RANDY EDSALL

HEAD COACH | MARYLAND FOOTBALL





andy Edsall enters his fifth season as head football coach at the University of Maryland, leading a program that has earned back-to-back bowl berths and continues to make great strides both on and off the field.

Edsall was named the 34th coach in Maryland football history in January 2011. Since taking over, Edsall and his staff have placed a strong emphasis on recruiting the local Maryland/Washington, D.C. market, which is heavily recruited by schools across the nation and is considered a football hotbed. The result of this focus was the signing of 81 athletes, 42 from the area, since 2012. Edsall and his staff have recruited classes ranked in the top 35 nationally by Rivals.com in two of the last four years, including the 31st overall in 2013.

On the field, Edsall led Maryland into a new era in 2014, with its first season in the Big Ten. Maryland finished the regular season with an impressive 5-1 record away from College Park, leading the Big Ten in road wins. The five road victories were the most for a Terrapin team since 1984. Maryland posted it's first-ever road victory at Penn State and it's first-ever win against Michigan to punctuate its first season in the conference, which concluded with an appearance in the Foster Farms Bowl. Maryland finished the season 7-6 securing its first back-to-back winning seasons since 2002-03.

The Maryland program continued its ascent in 2013 totaling seven victories and earning its first bowl appearance since 2010 (2013 Military Bowl).

Prior to coming to College Park, Edsall, a native of nearby Glen Rock, Pa, spent 12 seasons coaching the University of Connecticut Huskies where he took the program from FCS (formerly I-AA) to five bowl games, including a BCS bowl. The 2010 Big East Coach of the Year led the Huskies to a 33-19 record over his last four seasons there, including two bowl victories with his leadership resulting in UConn being the first program ever to go from FBS newcomer to BCS bowl participant in just seven seasons.

Edsall departed UConn as the school's all-time leader in career wins (74) and most games coached (144). He was a two-time recipient of the prestigious Bowl Championship Division Head Coach of the Year in New England by the Gridiron Club of Greater Boston (2007, 2010). Off the field, Edsall's teams were strong in the classroom as well. In 2007, 2008 and 2009, UConn was recognized by the American Football Coaches Association for its high graduation rate. In 2003, UConn was the only public Division I-A school to graduate at least 90 percent of its football players and in 2005, it was one of only eight schools to both graduate 70 percent and win a bowl game. Edsall was a three-year letter winner in football, basketball and baseball at Susquehannock High School (Pa.) and was an all-state selection in all three sports as a senior, which led to induction into the York Area Sports Hall of Fame.

Coach Edsall grew up golfing at Bon Air Country Club in Pennsylvania. Randy gets out and plays whenever he can. He is a good golfer and uses his time on the links to unwind. The all star athlete has played some amazing courses including: Augusta National-Wingfoot-Burning Tree-Oakmont-Congressional...just to name a few.



MARK TURGEON

HEAD COACH | MARYLAND BASKETBALL

ark Turgeon is entering his fifth season at the helm of the University of Maryland men's basketball team. Maryland posted 28 wins last season, an eleven-game improvement from its 17 victories during the 2013-14 season.

The Terps finished their inaugural season in the Big Ten with a perfect 9-0 home record, which included victories against then-No. 5 Wisconsin, Michigan State and Indiana. Overall, Maryland concluded with an 18-1 home mark at XFINITY Center.

Maryland's 14-1 record to start the 2014-2015 season marked its best start in 18 years (1996-97). Turgeon has posted 28 wins this season – the fourth time he has posted at least 25 wins in his career.

Turgeon's winning percentage of .600 (42-28) was the best mark by a Maryland coach in his first two seasons, ahead of Bud Millikan (.592) and Gary Williams (.574). After bringing in a top-15 recruiting class in 2012, he led the Terrapins to a 25-13 record (most wins in six seasons) and appearances in the ACC Tournament semifinals and the NIT semifinals in 2012-13.

Turgeon has led his teams to a winning season in 14 of his 17 seasons, including a current streak of 13 consecutive winning seasons. Turgeon, who came to College Park after directing Texas A&M to four consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament, led Maryland to a 17-15 record in 2011-12. At A&M, he posted a 97-40 record in four seasons and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in both 2010 and 2011. He is the only coach in Big 12 history with at least 24 victories in each of his four seasons.

