SHORTY WAS A GREAT COMPETITOR AND GREW UP ON THE GOLF COURSE. AS A YOUNG MAN IN 1959, HE CADDIED AT OCEAN CITY GOLF CLUB. HE WAS ALSO A MEMBER OF STEPHEN DECATUR'S FIRST HIGH SCHOOL GOLF TEAM. HE LOVED BEING AROUND THE GAME-ESPECIALLY THE 12 YEARS HE AND HIS WIFE SHIRLEY MANAGED WINTERS QUARTERS GOLF CLUB. HE WON MULTIPLE TOURNEYS INCLUDING DPGA SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP, EASTERN SHOE AMATUER AND MULTIPLE CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS @ NASSAWANGO AND WINTERS QUARTERS.

HE SWUNG THE DRIVER LIKE HE WAS CHOPPING DOWN A TREE BUT COULD SEEMINGLY GET THE BALL UP & DOWN FROM ANYWHERE. IF HE WAS ANYWHERE INSIDE 20 FEET ON THE GREEN, YOU HAD BETTER BE PREPARED FOR HIM TO SINK THE PUTT."

The Ocean Pines Association and BCG began converting all greens on Ocean Pines' 18-hole golf course to United States Golf Association-specified A1 Bentgrass. The front nine was completed in May and work on the back nine began in December.

"This is the perfect time for the community to rediscover the many terrific attributes of Ocean Pines," says John Malinowski, PGA Director of Golf at Ocean Pines Golf & Country Club. "The course is the only Robert Trent Jones, Sr. design on Maryland's Eastern Shore, and the new putting surfaces ensure even better playability for golfers."

"We're proud of the work we've done with partner Billy Casper Golf," says Bob Thompson, General Manager of Ocean Pines Association. "The golf course will be more enjoyable than ever with the new greens."

In November 2010, BCG was selected to manage the semi-private Ocean Pines, overseeing all aspects of the operation, including marketing and public relations, golf course maintenance, staffing and training, merchandising, clubhouse food and beverage, financial management, golf instruction and special events.

Open to the public, Ocean Pines Golf & Country Club is part of an 8,000-home community. Its 18-hole, par-72, 7,050-yard layout is nestled amid natural wetlands and scenic woodlands. Five sets of tees and ample scoring opportunities dare players of all abilities to challenge themselves.

While Ocean Pines is open to the public, it boasts an active membership with associations for both men and women golfers. The associations conduct many social and golf events throughout the year and are also big supporters of junior golf. They organize the annual Ocean Pines Junior Golf Tournament and raise funds to provide scholarships to college students from area high schools.



During John's career he has been highly active with the PGA. In 2012 the Middle Atlantic section of the PGA honored John as their Professional of the Year. John is also currently serving as the Middle Atlantic section's 44th President. Prior to his Presidency, John served as the Section's Education and Membership Chair. John is also a member of the National PGA Education Committee and has achieved certification in all six areas of the PGA Certified Professional Program. Other Section awards on John's resume include the 2009 Bill Strausbaugh Award, 2006 Horton Smith Award and the 2002 President's Award.

BILLY CASPER had 51 PGA Tour wins in

his career, with his first coming in 1956. This total places him seventh on the all time list. His victories helped him finish third in McCormack's World Golf Rankings in 1968, 1969 and 1970, the first three years they were published. He won three major championships: the 1959 and 1966 U.S. Opens, and the 1970 Masters Tournament. He was the PGA Tour Money Winner in 1966 and 1968. He was PGA Player of the Year in 1966 and 1970. Casper won the Vardon Trophy for lowest scoring average five times: 1960, 1963, 1965, 1966, and 1968. He was a member of the United States team in the Ryder Cup eight times: 1961, 1963, 1965, 1967, 1969, 1971, 1973, 1975, and a non-playing captain in 1979. Casper has scored the most points in the Ryder Cup by an American player. Casper won at least one PGA Tour event for 16 straight seasons, from 1956 to 1971 inclusive, and this is the third-longest streak, trailing only Arnold Palmer and Jack Nicklaus, who each won on Tour in 17 straight years.

