ball, we merely rent it. The average golfer loses 5 balls per round. With premium nuggets selling at \$50 some dollars per dozen expect to chunk about \$20+ into those feared water hazards. I have been amazed watching the golfer that lost his wayward shot exhaust the 5 minute time limit searching for his ball. The realization that it isn't the cost of said ball, it's the closure that is needed. Amazingly a golfer can narrow down the search from hundreds of yards away to a few square yards, "But I KNOW it is right in this area!" He just tipped the cart person \$10 bucks, but will step in the muddiest of areas in his \$150 dollar shoes to find a \$4.50 ball. Again, you need to know where it came to rest. Psychologically you need the closure. Maybe it's playable?



TEST, ASSESS, THEN PROGRESS!

One of the most common questions I get from golfers is, "how can I hit the ball longer?" Valid question! However, there is never a solid answer. This is assuming you're hitting the ball on the center of the clubface. If you're not, then there's one very easy fix. But for me, I work with golfers on making their bodies better at generating power, increasing flexibility, and increasing stability. However, before I can do that, I must know EXACTLY what your body can or cannot do. This is called testing and assessment. There is a 12-15 test 'screen' as well as a video swing session to correlate swing

flaws to physical limitations. Once I know exactly what your body is capable of and what limitations it has, I can develop a specific protocol for you to improve on these areas, hence leading to a better and more powerful and effective golf swing. The answer to longer tee shots, more consistent irons, and a better looking you is right under your nose, maybe you just haven't thought about it this way yet! So before you start beating balls all day long on the driving range, remember, you must TEST AND ASSESS, BEFORE YOU CAN PROGRESS.


