The Oliva Serie V cigar has been at the top of my favorites list for a long time. Usually this cigar is reserved for a time when I can just settle back and enjoy the smoke away from the golf course. I have enjoyed it on the course but only when it was a special occasion. It's a bit

more than I want to pay for in a golf course cigar. That has changed now that I found the Oliva Serie V number 4.

> This cigar reminds me of one of my favorite Cuban's, the Partagas Habaneros. These little cigars pack a lot of punch.

The Oliva Serie V #4 is a 5" x 43 beauty, that while small in size, lasts a long time.

On The Range

The appearance is a nice medium brown wrapper with an almost velvety touch. It has a nice aroma with a touch of cedar and leather. It has a firmness to the roll due to the amount of tobacco wrapped in this little package. This is what helps to give it a nice long burn time.

Front Nine

It lights easily with a nice tight burn ring. While a tightly wrapped cigar, it draws in a very smooth manner. Early on there are earthy notes with some pepper and spicy hints.







EASTERN SHORE'S GEM, JENNY SULLIVAN RANKED 9TH IN THE NATION

Coach's Chalkboard was created to report on the latest and greatest news involving high school golf in our area. It affords me the opportunity to praise junior golfers for their accomplishments and give thanks to the people behind the scenes that make it possible for the kids to enjoy the game. In this issue of the Chalkboard, I am compelled to break away from high school golf and praise a former player of mine, Jenny Sullivan, who has recently experienced her greatest golfing accomplishment at the collegiate

Jenny was a member of the Stephen Decatur High School golf team for all four years, entering in 2005 as a freshmen with a nine hole average of 56. This shy girl with a kind and gentle personality, obviously inherited from her mother, Lori, possessed a tenacious drive to want to beat all the boys in every match. It was this passion for winning that grabbed my attention, and with the help of her father Mike, and Uncle Joey, she worked harder than any other player I've coached to improve. A relentless dedication to golf over the four years resulted in earning her the title #1 female golfer on the Eastern Shore of Maryland by the time she graduated in 2009. Her average improved to a 42 during her senior year, in which she won the District match at the Hyatt, shooting an 81, and taking home the Medalist honors among all the female golfers. Complimenting her golfing abilities was her impressive academic record throughout school, which resulted to a ranking of 18th in her graduating class of 350 with a 4.7 GPA. Her dream of playing collegiate golf became a reality with an acceptance into Methodist

University in Fayetteville, North Carolina, with an award winning golf program.

It wasn't easy for Jenny as a freshman on the team, struggling to qualify for matches and patiently waiting for her big break. The level of talent surrounding her was extremely impressive. Nevertheless, her drive and passion to get better and prove to herself that she had what it takes to be a competitive collegiate golfer, kept her positive and determined.

During her first few years on the Methodist team Jenny quietly began to make a move towards the top, qualifying for numerous events and helping her team to victories. In fact, last year she was named Methodist Scholar Athlete and USA South Academic All-Conference, earned the honor of becoming the team's Junior Captain for this season. But it wasn't until March 18, 2012, when she won first place in the Jekyll Island Women's Collegiate Golf Tournament, that she had arrived, as one of the top female golfers in the Nation (ranking her 9th overall).

Twenty one teams assembled on the beautiful Jekyll Island Country Club par 72 course, with a total of 112 players. Jenny's three round scores of 73, 75, and 76 distanced her from the field with a 5 stroke win and set an all time tournament record. Jenny's father, Mike, along with friends and relatives were on hand to witness her momentous accomplishment. Most impressive were her tee shots, only missing two fairways in all three rounds. Jenny commented after the final round, "I was able to put myself in places to score. One of my main goals was to make sure my tee ball

landed in the fairway." Jenny, along with her teammates coach. Tom Inczauskis, proudly held the trophy high, and celebrated a victory that she will never







GOLF COURSE


Game Coaches and Sport Psychologists have access to volumes of scientific research and empirical data to support the theories applied during counsel with athletes. Occasionally the most valuable and applicable nuggets of information are discovered when interviewing the elite within a sport. Case in point: Bubba Watson. The 2012 Masters Champion is described as a self-taught golfer who exhibited what many researchers acknowledged as the two most important keys (mental skills) of athletic success: Confidence and the ability to direct focus.

When asked to pinpoint what enabled the left-hander to emerge victorious and win the prestigious Green Jacket, Watson credited his ability to "leave the more important stuff behind" and focus on only task-relevant cues. The interview shed light on specific areas of concentration that can benefit golfers at every stage of development: Watson's perspective on priority may have led to a heightened sense of competitive enjoyment and a decreased level of performance anxiety because of his propensity to view Sunday at Augusta and the PGA major as purely a golf game. Additionally, Watson's awareness of the debilitating effect of distractions and the competence to identify and eliminate such variables from play could free vital attention capacity necessary to manage the championship course successfully.

Researchers have noted the critical importance of recognizing the External and Internal distractions that hinder peak performance, and have encouraged athletes to make a list of the potential roadblocks as a strategy toward controlling the volatile competitive environment. An external distraction could be a business or personal interest; an internal distraction could be doubt or hypertension. As Bubba so humbly demonstrated, determine what gets in the way, and then forget it.



GOLF FITNESS - NUTRITION

DR. PETE ZEMO

This month I want to talk briefly about nutrition. As most of you know, there are critical amounts of vitamins, minerals, phytochemicals, antioxidants, etc. that are required for a normal and healthy lifestyle. These are even more important for very active people and athletes, including golfers. You say "I eat plenty of fruits and vegetables, so I get all that I need right?" Probably wrong. Much has changed in the nutrient values of these products. Food is harvested before it is ripe; the soil it is grown in may have become depleted of important minerals. Chemical additives and preservatives are used. Many foods are stored for long periods of time before you get them. For example, the apples in your supermarket may have been picked up to fourteen months before you get them. Here is an example; the amount of vitamin C in one hundred grams of spinach in 1950 was 150mg. In 1994, that same amount of spinach held 13mg. The odds of you getting all that you need in your market is getting worse and worse. Maybe many of you have heard that a lot of the fruits and vegetable products sold by Whole Foods market (all organic right?) come from China. What do you think their standards for organic quality are?