On the senior circuit, Casper earned Senior PGA Tour (now the Champions Tour) wins from 1982 to 1989, including two senior majors.







It's All In The Hips...

One of the all time classics is 'Happy Gilmore' and I think we can all agree on that. One of Chubb's most quoted lines is, "It's all in the hips, it's all in the hips." Man is he right, granted he was actually showing Happy how to sway and slide (which is wrong) but the principle is correct. Hip rotation is absolutely essential in the golf swing! Without it, your body has no ability to create upper/lower body separation, rotational power, coordination or stability.



The hips have 4 roles in the golf swing.

They are as follows (as a right handed golfer):

Backswing-

Right Hip Internal Rotation Left Hip External Rotation

Downswing-

Right Hip External Rotation Left Hip Internal Rotation

If all of these are not working properly, compensations will have to start being made. Let's compare some of this. Rory is one of the best swingers of the golf club, not to mention one of the most powerful hitters on tour pound for pound. I think he made that quite obvious when he airmailed Rickie Fowler's drive at Quail Hollow in the playoff with his 3-wood. How does he do this? Simple, it's all in the hips. On the way back, Rory stores all of his power into his right hip by internally rotating into it. How do we know? Look at his shoulder turn, it's incredible but notice his belt buckle, it is still almost face on. Therefore his hips are rotating internally and externally and not swaying. This causes a HUGE UPPER/LOWER BODY SEPARATION, aka, a ton of stored power and potential energy. Compare this to the amateur swing and notice the difference on the right side.

Then on the downswing, the hips can fire internally and externally as well in the opposite directions causing the 'whip' that you see in good players which is not only generating power, but consistency and a full body swing rather than a handsy or arms driven swing. Notice Rory on the way down and through clear his left hip (internal rotation) and allow his body to pull the club through the impact zone in a good position. Then compare it to our not so body-efficient friend and see the difference at impact.

You'll notice a couple of things. One is Rory's ability to clear the hips and create lag in the swing versus a 'casting' of the club to generate power. His belt buckle is already cleared the hitting area allowing room for his hands to come through smoothly, stay forward, and rip the living daylights out of the ball, all while remaining in control, balanced, and repeatable.

Easy Fixes: Increase hip rotation by doing some simple exercises to allow them to loosen up and allowing you to become a more efficient ball striker.







What High School Golfers Should Know For Summer Preparations COACH'SCHALKBOARD

- **1** Practice, practice, practice. Make the golf course and range your second home. Hit balls until it hurts. Serious high school golfers can be found on the course almost everyday during the summer.
- **2** Bayside golf matches are usually played from tees that are closest to 6300 total yards for men. Ladies will always play from the ladies tees in high school. No matter which course you are playing this summer, try to play from that distance or more.
- **3** Get involved in a junior tour. Summer tours afford young players with experiences in competition that can be extremely valuable. In fact, most college recruiters weigh a player's achievements on junior tours more heavily than their high school accomplishments (except for the state tournament).
- + Play the ball down. If you improve your lie by fluffing your ball up on a tuff of grass you are only hurting yourself. You must learn how to hit shots from bad lies to be the complete competitor.
- **5** Learn the rules of the game. Get a USGA rulebook and study it. Penalties are assessed during practice rounds, qualifying rounds, and matches for any and all infractions. Ignorance to the rules is not an excuse.
- **6** Learn to control your anger. Swearing, club throwing, kicking objects, etc. will NOT be tolerated at all. Act with maturity and control on and off the course.
- **7** Get a physical if you haven't already done so. Physicals are valid in public high school for 365 days. Permission slips, physical forms, emergency forms, etc. will be due before you are permitted to play. Don't wait too long and assume the doctor can see you on short notice.

