
of her car until we convinced her to snap a picture of us standing on our beautiful piece of heaven! "





As the weather continues to warm up, a lot of us are anticipating another fun golf season. First, however, we have to deal with getting our bodies (and minds) in shape for the upcoming physical activity. And for many of us this involves handling a very common sequela of the winter layoff- joint pain. Here I am not referencing the pain caused by significant medical conditions, such as Phil Mikelson's psoriatic arthritis. I mean just the little aches and pains that all of us experience from time to time and that have been shown, by proper medical evaluation, not to be of a more serious nature- just the ones that we treat with a little aspirin or similar pain reliever.

One of our gym members is a certified nutrition coach; she and I both have experienced the annoyance of minor joint pain and have both tried various circuitous routes to treat it. Interestingly enough, we both independently tried many of the same treatment options and both arrived at something that worked-at least, for the two of us. What we found was relief using a common over-thecounter drug called glucosamine. But what we both also found was that relief also depended on how the drug was taken and whether or no it was taken with ancillary ingredients. To make a long story short our best results were obtained when glucosamine was taken in combination with a substance called hyaluronic acid, an effective joint lubricant, and with a potent antioxidant called pycnogenol. There is a company that makes this combination. They left out the chondroitin because of its high molecular weight and poor absorption. Interestingly enough, they produced this product in an isotonic form that allows its rapid and more complete absorption. Since this article is not a commercial operation, I will not mention the name of the overthe-counter product. Suffice it to say I and the nutrition coach have been using it for some time now with excellent results. It is taken once a day and is very easy to use. Actually, I have begun to take it along with another product this company makes for other reasons, but the two seem to work quite well together.

I am sure everyone has their pet cure for joint pain, whether it be anti-inflammatories, specific diets, chiropractic treatment, various exercises, etc. My bottom line is if one of those works for you, continue it. ### YOU KNOW THE DRILL **BALANCE = FAIRWAYS**

If you are having trouble keeping it in the short stuff off the tee, take a good look at your finishing position. If you are having troubles holding a solid balanced position as the ball flies down the fairway then there is a good chance you are swinging the driver too hard. A good finishing position should have all of your weight on your left foot (for right handers) and your chest should be centered over your left knee. If you can't get to that position you are simply swinging too hard. Good balance will result in straighter shots and more fairways hit. Try gearing down on your driver and swinging it at about 70 percent and watch your fairways hit in regulation soar. Believe it or not you will sacrifice little to no distance, most will even gain a few extra yards! Now you know the drill!

Imagine your favorite Bar-B-Que joint going into the cigar business. This is what they should come up with. The smoked hickory and oak aroma is abundantly evident upon first pre-light sniff. The wrapper is a beautiful deep, matte brown in color. I just enjoy smelling this cigar without lighting it.



Right from the start, the hickory and oak flavors hit you, but in a smooth, creamy way. Not over-powering at all, however if there are other nuances in flavor, I'm having trouble detecting them because I am enjoying the smoked wood. It remains consistent as we approach the back nine. The draw is smooth as well and the body is medium, which suits it just fine for golf.

### Back Nine

The smooth, creaminess of the oak and hickory continued right to the finish. Often cigars develop new flavors from the drawing of smoke as you near the end. The KFC never changed. As I enjoyed the smoked wood flavor, I actually found that it enhanced the flavor of the fine Canadian whiskey that accompanied the cigar during this review. I would like to write more but I am having a sudden craving for a nice rack of ribs right about now!










I don't know about the rest of you (well, actually I do), but as a golfer I'm always looking for an edge from the tee to the green. What if you could gain an advantage by simply choosing the right pair of sunglasses? Usually its color, style, maybe the weight and most likely whether my wife thinks they look good. Last on my list was whether the lens was appropriate for golf.

I had a chance to compare Oakley's G30 Iridium lens up against a non-golfspecific Oakley lens. The switch to the G30 lens showed an immediate and dramatic difference in what using the right lens can do for your vision. Non-golf-specific lenses do as they should, darken the view and reduce some glare. However, what the G30 lens does is reveal the hidden contours and textures in closely mown areas. Tracking the ball flight was also much easier.

