The Ocean City Elks Lodge #2645 ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT HISTORY

The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks is a nationwide organization of well over a million members. Founded in 1868, we have adopted the concept of a "mutual benefit" society which was broadened into the grander idea of charity for all.

The Ocean City Elks Lodge # 2645, received its charter on October 3, 1982. Since our charter began we have provided charitable donations to assist our military veterans, local churches, schools and other organizations which have a need.

Beginning in 1985 the Lodge formed a Scholarship Committee whose objective was to raise funds which would provide monetary assistance for the further education of local students. In May, of that year one scholarship was awarded to a student of Stephen Decatur High School. The amount presented was for \$300.00 a year for four years. These funds were mainly contributions from within the Lodge.

For six years thereafter, the Scholarship program was supported by the lodge, along with funds raised from a Scholarship Golf Tournament. These funds provided one scholarship each year. Later the tournament committee grew in size and provided additional incentives, which found a larger number of players participating to a point where funds increased, allowing for additional students to receiver greater amounts.

On May 25, 2011 the Lodge will award four Stephen Decatur Seniors \$1,000 per year for four years; totaling \$16,000. As of May, 2011 the Lodge has recognized 59 seniors from Stephen Decatur High School and Worcester Preparatory School with scholarships totaling over \$200,000. These students have enrolled in 37 colleges or universities. In September of this year, the Lodge will be funding 14 scholars in college, who will be receiving \$1,000 to \$1,500 per year.

The Scholarship Committee deeply appreciates the tremendous help it receives form the Ocean City Elks Lodge #2645 Annual Golf Outing Committee. This fund raiser has become the primary source of the Scholarship Fund. They would also be remiss if the did not recognize the players, Eagle's Landing Golf Course, the many local business and individual sponsors, the Elks Golf Associates, the Elks Ladies Auxiliary and the individuals who contribute with tax free donations.

The next Ocean City Elks Lodge # 2645 Golf Tournament will be held on Monday, June 13, 2011 at Eagles Landing Golf Course. We are hoping to maximize this event. The cost is \$95.00 per golfer and includes continental breakfast, hot dogs and beverages on the course and dinner at the Elks Lodge. Prizes will be awarded to A, B, C, and D Flights. Additional giveaways will also be awarded.


THE EASTERN SHORE GOLF HALL OF FAME



The momentum being created can serve as a driving force for golfers of all ages who are focused on maximizing performance. But before blowing the budget on new clubs or the latest gadgets, remember the words of legendary golfer Bobby Jones, who once said, "Competitive golf is played mainly on a five and-a-half inch course...the space between your ears".

Sport Psychologists and Mental Game Coaches agree that a sure-fire sign that a golfer could benefit from consultation is the inability to repeat successful practice habits during competitive play. If you are wondering whether a Game Coach is right for you at this stage of your skill development, here is a list of common questions and concerns that golfers share with their Consultants: How can I develop more effective thought-management skills to better navigate the periods of success and bouts of disappointment that occur during competition? How do I eliminate self-doubt and maintain self-confidence when my performance is not up to par? How can I avoid getting angry on the course, or can it be used to my advantage? How can I control my excitement when I am playing well? Lastly, how can I sustain the aggressive nature that got me the lead?

The golf world is motivated, and its athletes are angling for every advantage imaginable. Acquiring the skill and stamina necessary to successfully negotiate an 18-hole course can be a daunting task. Mastering the five and-a-half inch course will make that mission possible.









The best in the world always make it look easy. Eric Clapton's smooth motion gave him the nickname Slow Hand. What you would see in concert would seem like the music was flowing through him. Tiger Woods in peak performance, would sink putts that appeared to be destined to go into the hole right off the putter face. You knew it and he knew it. What you didn't see were the hours Eric and Tiger spent practicing. Clapton once said "If I don't practice one day, I can feel the difference. If I don't practice two days, my audience can hear the difference." The point is that while they make it look easy, it isn't easy getting there.

Golf is a game of patience. The only thing that happens quickly in golf is a high score on a hole. You walk of the green scratching your head thinking "What the heck just happened?" Golf requires patience in three ways, in the game, in the swing and in the improvement.

In The Game

Patience in the game means that you shouldn't try to make up for any bad shots by hitting heroic shots or by trying to murder the next tee shot because you're angry about a three putt on the last hole. This can easily turn a bogey into a double bogey or higher. You can come back from a bogey, but it's very difficult to make up for doubles. Stay in a calm focus knowing there are plenty of opportunities that are coming your way. It doesn't have to happen right now.