Turgeon is 337-209 through 17 seasons overall as a head coach. In seven years at Wichita State, he built the Shockers into a power in the Missouri Valley Conference, earning the league title and an NCAA Sweet Sixteen appearance in 2006. In that NCAA Tournament, Wichita State beat Seton Hall and Tennessee before losing to eventual Final Four participant George Mason.

Turgeon amassed a 128-89 record at Wichita State (2000-07), posting the third-most wins in school history. The Shockers advanced to three straight NITs from 2003 to 2005 in addition to the 2006 NCAAs, the first time WSU had four straight postseason appearances in 40 years. A point guard at Kansas from 1984-87, Turgeon was the first player in Jayhawks history to play in four straight NCAA Tournaments. KU went 108-33 under Brown in that stretch. Turgeon served as team captain in his junior and senior seasons, leading the Jayhawks to the 1986 NCAA Final Four.

A native of Topeka, Kan., Turgeon led Hayden High School to back-to-back Class 4A state titles in 1982 and 1983, earning all-tournament honors each year. A first team all-state pick as a senior, Hayden went 47-3 in his high-school career.



MIDDLE ATLANTIC **PGA**PROFESSIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Professional Championship presented by Club Car, Mercedes Benz, and Omega will be held at Congressional Country Club in Bethesda, Maryland on Monday, August 17th – Wednesday, August 19th. The MAPGA Professional Championship is the premier event of the Middle Atlantic PGA and is a 54-hole stroke play competition. Approximately 180 PGA Professionals from Maryland, Virginia, and Washington D.C. will be competing for a purse of \$72,000 and on the Middle Altantic PGA's Tom plus exempt former national champions DeFrancesco and David Hutsell will advance to the 2016 PGA Professional National Championship at Turning Stone Resort in Verona, New York.

Headlining the field at the championship will be defending champion Pleasant Hughes, PGA of Chevy Chase Club in Chevy Chase, Maryland, 2014 Middle Atlantic PGA Player of the Year Rick Schuller, PGA of Swaders Sports Park in Chester, Virginia, and current Middle Atlantic PGA Player of the Year Points Leader Billy Hoffman, PGA of Westwood Country Club. Hoffman has five top five finishes this year, including winning the MAPGA Match Play Championship in July at River Bend Club in Great Falls, Virginia.

ROUND 1 RECAP

On the biggest stage, the past two Middle Atlantic PGA Player of the Year winners showed up as Rick Schuller and Faber Jamerson each shot a four-under par 68 and are tied for the lead after the first round of the Middle Atlantic PGA Professional Championship. The 2014 MAPGA Player of the Year, Schuller of Swaders Sports Park in Chesterfield, Virginia, posted a bogey free round with four birdies on the Blue Course (Par 72) at Congressional Country Club. Head PGA Professional at Falling River Country Club in Appomattox, Virginia and 2013 Player of the Year, Faber Jamerson finished his round on the Blue Course with five birdies, including making birdie on the final three holes.

Schuller and Jamerson lead the field of 183 MAPGA Professionals taking part in the biggest event in the Section each year, with 12 low finishers plus exempt former champions Wayne DeFrancesco and David Hutsell advancing to the PGA Professional National Championship. One shot behind behind Schuller and Jamerson are Frank O'Connell, PGA Assistant Professional at Springfield Golf & Country Club in Springfield, Virginia and Todd Larson, PGA Assistant Professional at Farmington Country Club in Charlottesville, Virginia. Both O'Connell and Larson carded a two-under par 69 on the Gold Course (Par 71). Defending champion Pleasant Hughes, PGA from Chevy Chase Club in Chevy Chase, Maryland, shot a two-over par 74 and is currently tied for 19th.

ROUND 2 RECAP

As a winner of the 2012 Middle Atlantic PGA Professional Championship, Faber Jamerson knows exactly what it takes to win the Section's premier event. After playing his first round on the par-72 Blue Course, Jamerson, Head PGA Professional at Falling River Country Club in Appomattox, Virginia, shot a tidy two-under par 69 on the Gold Course at Congressional Country Club and now sits at six-under par for the event. Jamerson posted a bogey free round with two birdies, one on the front nine and one on the back nine. He takes a one shot lead heading into the final round over good friend Rick Schuller. The cut fell at 13-over 156 for two rounds, with 76 Professionals making it to the final round.