- **8** Don't concentrate on driving as much as your short game. Chipping and putting win tournaments.
- **9** Walk the course when you play. You must have strong legs. Often high school golfers are able to post good scores for their front nine, but many times they tire on the back nine due to weak legs. I see it happen every year during our 18 hole matches. Strong legs help a strong finish.
- **10** Don't take golf for granted. It's not a right, it's a privilege. However, any player who does not exhibit respect for the game, the facilities, and the people involved may be dismissed. You must have control over your bodily functions. You are representing your school and you are a reflection of your coach.
- **11** Enjoy the sport. It is one of the few sports that can be played for a lifetime. Don't let the game control you. You control the game. Everyone has their share of horrible rounds, as well as awesome ones. You will hit a slump this summer and at other times strike the ball with resounding confidence. Don't give up. Don't be a quitter.
- **12** Remember to always respect and appreciate those who give you the opportunities in life to play golf.
- **13** Good Luck in your preparations for the upcoming season. Practice, play, and learn from those golfers whom you respect.





HEPRO SSPLOSION

I would like to describe for you a little known, and less used golf shot. It's little known 'cause I just made up the name, and it's little used because: 1: it's a very dangerous and low percentage shot; and 2: because it's scary. I first learned of the shot from my mentor, friend, and enemy to superintendents Bret "the digger" Marshall (of Ruddo's Golf fame). I was in a bit of a pickle just off a green, and had a horrible, deep, dark lie, had to pitch uphill over a hump, and to a tight pin...just over the hump...IM-POSS-I-BLE!!! Bret suggested playing the shot like a bunker shot. I did, and the "grassplosion" was born.

I have used the technique to great success in the 20 years or so since, and in fact, just recently passed it on to one of my Wi High Golf Team players...one Tyler Joven. We were in the process of winning the Nutter's Crossing Member/ Guest tournament, when Tyler missed the 11th green short and to the right. He called me over to look at his unfortunate predicament, and this is what he was faced with: lie in a hole between clumps of deep rough; shot of 20 yards uphill over a bunker and a mound; tight pin with no room to work with; IM-POSS-I-BLE!!! I say, "Play it like a bunker shot. Take a big swing, hit 2 to 4 inches behind the ball (in other words hit it "fat" on purpose...not PHAT (pretty hot and tasty), and not fat (as in obese or over weight). Swing pretty hard with your sand wedge (not sandwitch) and follow through, and the divot of grass and dirt will throw the ball up in the air like a greenside bunker shot!" He says, "you're kidding right?" I say, "no really...try it." So he does, and he knocks it right up on the green about 6 feet, and makes the putt for par! "That was a great shot!" I say.

This shot is not for the faint of heart, and should only be used in the most dire of situations. But if you've got no choice, try the "grassplosion" and just maybe you will hit a miraculous shot as well...good luck!




YOUR PATH TO PAR

RICHARD ROBINSON - INSTRUCTOR: THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL


What are your expectations? This is a critical recurring question. It is a determining factor in achieving the range of goals for your development as a golfer. Broad long range goals such as lowering your handicap, to the immediate goal of making the next shot are linked to your expectations. The elated anticipation of hitting a shot or making a putt when in the "zone" certain you will succeed is countered by the frustration, when doubt creates the expectation of inevitable failure. Developing a method to create positive expectations is a key to better play.

Your pre round warm up should be focused on creating positive expectations. Routines vary and are limited by the available time and facilities. However, there are a few fundamentals that prepare you for success. First, seek flexibility, stretch, swing a weighted club, take a few deep breaths, and relax. Second, set you tempo. Think of you swing as a dance, walk to the music, begin to synch all your movements to you swing tempo. Third, hit a few tees. Practice swings for balance and tempo hitting tees instead of a ball gives you focus on precise contact without negative feedback of errant ball flight. Fourth, hit chips, pitches, and short irons from perfect, even teed up lies. The purpose is to feel good clubface ball contact and reinforce balance and tempo. Now is not the time to "dig it out of the dirt". Hit a few tee shots and accept you tendency for the day. If you normally draw the ball, but are suddenly hitting fades, accept it and expect to play that tendency at least on the initial few holes. If you are miss hitting limit you analysis to checking your grip and set up. Finally, on the putting green seek to get distance control. Make putts of varying lengths to a ball marker or tee, with the goal of grouping the balls at specific distances. If you can stop a ball on a "dime" from 2, 4, 10, or 20 feet getting it in the hole will seem simple.