In The Swing


In the golf swing, there needs to be patience in the motion. Balance and timing are everything. You need to let speed build in the swing. A quick take-away can lead to tightening of the muscles. Then, there's little, if any, chance of a smooth transition into the forward swing. A quick snatch from the top of the swing can get you out of sequence and out of position, leading to a misdirected shot. The golf swing is a sequential movement of your muscle groups. You need the time for it all to take place. Practice in super slow motion to get a feel for the sequencing. As you start getting a feel for the right motion, slowly begin to increase the speed, but stay in sequence.

Patience in Improvement

After winning his first Masters, it took Tiger Woods a year and a half to make a swing change with Butch Harmon. Imagine that. The number one player in the world with one of the top teachers in the game, hitting a thousand balls a day and it took a year and a half. After taking a lesson, you may understand completely what the new move is supposed to be. But, golf is not like a math equation where you know the formula and just have to fill in numbers. You have to train yourself through repetitions, practicing short and working towards long, and committing to it on the course. Taking one

lesson and then thinking that you should "have it" is unrealistic. Very seldom will you get it immediately. The fringe benefit to working on your patience in your golf game is that you learn patience in your life. We all thank you for that!

CONSIDERATION FOR OTHER PLAYERS

No disturbance or distraction.

Players should always show consideration for other players on the course and should not disturb their play by moving, talking or making unnecessary noise. Players should ensure that any electronic device taken onto the course does not distract other players. On the teeing ground, a player should not tee his ball until it is his turn to play. Players should not stand close to or directly behind the ball, or directly behind the hole when a player is about to play.


This time of the year is the best to get out and play golf. After

GOLF FITNESS - WRIST INJURIES

This month I would like to briefly look at wrist injuries in golf. While not a common injury, it nonetheless occurs. Injuries tend to be either soft tissue(usually tendons) or, on occasion, bony. The former usually are overuse injuries of the flexor and extensor tendons of the forearm. They usually are precipitated by elements of an improper golf swing, gripping the club too tightly and, of course, impacting the ground when taking an overly big swing, especially out of the rough. The left wrist is usually injured in righthanded golfers. Advancing age, a previous injury and anatomic

abnormalities can increase the risk. When the pain of tendinous injury occurs, the treatment is resting the wrist, analgesics and occasionally the injection of steroids.

The most common bony injury is fracture of the hook of the hamate, one of the 8 small carpal bones in the wrist. Unfortunately, this injury is often diagnosed late; if found early, a cast may be the treatment. If not, surgery may be

required to remove damaged bone fragments.

Some suggestion to minimize wrist injuries include slowing down the backswing to lessen whip on the wrist. Some recommend flattening the back swing to decrease the chance of the club hitting the ground and taking a big divot, especially when the ground is dry and hard. Also, keeping the hands in parallel alignment to allow the wrist to achieve it's natural motion has been recommended. As in previous articles, good equipment and good swing techniques minimize the risk of any injury. And one final point- we have talked over and over about the importance of a strong body core. If the core is weak, experts say that will encourage the golfer to use the wrists to throw the club at the ball; with a strong core you will be more able to bring the larger muscle groups into play and use your body to swing the club. Keep up with the Pilates exercises.`

FIRST DE CLUB TO GO SOLAR!

Cripple Creek started looking into the viability of utilizing solar power to offset rapidly escalating energy costs about six months ago. Three companies bid on the job and the contract was awarded to Flexera, a Harbeson, Delaware-based, comprehensive design-build alternative energy company.

Flexera installed four photovoltaic systems for Cripple Creek: an 8190-watt, 39-panel system for their pool; a 17,640-watt, 84-panel system for their golf cart barn; a 12,600-watt, 60-panel system for their maintenance facility; and a 15,120-watt, 72-panel system for their irrigation systems.

Hunsberger said Cripple Creek's board formed an energy committee and started looking into several forms of alternative energy, including solar, wind and geothermal, "anything we could do to lower our energy costs," about a year ago.

"The best rate of return came from solar," he said. "Our main decision when Flexera's figures came in was based on the fact that we could cut energy costs for the long term with a payback period of about four years. Federal grants, state grants and SREC's are essential to making this project economical for our club."

The pool and cart systems were up and running in December. The maintenance facility system went live in January and the irrigation

system was online in February. The energy cost for February, the first full month of operation for all four systems, was less than 40% of the previous year's cost, according to Flexera Vice President Benjamin Farr.