Schuller, PGA Director of Instruction at Swaders Sports Park in Chester, Virginia, shot a second round score of one-under par 70 to get to five-under par for the tournament. Unlike Jamerson's round, Schuller's second round was quite eventful as he carded three bogeys on the front nine and five birdies and one bogey on the back nine. Former PGA Professional National Championship winner David Hutsell, PGA sits in third place after he shot a second round score of two-under par 69 on the Gold Course. Defending champion Pleasant Hughes, PGA from Chevy Chase Club in Chevy Chase, Maryland, recorded a second round score of four-over par 75 and is tied for 24th place at six-over par.

Middle Atlantic PGA Professional Championship presented by Club Car, Mercedes and OMEGA held at Congressional Country Club. Hutsell finished his third and final round with a one-over par 73 to take his 54-hole total to one-under par and win by one stroke over Rick Schuller, PGA Head Professional at Swaders Sports Park in Chester, Virginia and Frank O'Connell, PGA Assistant Professional at Springfield Golf & Country Club in Springfield, Virginia. For his win, Hutsell receives a check for \$10,000 and his name engraved on the MAPGA's Tom Utterbeck trophy.

Heading into the final round trailing leader Faber Jamerson by four shots, Hutsell wasn't sure of his chances of winning the title, but as he said, "you never know with golf". Hutsell started his first round of the tournament on the famous Blue Course with an even par 72 to put him tied for ninth place. In round two, Hutsell shot a two-under par 71 on the Gold Course to put him in third place heading into the final round. Hutsell was very consistent on his first nine holes of his final round as he carded a four for every hole and made the turn tied for

first place with O'Connell at two-under par. After making a double bogey on the par-3 13th and bogey on the par-4 14th hole, Hutsell was able to get a shot back and went into the 18th hole one shot back of then leader O'Connell who was oneunder par. O'Connell hit his approach shot into the hazard next to the green and made bogey which was exactly what Hutsell needed to make a move. With 206 yards to the flag. Hutsell hit the shot of the tournament as his four-iron came to rest three feet from the cup on the par-4 18th. Of course he still needed to make that putt to win, and he did, "sliding it in the door" for the title.

O'Connell was steady throughout the day and had a three shot lead with two holes to play. Unfortunately it wasn't meant to be for O'Connell as he made bogey on the par-4 17th and par-4 18th to finish the event at even par. Rick Schuller, who entered the final round at five-under par, posted a final round score of five-over par 77 and finished tied for second place with O'Connell.

Along with Hutsell, O'Connell and Schuller, 11 other MAPGA Professionals will compete next year in the 2016 PGA Professional National Championship at







Pride. What is the definition of pride and how does pride affect performance? The Psychology Dictionary describes pride as, "a conscious emotion characterized by the attainment of a goal and that accomplishment resulting in recognition and approval from others in the group." In other words, feeling good about being recognized for (doing good) by likeminded individuals. To determine how pride influences action, researchers set up a series of experiments where random people were told they would be assessing a new, important and difficult cognitive task. After completing the first round of tests, some subjects were privately informed that they scored exceedingly well; they were patted on the back, and received positive body language from the visibly impressed investigators. Another group of test-takers finished round one without receiving any feedback. On the second round of tests, subjects were told they could stop the process whenever they decided that they had done enough. As expected, the people who received acclaim resulting in a sense of pride in their

work persevered longer than those who completed round one without feedback. The examiners concluded that feeling proud of being able to complete a complex assignment motivated subjects to suppress the desire to guit working on a subsequent and equally difficult task.

This phenomenon readily applies to sport and the competitive arena as coaches and athletes seek to strengthen the capacity to delay gratification and allow for skill development--to continue working hard in the face of adversity knowing there is gold at the end of the rainbow. Resisting temptation takes willpower, and willpower can fail. Sport Psychologists contend that pride may serve as a booster to make athletes more resilient, and keep us swinging toward our goals.

YOU KNOW THE DRIL MAKE MORE PUTTS. MATCH YOUR PACE.

One of the best tips I had from a buddy some decades ago still rings true. If you are struggling with putting distance causing three putts, match your putter swing with the pace you imagine the ball rolling. I really liked this notion because it helped me to visualize the ball rolling before I attempted my putt. Imagining the ball rolling and the line of the putt is a trait shared by the world's best putters. Simply visualizing the ball roll on its intended line with the proper speed is as good as getting the chance to hit the putt twice. The next time you are reading the putt, imagine the speed you see the ball rolling into the hole. When you take your practice swing, match the speed of the ball that you imagined with the speed of your putting stroke. This should result in making more putts and even if you miss it should only result in ε tap in two putt. Now you know the drill!




