Maryland men's basketball team. Maryland posted 28 wins last season, an eleven-game improvement from its 17 victories during the 2013-14 season.

The Terps finished their inaugural season in the Big Ten with a perfect 9-0 home record, which included victories against then-No. 5 Wisconsin, Michigan State and Indiana. Overall, Maryland concluded with an 18-1 home mark at XFINITY Center.

Maryland's 14-1 record to start the 2014-2015 season marked its best start in 18 years (1996-97). Turgeon has posted 28 wins this season – the fourth time he has posted at least 25 wins in his career. Turgeon's winning percentage of .600 (42-28) was the best mark by a Maryland coach in his first two seasons, ahead of Bud Millikan (.592) and Gary Williams (.574). After bringing in a top-15 recruiting class in 2012, he led the Terrapins to a 25-13 record (most wins in six seasons) and appearances in the ACC Tournament semifinals and the NIT semifinals in 2012-13.

Turgeon has led his teams to a winning season in 14 of his 17 seasons, including a current streak of 13 consecutive winning seasons. Turgeon, who came to College Park after directing Texas A&M to four consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament, led Maryland to a 17-15 record in 2011-12. At A&M, he posted a 97-40 record in four seasons and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in both 2010 and 2011. He is the only coach in Big 12 history with at least 24 victories in each of his four seasons.

Turgeon is 337-209 through 17 seasons overall as a head coach. Inseven years at Wichita State, he built the Shockers into a power in the Missouri Valley Conference, earning the league title and an NCAA Sweet Sixteen appearance in 2006. In that NCAA Tournament, Wichita State beat Seton Hall and Tennessee before losing to eventual Final Four participant George Mason.

Turgeon amassed a 128-89 record at Wichita State (2000-07), posting the third-most wins in school history. The Shockers advanced to three straight NITs from 2003 to 2005 in addition to the 2006 NCAAs, the first time WSU had four straight postseason appearances in 40 years. A point guard at Kansas from 1984-87, Turgeon was the first player in Jayhawks history to play in four straight NCAA Tournaments. KU went 108-33 under Brown in that stretch. Turgeon served as team captain in his junior and senior seasons, leading the Jayhawks to the 1986 NCAA Final Four.

A native of Topeka, Kan, Turgeon led Hayden High School to back-to-back Class 4A state titles in 1982 and 1983, earning all-tournament honors each year. A first team all-state pick as a senior, Hayden went 47-3 in his high-school career.

In the summer of 2008, Turgeon was inducted into the Topeka Sports Hall of Fame.

Coach Turgeon has spent a lot of time around the game of golf and fell in love with it at a very young age. The son of the Topeka Kansas City Champion had a club put in his hands at the early age of 8. 

Being someone who is familiar with overcoming life's challenges, there was no way **JAMES ROBINSON** was going to let a PGA Playing Ability Test (PAT) get in the way of his new aspirations and dreams. A native of Hampton Roads, Va., Robinson joined the Unites States Army


as a Medical Laboratory Specialist in February of 1995. While serving his country, Robinson was a member of the 226th Medical Logistics Battalion stationed in Balad, Iraq during Operation Iraqi Freedom from October 2005 to October 2006. While deployed, Robinson sustained a vertebral injury that required surgery to fuse parts of his spine together to stabilize his entire spine. After his surgery, Robinson was assigned to the Warrior Transition Unit (WTU) in Fort Eustis, Virginia which would aid in his physical and mental recovery and ultimately determine if he would be allowed to finish his military career.

Although Robinson had become an avid golfer prior to his injury, he assumed his surgery would render him no longer able to play. To his surprise, one of the many programs the WTU offered to Robinson and his peers was a golf program run by PGA General Manager Andy Weissinger and his staff at the Fort Eustis Pines Golf Course and supported by the Salute Military Golf Association. Robinson began to realize that playing golf "provided a positive outlet for my need to be competitive, and also proved to be a healthy means of stress release." In 2012, the Army Medical Evaluation Board found Robinson was fit to return to active duty, but after completing 20 years of military service, Robinson had a different plan in mind.