"At this point in time we're very satisfied with the operation of the system and the financial results," said Hunsberger. "The panels blend in with the roofs and we're selling energy back to Delaware Electric Co-op, and when we're not doing that, we're reducing our power bills. And that helps us contain costs for our members."





How to Hit a **OIRON**



You know the quote: "only GOD can hit a ONE IRON", well today I'm going to teach YOU how to hit ONE. Actually that's not entirely true...truthfully it's almost entirely a non fact...but I have reason to lie. Today's clubs are so long and strong of loft, that your 7iron today is comparable to a 5 iron of old (15 or 20 years ago) so a ONE iron would be

comparable to like a negative TWO iron...unless you are playing with clubs from 15 or 20 years ago (in which case I strongly suggest going to see John and Derrick at RUDDO'S Golf for an upgrade to the 21st century). In the infinite wisdom of marketing geniuses, the golf club companies discovered that players wanted nothing more than to hit the ball farther. So, in an epiphany of incredible discovery, they figured that if each club was longer than currently standard, and a couple of degrees stronger in loft, lo and behold, the ball would go farther. I don't know why they just didn't just re-number the clubs and save a bunch of trouble. (Maybe that's what they did...no one will ever know). In any case, clubs got longer and longer and stronger and stronger over the years, and that's the primary reason most people struggle with the long irons (5, 4, &3 etc.).

So now, even GOD can't hit a ONE iron. What is a mere mortal to do? The strengthening of lofts in irons has created the necessity of Gap Wedges to fill the gap left from the strong lofted Pitching Wedges, and now this unforeseen situation has created the necessity of yet another club to appear from the ether...THE MIGHTY HYBRID!

Hybrid clubs have actually appeared from time to time in the past, but have just recently gained world wide acceptance and popularity. You can even find them in Professional Golfers bags, so you know they must be good! The current models are all very similar, and all are designed to do the same thing...replace your impossible to hit loooooooonnnnngggggg Irons! Hybrids make it much easier (for most people) to hit those long fairway shots nice and high and accurate, or at least high enough to save some worms, and accurate enough to stay on the planet! Go out and try some hybrids and see if they suit your game and can replace those nasty long irons (RUDDO'S Golf again)...with any luck you'll be back to smashing those pesky long fairway shots and lowering your scores.

I have noticed lately though, that the heads on the hybrid clubs are starting to get bigger and bigger...they almost look like...I don't know...maybe like a......fairway wood? I don't know for sure, I'll leave it to you to judge, but maybe it's the manufacturers again...playing their marketing games. Only the future will tell. So maybe I lied about teaching you to hit a ONE Iron...just doing a little marketing!

The recent mild weather has allowed more opportunities to get out, stick a tee in the ground and light one up. As previously stated, my mission is to do the tedious ground work, The heavy duty, on-course research to bring you cigars that are flavorful and a value to help make your golf-cigar experience better. Who wants to have a harsh cigar ruin an otherwise great trip around the links?

Well after working my way through many good smokes and a few not so good ones, I kept going back to the Serie O by the Oliva Cigar Company. The Serie O is a Nicaraguan Puro. The same Habano seed is grown in diverse regions of Nicaragua to give it a distinctive blend.

On The Range

The appearance of the cigar has a nice leathery, medium brown wrapper that shows the richness you are about to experience. The aroma emanating from the cigar and the wrapper give you a tasty start as you prepare to light up.

Front Nine

At first, the smoke was just a bit dry. It could have been me or maybe it could have needed just a little more time in the humidor. But that dryness was temporary as it soon began developing its flavor. The burn was nice and even with a smooth draw.

Back Nine


By the halfway point, my taste buds were anticipating every next draw. It was reminding me of a bold, yet silky smooth cup of coffee with about the same kick. For a golf course smoke it's a nice balance between flavor and kick that I'm looking in a cigar and this one fills the bill nicely.




PGA GOLF MANAGEMENT STUDENTS TEAM UP TO CLEAN UP MANOKIN RIVER PARK


YOU KNOW THE DRILL

This is an old drill we used to get the feel or speed of the greens when we played a new course. Take 3 balls and putt towards a tee in the green about 15 feet away. With the first ball, hit your putt while looking only at the tee in the green. The second putt, hit it with your eyes closed towards the tee. The last ball, putt it normally at the tee in the green. Repeat this drill a few times and you will master the speed of the greens. You can also do this drill towards a hole, but a tee is a smaller target and it helps you focus more. Now you know the drill!