TOOLS OF THE TRADE

HIT THE GAS!

The swing starts from the ground up. If this is a phrase that you have heard but never really understood, this is the article for you! It happens time and time again. Sometimes we start taking the club back too fast with our arms causing our weight to shift outside our back foot. It also allows the back knee and/or hip to shift outside our feet and sway. This action causes the club to get "stuck" and normally makes us cast or start the downswing with our upper body or arms resulting in an out to in club path and a big old slice. Here is a way to get that swing to be built from the ground up and you can practice it right at home. The feeling we are trying to achieve is as if we are pressing our foot on the gas pedal. Once the weight shifts to your back foot, keep your knee and hip inside you feet as your body turns the club to the top and the pressure in your trail foot should stay on the inside resulting in a feeling like you are pressing down on the accelerator. This simple action will create resistance against the ground and help the swing build much more power. If you are having troubles feeling this just take off your shoes and watch how your back foot reacts when you take the club back. Slow motion rehearsal swings really help accomplish this action. If your weight shifts outside your back foot, check the position of your back knee and/or hip. If either of them has shifted outside the parameters of your stance, there is your culprit. The feet and legs are immensely important in the swing and using these tools properly will make you more powerful and much more accurate because the legs drive the ball. So if you would like a better long term golf swing, "HIT THE GAS!"






$Wedging\ it\$ By Rob McDonald

In previous articles I've written about striking down on the ball to get it to go up in the air. Sometimes when playing a short game shot, people tend to try and lift the ball or get under it to get it up in the air. This only promotes inconsistency in contact and results. Your short game clubs are called wedges for a reason. They are wedge shaped (see photo 1). The key to playing these shots is to drive the wedge point down into the base of the ball as you would drive a door stop into the base of the door. You wouldn't try to lift the door. When you drive the wedge point down, notice the handle is leaning forward and driving downward (photo 2). This action strikes the back of the ball and sends it upward. To help you achieve this downward strike, set up with your weight on your left side and rather than feel like you are striking the ball sitting at 6 o'clock on the swing clock, drive your hands and handle down to 5 o'clock. This should help you to "wedge it" up into the air.

YOUR PATH TO PAR

RICHARD ROBINSON, INSTRUCTOR THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL

"NAE WIND, NAE RAIN, NAE GOLF." This old Scottish saying describes the common occurrence and philosophical attitude of links golf. Nature's unpredictability challenges the golfer's quest for certainty. The battle for control, weather challenging the physical and mental abilities of the golfer is most evident when playing the cooler months of the year. To win this battle understand and apply "weather yardage" to your decision making. Wind, moisture, temperature are the challenge elements evident in the fall of the year. Many players adapt to these challenges with swing modifications and extra physical effort to match their typical performance in milder conditions. For example, if a player typically drives 250 yards and approaches from 150 yards with a 7 iron in 75 degree calm conditions. Playing in a 10 mph head wind and 55 degrees temperatures and the same player should expect a driving distance of 234 yards and a 7 iron 134. You can expect wind speed mph to approximately equate to changes in carry distance and deflection of the shot, thus a 10 mph head wind would add 10 yards to the shot distance. Under such conditions a 150 yard shot should be played as if it is 160 yards. Clues to wind speed include movement of the flag, trees, leaves, and water surface.

- •If the flag is waving slightly or leaves begin to rustle light breeze 4-7 mph. Adjust +/-5 yards
- If the bottom of the flag is extended from the flag stick or leaves in constant motion gentle breeze 8-12 mph adjust +/- 12 yards
- If the Flag extends straight out from the flag stick and flaps quickly or small trees sway, water whitecaps fresh breeze 20 mph winds. Adjust +/- 20 yards. Wind is a factor in all seasons, but do not neglect temperature as a co-conspirator undermining your performance in the fall and winter. The temperature impact is approximately 3 yards lost for every 10 degrees cooler temperatures. A 150 yard shot at 75 degrees becomes a 156 yard shot at 55 degrees. If you are a data junkie the variables of ball aerodynamics and swing nuances can be mind boggling. However, merely understanding common sense adaptations to weather an establishing reliable reference points for club selection will improve your play and reduce frustration. The key is to recalibrate your distance expectations to the reality of the weather. You can do this by redefining your distances knowing a 7 iron range for a given day may be 16 yards less than "normal". Or, you can add the "weather yardage" and play to the "real distance". If the actual distance is 150; add 10 yard wind effect and 6 yard temperature effect for a "weather yardage" of 166. Play the shot as if it is 166 yards. It does not matter how you make the adjustment. It does matter that you do make an adjustment to "weather yardage" in club selection rather than swing change. Trying to overpower weather creates tension, loss of balance, and expecting the ball to fly like it does in the summer is frustrating. With experience you can refine your own personal "weather yardage". Find it. Trust It. Adapt to the reality of "weather yardage" and enjoy a fall in score.