With the guidance and support from family and friends, particularly Weissinger, Robinson decided to change his career path and seek a new future in the professional golf industry. Robinson is currently attending the University of Maryland Eastern Shore as a PGA Professional Golf Management (PGM) student and recently passed his PAT at Great Hope Golf Club in Westover, Maryland. As someone who has always put others first, Robinson made sure to recognize a fellow Wounded Warrior in the program, Matthew Kern, who is in his final year of the degree plan. Robinson remarked that "golf has given me many things, a good way to pass the time, a great way to meet new people, a positive way to relieve stress, and a new career path. Most importantly, golf has shown me, as well as many of my other brothers and sisters in arms, that even though we may have physically and mental limitations, we are by no means limited."

#### PATRICK BRETT "FIRST ROUND OF A LIFETIME" RECIPIENT PHILADELPHIA-BASED NONPROFIT LAUNCHES, ANNOUNCES FIRST GOLF DREAM TRIP

Philadelphia-based nonprofit Round of a Lifetime Foundation believes that life is about memories. That especially holds true for people with lifethreating ailments, such as Patrick Brett of Blue Bell, Pennsylvania, who suffers from the heart condition Tetralogy of Fallot.

Round of a Lifetime was established in 2010 by friends and family of Philadelphia's Andrew Maciey, who passed away from Familial Dilated Cardiomyopathy at the age of 24. His surviving friends and family fondly recall spending time on the golf course with Andrew and established the Foundation which grants rounds of golf on world-class courses to those who may not otherwise have the opportunity to do so.

"We want to create lasting memories like ours for others who suffer from congenital heart disease," said Round of a Lifetime President Joe Maciey, Andrew's cousin. "We're so pleased to be awarding our first round to Patrick, who started playing golf only after he could no longer play organized sports due to his illness."

Twenty-nine-year-old Brett was selected from a group of candidates put forth from University of Pennsylvania Hospital. A guidance counselor and baseball and basketball coach at North Penn High School in Lansdale and married with an infant daughter, Brett underwent his first open-heart procedure at two years of age to close his atrial and ventricular septal defects, as well as repair his tricuspid valve. At age 19, he had a second open-heart surgery with pulmonary valve replacement and resection of his right ventricle. In 1999, he had a defibrillator implanted, which has been replaced twice. And, in 2011, he had a new valve placed in the catheterization lab.





"It's tough to put into words. Being someone who has congenital heart disease, I've had my brushes with death," said Brett. "Being a father now and understanding what my parents went through, it makes it more special to me personally. To have this opportunity because of a man who passed away at my age, it means so much to me."

Thanks to Round of a Lifetime and its sponsors, Brett, who will celebrate his 30th birthday on November 24, has been granted a foursome of golf next spring at Congressional Country Club in suburban Washington, DC, the site the 2011 U.S. Open and host to U.S. Presidents and other dignitaries since 1921.



### SHORE UP WITH THE GAME COACH

Carson Lovett, MA Sport Psychology

When a quarterback drops back into a pocket of protection with time to read the defense his success rate goes up. He's more comfortable. It's like practice and he gets closer to the routine where his sole focus is downfield. Blitzing linebackers and bodies falling around the quarterback can divide his attention, and the ability to concentrate on the entire field shrinks. Allow a great shooter to set her feet and get a clear look at the rim and her shooting percentage rises. If the hand of a defender flashes into the sightline she misses the same shot more than she makes it. A marksman able to rest her rifle on a tripod and lock in on the bull's-eye will be within the rings with every shot. Add time or weather constraints and even the best miss the target. An athlete's state of mind in the moment he decides to act controls the body's response, and every aspect of the Pre-Shot Routine that makes it into the execution phase means more attention available for task specific focus, critical to success for golfers.

Golf may be the most mentally challenging sport because more of its variables impact performance like blitzing linebackers and hands in the face. A golfer's biggest obstacle is often the analytical voice in his head ready to provide feedback for every action. Learning to use Self-Talk as a tool to stay in the routine leads to a more enjoyable golfing experience and strengthens the will to achieve. Research suggests Self-Talk is most effective when describing instead of judging. During the good times, Self-Talk sounds optimistic; when the shots spray it's easy to say "I played terrible today," which is the blitz and the hand in the face of golfers. The unfavorable judgment opens the door for negative tendencies that might last a round or a weekend or a season. Turning "I played terrible today" into "I kept lifting me head up" or "I'm over-swinging" encourages the mind to draw from the descriptors, each performance becomes a lesson, a positive habit forms and more of the good times roll.