RULES OF GOLF

I guess it's my turn to weigh in on the crazy events at the 2013 Masters. As usual, this year's Masters didn't disappoint featuring some great golf and, as always, even more drama. I, like most golfers, try to abide by the rules of golf to the best of my knowledge. Golf is a great game with many rules and I have always been of the opinion that there are some bad rules as well. Which brings me back to this year's Masters. I never thought it was fair to disqualify a player for signing an incorrect scorecard when they were simply making an honest mistake. I still believe it was a travesty in the 1968 Masters to penalize Roberto De Vicenzo for signing an incorrect scorecard that was being kept by his playing opponent, Tommy Aaron. Aaron made the mistake of giving him a 4 on 17 instead of a birdie 3 that De Vicenzo had made on the hole. De Vicenzo shot 65 that day and everyone knew it. But they gave him the higher score of 66 which took him out of a tie for the lead and a chance at a Green Jacket. C'mon Man he wasn't cheating, the man was caught up in the moment and made an honest mistake and at least in my mind deserved a chance to correct his mistake. Not only did De Vicenzo lose, but golf fans also missed out on what could have been another dramatic finish at the Masters. That leads me to this year's Masters and the bad drop by Tiger Woods. I would say any reasonable golf fan would have to admit that Tiger was not intentionally trying to cheat. But like De Vicenzo, he was caught up in the moment and made a critical mistake when taking his drop. The rules committee did a great job of explaining the new rule that protects players from being disqualified for infractions like this one. In the end the punishment fit the crime and Tiger took his medicine and moved on and golf fans didn't have to miss out on the best player in the world competing for another major championship. Tiger benefited by the new rule but Roberto Di Vicenzo got hosed in '68. The USGA should change the rule in regards to signing an incorrect scorecard and call it the De Vicenzo rule. After changing that one, maybe they should let us all tap down spike marks!

TOOLS OF THE TRADE

SWING YOUR SWING




I have been contacted by many of our on-line readers and I thought "why not make the articles a little more interactive?" If you are reading on your PC or tablet, click the link below. If you are reading the hard copy just pull out your smart phone and search Arnold Swing your swing.

During this year's Masters, Arnold Palmer gave you the best advice you can ever hear. http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=MkX6xQM_QE8 you need to have the freedom to swing freely. Let your body react to the line you preselected before the shot

He isn't telling you that you are swinging correctly. He is telling you that you must trust the move you are going to make on that ONE particular shot. You know your tendencies, but do you trust them? About 13% of the golfers seek golf instruction; the other 87% still believe they are lifting their head. When you seek expert advice, it is up to you to practice the move until you can do it without thinking about it. Swing your swing means that even though you prefer your normal ball flight to be a fade, but on the range this morning you are hitting a draw, play it. Swing your swing all the way to the finish and hold the pose. Visualize (Period). Don't have a swing thought in your head of what you want it to be, just let it be. Don't hit at it, just swing. Human nature is a beast. The tendency to hit at the ball is so strong. The golf swing is a reaction. The golf club is a tool. Consider the 9 iron

as a hammer. You use it to drive a nail. You don't think about how far you are going to draw back the hammer, you just use it. To be accurate you shouldn't swing the hammer as hard as you can, you make moderate controlled strokes. The 8 iron is a screw driver; you certainly shouldn't use a hammer for the job of a screwdriver. You certainly can, but don't expect the job to be pretty. That is the beauty of a golf swing. I have a situation in front of me concerning yardage, elevation, and wind and ball flight. I choose my club and react. Swing your swing. The absolute best advice I have ever received has been from an amateur friend. He happens to be one of the best putters and players I have ever met. His golf swing I wouldn't teach to anyone. It is his, and he owns it. A couple of years ago he lost his faith in his golf swing and tried to modify. He was plagued by mechanical thoughts during his swing. This didn't let him swing freely. He visited me last fall and I asked him a very simple, complex question. "What do you think about when you putt?" His reply was priceless. "I don't. I pick a spot in front of my ball, line my

ball up to it then I sing a lyric to a song I know during my swing and let it flow." I said, "Apply that to your golf swing." Again this is one of the best putters I have ever met in my life so I applied it to my putting stroke and I couldn't be more pleased with the outcome.



NOW IT SWINGS.

STRENGTH&FLEXIBILITY!