The Oakley G30 Iridium lens will not increase your distance off the tee, but it will improve your view of what lies in front of you. With this extra confidence, I am sure the scorecard will look better too. Stop by Ruddo's Golf in West OC, Fenwick Island or Lewes, DE to test them yourself!

### **EXPECTATIONS**

After winning the Masters in 1997, Tiger Woods decided he needed to change his swing. He chose Butch Harmon, one of the top teachers in the game for the job. While Tiger was working on his changes, David Duval became the number one player in the world. Vijay Singh's Caddy, Paul Tesori wore a hat that said "Tiger who?" He took some abuse while he was not in his top form, but he stuck with it knowing it would pay off in the long run.

Now, how many balls do you think Tiger hit each day, with a top teacher by his side? It still took him a year and a half to come out and say "I have it!" He then went on to win the "Tiger Slam" winning the four majors in a row, but in two years. Now if it took the game's best golfer, with a great teacher, a year and a half to get his swing down to where he believes he "has it", why would you get upset if you didn't "have it" after one lesson and a little or even no practice? Tiger certainly understood what Butch was telling him and he could do it pretty early in the process. By "having it" he meant owning it. He could do it as needed, under pressure and it took time to engrain.

Enjoyment level is directly related to expectations. If you are only able to play once a week and you consider hitting a couple of balls before playing as practice, you shouldn't be terribly upset if your play is less than stellar. If you keep your expectations realistic to your current situation you may find that you'll enjoy your round much more. The best tour pros have a greens in regulation percentage of 72%. That means they miss about four greens per round. Why should you be down on yourself if you miss a few more than that and you probably haven't hit as many practice balls as they have that week. Even Ben Hogan, who set the standard for practice in his day, would expect at least three misses during a round. That way he wouldn't be upset when the bad shot showed up. Sure, you can give it your best on every shot, but if your expectations match your ability, you'll be a happier

golfer and might even play better as a result.

the good shot outweighs the consequence of the poor ones. In fact, an errant shot is just an opportunity to make a spectacular recovery. What's done is done just look to the future, is the natural wisdom of youth and is a useful mindset for playing every shot and every age.

This summer there are several opportunities for young players to have fun learning and enjoying the game. Some include the best of all golfing experiences pairing adult and junior players in team competitions. Teaching skillful techniques establishes the foundation for improved performance. ## SHORE UP Carson Lovett, MA Sport Psychology WITH THE GAME COACH

#### **KNOW THYSELF!**

A critical review of the final round of the 2014 Masters Golf Tournament reveals the discriminating dichotomy between the perceived mental dynamic of the experienced athlete opposed to that of the beginner. Sport Psychologists and game coaches will contend that inside the mind of Bubba Watson, the seasoned professional and 2012 Masters Champion, the left brain, associated with verbal and analytical functioning, was calm and quiet allowing the right brain, linked to visual and spatial processing, to optimally perform and focus on task-relevant cues such as distance and contour. Conversely, Jordan Spieth, the tenderfoot twenty year old, Under Armour clad, praiseworthy contender and standalone leader by three strokes on the fourth hole of day four may have succumbed to the pressure associated with leading down the stretch at Augusta; an over-stimulated conscious excessively concerned with the routine steps necessary to close out the competition and become golf's youngest Major champion interferes with

the precious attention capacity of the first-timer permitting Watson, the wily veteran, to seize the moment for a second Green Jacket. Wisdom, maturity and the implicit comfort that comes from winning the tournament two years prior against the anxiety of youth and the challenge to make history and accomplish a first in the sport likely doomed Spieth, the up and coming star.

Examining, recognizing and applying the principles at work within the relationship between the champion versus the novice may provide valuable insight into the dominion of skill acquisition and progression. The heart of the mental game within the game of golf lies in understanding individual levels of expertise and proceeding accordingly.