#### IT'S FLU SEASON! BY PETE ZEMO 'WOC FITNESS'

Fall is here and we are rapidly approaching the flu season, so in this article I want to touch on important facts about that. As you all know, the medical community pushes the vaccine, which is good (and bad), the bad being the fact that not everyone who is vaccinated is protected. Last year the statistics showed that less than 20% of those getting the shot developed protection from the prevailing virus strains. In a good year that percentage can approach 60%, but no one knows for sure because of the propensity for the viral strains to change, a phenomenon called "drift". There are other things to consider, one of which, as I am sure you know, is tamiflu, the fairly effective antiviral oral drug. This, however, needs to be started when the earliest symptoms of the flu appear.

#### But what I want to emphasize is that the other parameter of defense is the strength of your own immune system, which can be cranked up a number of ways by most people.

So let me run through a number of ways this can be done, and I urge you to search the specifics of these on your own. While there are a lot of things out there that are known to do this (Vit C, Vit D, etc.), the ones I like the most, and that my wife and I use routinely, are probiotics, which enhance immune responses by promoting the growth of good GI bacteria. We use one called Culturelle which has been shown to be a top quality choice. The next is something called N.A.C., which stands for N-acetyl cysteine. This is what is called a precursor of glutathione, another potent antioxidant and viral enemy. The last is elderberry syrup. Taken a teaspoon a day during flu season and upping it to 4 times a day if symptoms appear has been shown to have definite benefits.

Again, use common sense- avoiding exposure to those who have the flu when you can, using good hand washing techniques, and so on. None of these can guarantee you won't get sick, but you will have given yourself an edge- and good luck.

### **TOOLS OF THE TRADE**





What a year young Jordan Spieth has accomplished. Won two Majors and contended strongly in the other two. He crowned it off with an amazing win of the Fed Ex Cup. While the world is hungry for the next "Heir Apparent" they have thrown the belt in several directions. Today's young stars have surely stepped up to the bar raised so high by his Tigerness. Jordan Spieth, Rory McIlroy and Jason day have been playing unbelievable golf. But what has set Jordan Spieth apart from the other incredible athletes? It was purely his putting stroke. During Tiger's incredible run, it was his ability to make everything he looked at that catapulted him to the top. Now I see that in Jordan. What is the big difference in his putting than others? When Jordan gets within 12 feet of the hole, he looks at the hole when he putts. Try it out, it's a little freaky. But it makes complete sense. When you are shooting baskets you look at the hoop. Throwing baseballs, you look at the target. When you are shooting darts, again you are looking at the target. Quite simply, when you are in control of shooting the projectile you focus on the target. Keeping your eye on the ball in this case is different. The ball isn't moving like in baseball. What does this accomplish for Jordan? It allows him to keep his head and eyes extremely still helping him to roll it better. Sometimes when looking at the ball our eyes tend to follow the putter head causing us to not hit the putt as pure as we would like. Next time you go to the course, get on the practice green and start looking at the hole during the stroke on two to four foot putts. I concentrate on a specific spot "in" the hole. It will be a different feeling especially when you see the ball rolling out of your periphery, but I am sure your head will remain perfectly still and you will roll it better!

## YOU KNOW THE DRILL COINUP BY STEVE MENZ

Coins have been used for years in golf. Jack Nicklaus has been rumored to keep three pennies in his pocket every round he plays. He carries one to mark his ball on the green and two for his playing companions. While it is true using a coin is proper golf etiquette for marking your ball, did you know you can use them to help you make more putts? A secret of all good putting strokes is hitting up on the ball at impact to roll the ball with top spin and no skidding. Here is a simple trick that can help you to hit your putts properly.

Stack two coins on top of each other and place them right behind your ball. Stroke your putt and strike the ball without hitting the coins. What you should see is a ball that rolls truer. The loss of skid will keep your ball on line longer.

