Captain's Table



ACTION = RESPONSE

A common problem I see with many people in the short game is a misconception of how the ball gets airborne. This is especially true with a 60 degree wedge. Most of the time the reason they choose that club is because they want to hit the ball high. So they try to hit it up, but it stays low and runs off the back of the green. It's all about actions and responses to those actions.


Try picturing it this way. If you take a ball and throw it straight down on the sidewalk, what would the response be? It would bounce straight up. If you throw a ball in a side-arm manner, like skipping a stone, the response would be a low angled trajectory. It's the downward action and the angle of that action that gives you the upward response and trajectory of that response. So, if you want to hit a high shot, your action must be a sharp, downward angle strike on the ball. If you want to hit a lower shot, it is still a downward strike on the ball, but from a shallow angle. The problem is that when you try to hit it up, you have an upward strike on the ball so the response is down.

To get used to a downward strike on the ball, there are a couple drills you can do. One drill is to set up normally, then take you back foot and move it behind you and set it only on your toes. This will make you feel like your chest is out in front of the ball a bit. Make swings being sure to use a good hip turn and feel like you are almost chopping down on the ball. If you don't turn your hips you will chop down on it. By turning your hips you will have the club swinging through while getting the proper feel of striking down. The other drill is to place the ball well past your back foot and strike straight down on top of the back of the ball without a follow through, pinching it forward. Again, make sure you turn your hips first. As you get used to pinching the ball, begin to move it forward in your stance while continuing to try and pinch it forward. You will see that you don't have to lift it in the air.






PLEASANT HUGHES GOES WIRE TO WIRE TO WIN 2014 MIDDLE ATLANTIC PGA PROFESSIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Pleasant Hughes, PGA Assistant Professional at Chevy Chase Club in Chevy Chase, Maryland, won the 89th Middle Atlantic PGA Professional Championship presented by Club Car, Mercedes and OMEGA held at The Country Club of Virginia. Hughes finished his third and final round with a 1-under par 71 to take his 54-hole total to 11-under par and win by four shots over Rick Schuller, PGA Head Professional at Swaders Sports Park in Chester, Virginia. For his win, Hughes receives a check for \$9,000 and his name engraved on the MAPGA's Tom Utterbeck trophy.

Hughes, who led by three strokes after round one, and four strokes after round two, said that "it is a big relief to hold on and win, especially with the added pressure heading into the final round after having led day one and day two." He started his first round of the tournament on the Tuckahoe Creek course with a 7-under par 65 which was the low round of that day and gave him a three stroke lead. In round two, on the famous James River Course, Hughes shot 3-under par to get to 10-under and extend his led to four strokes. Much like his first two rounds, Hughes' final round started off nicely and credits a "steady start to calming his nerves." He made birdie on holes seven and nine which got him to 2-under par as he made the turn. After making bogey on holes 12 and 17, Hughes finished his round with a birdie on the par 5, 18th hole to finish his final round with a 1-under par 71.

YOU KNOW THE DRILL

BREEDS CONFIDENCE

I am sure you have heard the line; "success breeds confidence" many times. But did you know that a self perceived weakness can affect other areas of your game? If you are struggling with short putts, it will creep into your chipping and pitching game making you try to help the ball to get closer to the hole resulting in poor shots. It leads to a domino effect in your entire game. If your chipping is weak, you tend to put more stress on your iron play by hitting more greens. Beating this syndrome is easy if you get honest with yourself and understand which shot makes you uncomfortable. If it is short putts, find a drill suited to make you a more confident putter. I normally find if I am confident on putts 6 feet and in, the rest of my game benefits greatly. What you will find is that confidence in one area of the game will lead to confidence in the other areas of your game allowing you to swing more freely and enjoy your day! Now you know the drill!

All athletes need to be sure their vitamin/nutrient intake is adequate. In a recent issue of healthbeat from Harvard Medical School, I found some data worth passing on. They feel the best source of vitamins is not your medicine cabinet, but your dinner plate. They state that by focusing on the big picture- eating a balanced diet that includes a variety of fruits, vegetables, whole grains, seafood, lean meats etc.- it is easy to get all the nutrients you need. There are certain guidelines to follow, such as choosing healthy fats (monounsaturated and polyunsaturated) and avoiding saturated and trans fats. Remembering a good fiber intake, which varies slightly with age and sex (men over 50-30 grams daily, women over 50-21 grams). Balance your energy intake and output to maintain a healthy weight and set goals, such as eating one extra fruit or vegetable a day, and when you are used to that, increase it slightly until you reach a recommended intake of both. Once you get yourself into a good pattern and habit it becomes easy to maintain.

Also, another tip is to get creative by adding grated vegetables to pasta sauce, meat loaf, chili, etc. Use dips for vegetables, such as hummus, or smear peanut butter on bananas or apples. Try mashed avocado as a sandwich spread topped with onions or tomatoes. You could also add spinach leaves and a slice of cheese. I personally like to get vegetables in the morning as a stuffing for an egg white omelet. Today, for example, I sautéed some chopped zucchini, mushrooms, cauliflower and plum tomatoes in extra virgin olive oil and used that to fill my omelet, topped with shredded parmesan cheese. It was outstanding, but the choice of vegetables becomes an individual preference. Once you find the ones you like, it all becomes easy, especially if you make it a routine, as noted above. There are plenty of reference sources to help you. It mostly is a matter of learning to include the good and leave out the bad- and then leave the vitamins in the medicine cabinet.