YOUR PATH TO PAR Richard Robinson- Instructor The Original Golf School



Golf is a dramatic game. It gives us opportunity to face risk reward situations and boldly attack or creatively circumvent the hazards lurking on the course and in our minds. If we meet the challenge we are gifted with the thrilling affirmation that we did it, and the hope and expectation we will do it again. If we fail we engrave the score card with the indelible memory of our failure quantified in a number.

Nothing can spoil a round, or dampen the enthusiasm of a golfing vacation, quicker than the one errant shot that leads to a catastrophic score on one hole. Why? One reason is our conditioning to focus on the bottom line. The score becomes our primary goal not playing the game. The best players play one shot at a time and let the score take care of itself. Easier said than done. Yet, there is a very good way to blend our quest for the quantitative affirmation of a good score, with the joy of meeting the challenges of the game. It is the British Stableford scoring The Stableford system is widely used in British amateur competitions where the combined challenge of weather and links courses almost guarantee "disaster" holes. It also speeds up the pace play so the typical 18 hole walking time is 3 ½ hours. The system is simple. You focus on scoring points not saving strokes. You "score" 1 point for a bogey, 2 for par, 3 for birdie, 4 for eagle, 5 for the rare double eagle, 0 points for double bogey or higher. The practical effects are dramatic. First, you can pick up the ball after playing the "bogey" stroke without the guilt of thinking you guit on the hole. Second, you begin to think shot by shot. An errant tee shot may eliminate the chance for birdie or par, but you can still score by making bogey. Playing more strategically and persistently may surprise you with scrambling pars. Third, you think like a winner. You don't "lose" strokes to Old Man Par or fear the Bogey Man, they give points to you! You can flirt with Disaster without making a life long commitment.


Lest you scoff at this approach as inauthentic, it has been used in Britain and around the world since 1898. Also, remember the USGA equitable stroke control system limits the number of double bogeys or higher in handicap calculation. If you insist on being bound to score thresholds try to score 10, 15,20, 25 or 30 Stableford points. A few years ago a trip to my visit father's Belfast home, I played my first Stableford round at Royal Portrush. I met a gentleman who played to a 34. Did a quadruple bogey on a hole called Calamity ruin his day. No. Let's see 2 point for par, 18 holes, 30 mph hour winds, waste high rough, holes named Calamity and Purgatory. Could he play? It was dramatic! It's was positive It was fun!

TOOLS OF THE TRADE VIDEO GAMES





While I am excited about the newest release from EA Sports, Tiger Woods 2012 this article isn't exactly about arcade video games. Don't get me wrong, I WILL be playing that Tiger game on PS3 and Wii because it features our Mecca, Augusta National. Unfortunately, this may be the closest the majority of us will get to check that item off our "Bucket List". The better point of this article is to promote video lessons from your Golf Instructor. Getting your golf swing on video used to be an arduous task. The camera and equipment were bulky. You needed to stabilize the camera and take the tape back to a VCR to play it. The video itself was grainy and hard to see when the instructor tried to slow it down. Normally, it wasn't easy to make a copy of the swing for you to take home. The higher cost of the video lesson usually made it a difficult pill to swallow when you wanted video instruction. Fear no more! The main point of a lesson that utilizes video is so the teacher can better explain by using visualization. Believe me, I have worked with a ton of students that thought they were swinging like Freddie Couples only to see their swing on video and describe it more like Fred Sanford. Many instructors are asking bloviated rates for simple video instruction. The simple truth, with today's technology the video aspect of teaching should be included in the price of the lesson. If you have a Smartphone, yes, there is an app for that. Some golf video apps are as little as \$3.99 to \$9.99. But, I do suggest you get a qualified set of eyes examining your work. Merely looking at your own swing you may not be able to see what a trained eye may be able to catch. In a simple quick video of a swing I can see many flaws that may be giving you trouble. The swing itself takes less than two seconds on average. The slow motion or stop frame ability during a swing can help your instructor quickly identify what is hurting your final product. With a video lesson, it is so much easier to assess each students address position, alignment, spine angle, takeaway, club head position and weight transfer, to name a few. We will have an easier view of fixing bad posture, inside club movement, squareness of club head, reverse pivot, lateral movement and over the top moves. Just one simple swing = hundreds of assessments. I love technology! If you would like to have your swing on a handy CD, stop by The "A" Game Golf Academy, we have 3 different video teaching areas! Don't worry, on rainy days, we'll hook up the Wii and play some Tiger too!