T AIN'T OVER - TILL IT'S OVER

Here I am standing on the 18th tee at Talbot CC with club in hand preparing for a playoff. About an hour ago Butch Butler and I finished the Four Ball Tournament at two under par in the Senior Division. Butch informed me that he wasn't coming to the dinner and awards presentation because he had a prior commitment and had to leave. Well, we both forgot about the playoff in case of a tie. You can probably figure out what happened next. We have a tie for first place!" What could I do at this point but go get ready. So here I am on the tee waiting for the playoff to begin. I congratulated my opponents on their round and got set to begin. I got the honors by luck of the draw. I remembered that I had hit a five iron the previous time I played the hole. I decided to go with a four hybrid. Going through my pre-shot routine I remembered Yogi Berra's "It ain't over til it's over!" Two against one in golf is much different than in any other sport. This is a game of shots, one on one against the course. So I focused on what I needed to do. I hit my shot to the front on the fringe under the hole and proceeded to two putt for par to tie my opponents. We went back to the 18th tee again. This time I decided to hit 3 hybrid. I pushed the shot into the greenside bunker. My opponents hit one shot on the green 25 feet away and the other into the same bunker that I was located. I was away and hit a great bunker shot that rolled three feet away under the hole. The opposing player in the bunker hit his shot that rolled ten feet away under the hole. His partner that was 25 feet away putted the ball to within three and a half feet beyond the hole with a left to right break. Well! They both missed their putts and I made my putt to capture first place in the Senior Division. We all at some point are tested whether it is golf or just life itself. We need to believe in ourselves, focus on what we can do and just let it happen. Remember, "It ain't over til it's over!"

#### **YOUR PATH TO PAR** RICHARD ROBINSON, INSTRUCTOR THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL

Changes in agronomy, maintenance and construction equipment, shafts, club head design, grip materials, even clothing have improved playing performance and changed course design. Yet, the most dramatic and consistent evolutionary factor is golf ball technology.

The modern golf ball is a wonder of aeronautical and chemical engineering.


Once a stone struck with a stick, the modern golf ball is a virtually indestructible sphere, with complex flight characteristics. There are beeping balls for blind golfers and illuminated balls for "night" golfers.

The most obvious effect of ball evolution can be seen at the first hole of the Old Course St. Andrews. At 370 yards this hole was a par 5 for nearly 400 years when the feathery ball, a leather sack stuffed with feathers traveled at best 175 yards. In the mid 1800's the gutta-percha emerged, followed by the Haskell rubber core in 1898, and driving distance passed the 200 yard mark. Today's flying marvels soar twice as far "feathered" with aerodynamic dimple patterns and multilayer synthetic substances.

Golf is an exercise in decision making. Picking the right ball for you is important. If you drive a car and a golf ball 130 mph then a Ferrari and a \$50 a dozen tour ball will suit you nicely. If you cruise the highway and golf course at slower speeds, know you are paying for potential performance you may never actually use.

Increased distance has been the dominant effect of ball evolution. However, it should not be the focus of your personal choice of ball type. Begin you ball evaluation on and near the green. The way the ball feels when putting, chipping, and making short pitches from 25 yards or less, is the best determinant of ball performance. Some balls come off the clubface quickly and roll, others spin and check up on landing, some feel soft, some feel hard. Resist expecting what a ball should do, rather focus on what really works for you. If your typical approach shot lands short and rolls a foot from the hole, it is just as effective as landing past the hole and drawing back, or a shot that just drops and stops. Match the ball characteristics to your style and playing conditions. Try different types of balls and see what is most consistent for you. Usually the ball that works around the green will work best for you off the tee as well.

Ball choice is about feel and confidence and consistent performance. Anxiety over losing an expensive ball, making a forceful swing to smash a "distance" ball, fearing a soft ball will not carry a hazard or get to the hole on a long putt, worrying a hard ball when chipped or putted will race past the hole or fly over the green on pitches, are typical counter-productive feelings associated with ball design. Eliminate doubt, test different balls, and trust your results. The ball that feels right to you will help you play best, no matter the specifications, cost, or marketing claims.