Sport Psychologists, Game Coaches and elite athletes across the continuum of sports appreciate and profess the importance and necessity for regimented physical conditioning. Proper strength training, however, extends far beyond a powerful physique and flexible core. A sound psyche is as critical to golf success as a strong body and solid fundamentals, and researchers have identified four cornerstones of mental fitness.

RESILIENCE: Gaining the mental toughness to perform under pressure, and being comfortable in the heat of a

competitive spotlight.

FLEXIBILITY: Increasing the capacity to think creatively, adapt and manage varying course demands and conditions.

BALANCE: Remaining even keeled throughout the rigors of a competition.

STAMINA: Learning to minimize the emotional rollercoaster within a round of golf to maximize the limited reserve of

mental energy.

To become more resilient, compete with and against highly skilled golfers and embrace the experience as an opportunity for growth. For enhanced mental flexibility research suggests stepping off the beaten path. Discover new ways to approach routine shots. Reconsider the standard. Balance on the golf course comes from staying in the present. Tackle the task at hand; leave the bogeys behind and expect to master the next stroke. Once the club makes contact with the ball, stick to the game plan. A first tee shank or a hole in one lead to the same place: The second hole. Conserve precious energy, and play on. Modern golfers have demonstrated the need for and benefits of well-rounded fitness habits, so by all means, hit the weight room, do those crunches, but remember, a muscular mind lifts the spirit.

TOOLS OF THE TRADE "DIVOTS ARE SOLE FOOD"

Did you know your divots can tell you exactly what is going on in your golf swing? Much like an episode of CSI, your divot is leaving you some evidence of what may be going on in your golf swing. Next time you are on the range check out your divot and see what it is telling you about your swing. There are many different things to check. Some of the things to look for are divots that are too deep or too shallow, short divots, irregular shaped divots or no divot at all. Did you know a divot facing left of your intended target line can mean you are coming over the top? Just as divots pointing right of your intended target line mean you are coming too far from the inside. A deep divot can mean that your impact angle may be too steep. Irregular shaped divots can let you know if your club face is open or closed at and through impact. If you have no divot at all or your divot starts behind the golf ball, more than likely your weight is on the back foot during impact. However your divot appears please take the time to replace it or fill it level to the ground with sand. There is nothing worse than striping one down the middle and find the ball has come to rest in the bottom of a big ole divot. So the next time you hit a wayward shot, when you are replacing your sod or filling the divot with sand mix check the shape and depth of the impression. It could just help you get back on plane and lead to better rounds!

DERRICK'S PRODUCT SHOWCASE

I don't know about the rest of you (well, actually I do), but as a golfer I'm always looking for an edge from the tee to the green. What if you could gain an advantage by simply choosing the right pair of sunglasses? Usually its color, style, maybe the weight and most likely whether my wife thinks they look good. Last on my list was whether the lens was appropriate for golf.

I had a chance to compare Oakley's G30 Iridium lens up against a non-golf-specific Oakley lens. 





YOUR PATH TO PAR

RICHARD ROBINSON - INSTRUCTOR: THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL

The nature of golf is harmony. It is true for technique, strategy, and the sheer enjoyment of the surroundings that are the golf course. Eastern shore courses offer the combination of natural scenic beauty enhanced by artful designs including Nicklaus, Hills, Dye, Jacobson, and Furyk. One foundational attribute of nature, design, construction, and skillful play is purpose. From a single blade of grass or grain of sand the mosaic is purposeful. Appreciating the components will improve your performance and playing experience. Harmonizing the purpose of your shot making with the realities of nature is an intriguing but frequently overlooked fundamental.

Consider these three aspects of the game: air, ground, recovery. The "air game" is about flight and carry. Factors such as wind, humidity, rain, temperature, barometric pressure, and ball design are important influences. The "ground game" is about contact and roll. Slope, surface density, grass characteristics are key elements. The "recovery game" is about expectations. Are there unique design or environmental conditions that require special types of shots?

To harmonize the air game accept reality. No one seems to mind playing 7 irons carrying 30 yards more than normal at Jackson

Hole Wyoming. Yet, to play a 5 iron 130 yards on a cold windy fall day at sea level is often viewed as defeat. The key is to maintain tempo, balance and play the club that suit the day and your way." Judy Robinson winner of multiple Delaware Amateur Championships, and a long hitter playing in the days of steel and persimmon, never hit a driver. "I could keep the three wood in play and reach par 5's in two. That was my purpose off the tee."

To harmonize the ground game, understand the surface. Play a low running pitch from 50 yards on the bent grass at the Bay Club West or Lighthouse Sound is often the best play. Yet, the same shot on Bay Club East zoysia grass will likely come up short. The fast hard sand surface and low cut fescue common to British Links and Bandon Dunes can make putting to elevated greens from as far as 100 yards a better choice

To harmonize the recovery game, consider the clubs you need and will use. Dave Stockton won the PGA at Congressional Country Club in 1976. When he returned to the same course nearly thirty years later for the Senior Open, he carried a special high bounce, heavy headed 7 iron, sort of a low loft sand wedge. I asked why? He said, "I won't use a seven iron on this course anyway, and this club helps me escape from