VITAMIN D!

In golf there are, among others, two important requisites-you need strong bones to be competitive and you have to have a tolerance to sun exposure. Which brings us to my topic for this article- Vitamin D. As you all know, this vitamin is critical for strong bone development; its main source for many years was exposure to the sun. Then the cry came out about the risks of sun exposure, so for years everyone slathered on sun screen. Now, however, discoveries about the importance of Vit D have made it a critical supplement for more than bones. It turns out many chronic diseases have been linked to poor intake of Vit D, including cancers and heart problems, to name just two. If you can't get it from the sun, then you need to take a supplement. The current recommendations vary, but most are in the 5000 i.u. daily range. But it is now apparent that just taking D alone (Vit D3 is the best) is not enough. The reason is that Vit D alone will indiscriminately cause calcium deposition in spots other than bones (where you want it) and into blood vessels (where you don't want it). What has been discovered is that taking Vit D along with vitamin K2 subverts this process and directs the calcium deposition to healthy locations. I would suggest you look up these facts online for your own edification and education. Many medical authorities now feel that a couple hours of sun exposure per day is less of a risk than the problems associated with Vit D lack. While chronic sun exposure may not overall be the best thing, you can probably relax on it for a couple of hours a day – or, the length of time for that round of golf.



Your core consists of your mid section, which involves all of your muscles in that area including front, back and sides. Your core includes your erector spinae, obliques, transverse abdominis and lower lats.

All of these muscles are stabilizers for the entire body. We do core exercises to strengthen these muscles. If you have a weak core, it could result in lower back pain and an expanding waistline. Start with these core exercises. Beginners should start with 2 sets of 10-12 and more advanced trainees should start with 3 sets of 12-15.

- Russian twist w medicine ball or kettle bell
- Lying leg raises on bench or lying flat on the floor
- Straight leg sit ups with the medicine ball
- Planks and side planks.... hold for 20 seconds, then 30 seconds, eventually building to one minute

Maryland High School Golf Seasons On The Shore

10.6

High school golf in the state of Maryland takes place in the fall for both public schools as well as private institutions. Typically the two do not regularly compete against one another except for an occasional scrimmage or an invite to a regular season match in which the visitor's score would not affect the conference standings. In the public sector, there are 18 schools on the Eastern Shore of Maryland that comprise the Bayside Conference and have been designated by the state as District 8. Those eighteen schools are subdivided into two smaller and more manageable divisions, the Bayside North and the Bayside South. Each school is permitted to compete in 12 regular season matches, a conference championship, the District Tournament, and the Maryland State Championship for those who qualify. At each regular season match there are 9-10 teams competing at the same time in a stroke play format, with 5 players representing each team. The top 4 scores combined account for the team score. The overall season winner of the south will face the winner of the north for the Bayside Championship, and at the District 8 match players are hoping to qualify for the exciting Maryland State Championship at the end of October.

Participating in the Eastern Shore Independent Athletic Conference (ESIAC) are three private school teams on the shore: Worcester Preparatory School (Berlin), The Salisbury School (Salisbury), and Salisbury Christian School (Salisbury). At each regular season match there are 2-3 teams competing at the same time in a stroke play format, with 6 players representing each team. The top 4 scores combined account for the team score.





Creating a contemporary style, all of the drawers are push to open and the doors have finger pulls. Lighting also plays a big role in this design. There is under-lighting on a motion sensor, as well as lighting that faces down onto the countertop, creating a soft, pretty glow.





Instead of California Closets coming in at the end to design, Susan got involved at the beginning of the project prior to all of the interior construction and provided helpful recommendations through to the end, meeting with contractors and electricians, and even selecting paint colors and master bedroom furniture for her client. 