So what can you do about it? Here is a quote from a recent issue of JAMA, The Journal of American Medical Association, "Most people do not consume an optimal amount of vitamins by diet alone. Pending strong evidence of effectiveness from randomized trials, it appears prudent for all adults to take vitamin


supplements." At our fitness club, we have been looking in depth at supplements on the market. We have on our staff, a registered nutrition/wellness coach, who works with our



members who want to improve their dietary lifestyle. She and I work together to implement their supplemental/dietary needs, just as our trainers and instructors work to improve their general physical fitness needs. If your facility does not provide services such as these to provide overall fitness, look elsewhere. The words "fitness club" should incorporate all things and not just be a "gym".




TOOLS OF THE TRADE BY STEVE MENZ



FOR INSTRUCTION "APP-ETITE"

The information age is finding its way into golf in a fairly unique way. Since the invention of the smart phone, people have been flooding the market with apps we can not live without. Well, make that until you grow tired of them. It gives new life to the old skit "I'd buy that for a dollar!" The price is so minimal or sometimes even free, that we won't think a second about dropping .99 cents on an application. In the golf market, you really should watch what you buy. There are a ton of apps out there that sound great in the description, but in reality stink! We can't trust the reviews either; as we do not know the skill level of the person reviewing the app. I have stumbled upon some must haves for any aspiring golfer. These apps will be in my iPhone for a long time. If it is improvement you would like, I have found these 3 apps to be the best. The Ping putting app. Yes while the app is free the Ping putting cradle will run close to \$30. This is well worth the price. This app will show you the flaws in your stroke pretty quickly. It measures tempo and square-ness of club face. It is a real eye opener. The V1 Pro golf app is a home run. It has taken software that has cost \$1000 in years past and placed it on your

smart phone for a mere \$4.99. You can now see your swing in all of it's glory and e-mail it to your local Pro so you can get on the right track. As for GPS's, I have tried two. It is a toss up between the Golfshot and Golf Logix. The free version of Golf Logix has a scorecard app that will help you analyze your game and it will e-mail it to you or your coach. Distances are accurate and graphics are good. It is taxing on the battery. You better have everything else shut down if you would like this app to last the round. The Golfshot app has excellent stats and is simple to use. It does charge a one time fee for the courses. It is a little more battery friendly. Both GPS's will do the job. They will save plenty of \$\$\$\$ over their counterparts. Buying a GolfBuddy or UPro will cost hundreds and require frequent downloads to keep each one current. The only drawback of using your smart phone I have found to this point is the battery life. Make sure you are going to the course with 100% on your phone. Let's face it, the smart phone batteries aren't up to speed yet. So if you have an appetite for instruction, download these apps and help yourself to some smarter golf!


class and dignity that he has made the Eastern Shore proud.







YOUR PATH TO PAR

RICHARD ROBINSON - INSTRUCTOR: THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL



Saving strokes on or around the green is the quickest way to improve your overall score. Good putting, chipping, and pitching skills can, as Walter Hagen observed, turn three strokes into two. Hagen was one of the all time great masters of the short game, but even he could be fooled on slippery fast sloping surfaces. He once putted off the

green and out of bounds onto Ardmore Ave. on the 12th green at Merion.


A good short game involves skillful technique and skillful assessment of the green. Technique enables you to execute the shot focused on the target and not the technique. However, as you prepare to tee off commit to playing the game you have that day. Better to have good target focus on the greens than to worry about faulty technique for a particular single round. You can immediately apply better assessment skills, without suffering paralysis by analysis. Here are three simple suggestions:


Before teeing off spend time trying to get the feel of green speed. Roll the ball specific distances without concern for holing out. Roll a few balls 5 feet so they stop close together. Then move to 10, 15, 20, 25 feet. Master the speed and distance control and you will make few three putts and several one putts. Remember the sense of speed is YOURS alone, not George Stimp's meter or your partners experience. Stroke each putt with the same tempo and grip pressure using the


length of the back swing and through swing to control distance. Generally, a slightly lighter grip pressure will get better results on fast greens and a firmer grip will adapt to slow greens. Tour green speeds are generally the same from week to week, and players putt great. The major exceptions are the U.S Open and Masters, with extremely fast conditions, and The British Open greens often slightly slower than tour standard. Even the best putters are challenged to adapt to the differences in green speed at these events.


On the course, begin to "read the green" as you approach it. Seeing contours from a distance is often more revealing than when on the green and watching approach shots roll give clues to your best next shot. Identify the "fall line" or direct uphill or down hill portion of the green that will affect your putt. Divide the green into quadrants and try to position approach shots that leave an uphill approach to the cup, minimizing the challenges of side hill putts. The green designs at Congressional for the U.S. Open featured an optimum quadrant for each pin position. An approach in the correct quadrant offered one-putt opportunities from 20 feet. In the wrong position a three putt from 10 feet was a distinct possibility. Make the slope your friend by playing up to the hole.

Finally, be real about your putting skill. Choose your line and your distance and make the putt. If the ball goes on the line and travels the distance, you intended it was a great putt, whether it went in the hole or not. The putt was good. The assessment was not. Congratulate yourself for a well-stroked putt, and know you will read the next putt more accurately. Golf is a continuous adventure in learning; join us at the Original Golf School to share the experience.