Now that it appears winter is finally behind us, the time has come to prepare for the upcoming golf season. Be aware that if you hung up the clubs last fall, you can't just pick them up and go right back to the shape your body and game was in at that time. Changes will have occurred in your strength and flexibility; your game will not, in all likelihood, be the same. So you have to do a little training. I will list some of the body areas you should start working on 4-6 weeks before you hit the links.

UPPER BODY It has been shown numerous times that the big muscles of the upper body are more important for

generating clubhead speed than the muscles below the elbow. This area can be whipped into condition with exercises like pushups, biceps curls and triceps extensions. Doing dips from a chair or bench is also a great strengthener. When you start these exercises, start with a weight or situation that permits you to do at least 15 reps without excessive straining.

DR. PETE ZEMO

CORE STRENGTH This involves the muscles of the abdomen and back. Abdominal crunches and back extensions are the classic maneuvers. Or, take classes in pilates at your fitness center.

LOWER BODY Squats for the quadriceps and hamstring curls for the back of the leg are the most important.

FLEXIBILITY Stretching the entire body after you have warmed up and finished your strength exercises is paramount. The overall most effective step is to participate in some yoga classes. Contrary to what you might think, anyone can do it; it is just a matter of only doing as much as you can comfortably. As I have said before, the old maxim "no pain, no gain" does not apply to general conditioning.

If you are unsure about the things listed or how to accomplish them, my most prudent advice is to consult with a qualified trainer. The time and effort you expend will be more than worth it – and, your game will definitely thank you.







YOU KNOW THE DRILL

JOE ASKED ABOUT CHIPPING...

We took this question from our facebook page "A" Game Golf Academy. We asked, "What area of the game you would like a drill to make your practice sessions more successful?" Joe Betro wanted a drill to help with chipping and stressed that it was an area of the game that people rarely practice and is pivotal to scoring. Well, you are right Joe! Here is a drill that will make your chipping motion better whether you are hitting a bump and run or using a sand wedge for a little more height. Stand with your feet close together, maybe a few inches. Place the ball just inside the instep of the right foot. Place 70% of your weight on your left foot. Address the ball and then take your left hand and put it in your left pant pocket. Keep only your right hand on the club and practices some chips. Make sure you maintain your wrist angle (keep your knuckles behind the thumb) from the address position through the shot. Let your body release the club as it rotates to the target. This will ensure crisp clean contact and eliminate any "scooping" motion. Thanks Joe! 



SHORE UP Carson Lovett, MA Sport Psychology WITH THE GAME COACH

The popularity of golf continues to spread across the globe, witnessed on the courses of our Shore and in the parity of recent champions crowned winners of Major tournaments. Concentrated efforts to capitalize on the momentum of esteem for the grand game extend far beyond the active participant, yielding remarkable advances in proficiency and performance enhancement. This universal movement encourages scientists and academia to consider golf research an increasingly exciting and fruitful field of study with substantial implications for success in sport and society.

In a recent analysis discussed at the World Scientific Congress of Golf, the investigator tracked eye movements during putts finding a debilitating variation in focus for the novice golfer compared to elite players. 
Front Nine

The burn was consistent with an easy draw. Drew Estate advertises this as a full-bodied cigar. But, I found the kick to be more medium, which is fine for the golf course.


ELBOW GREASE

I don't know about you, but I seem to get more than my fair share of plugged lies in the bunkers. A few years back I learned a way to get out that works well. With a good lie, you set up with the clubface anywhere from square to open depending on the shot you need to play. With the plugged lie, use the elbow of the club to act as a funnel to dig into the sand and force the ball up and out. The elbow is what I'm calling the curvature where the hosel meets the clubface when it is toed inward. Now keep in mind, you're not hitting the shot with the clubface. You're actually hitting it with the elbow. To play the shot, set up with the club as you see above. Hinge very early on the take-away and stop about waist high. From there, rotate hips and drive the elbow into the sand about an inch behind the ball. The ball will come out somewhat hot, with no spin, but it will come out. I will usually use the 60 degree wedge to help minimize the roll. As with any shot it takes a bit of practice to get used to it. I hope you never need it, but if you


