



Arnold Daniel Palmer (September 10, 1929 – September 25, 2016) was an American professional golfer who is generally regarded as one of the greatest players in the sport's history. Dating back to 1955, he won numerous events on both the PGA Tour and the circuit now known as PGA Tour Champions. Nicknamed The King, he was one of golf's most popular stars and its most important trailblazer, the first superstar of the sport's television age, which began in the 1950s. Palmer's social impact on behalf of golf was perhaps unrivaled among fellow professionals; his humble background and plainspoken popularity helped change the perception of golf as an elite, upper-class pastime to a more populist sport accessible to middle and working classes. Palmer was part of "The Big Three" in golf during the 1960s, along with Jack Nicklaus and Gary Player, who are widely credited with popularizing and commercializing the sport around the world. In a career that spanned more than six decades, he won 62 PGA Tour titles from 1955 to 1973, placing him at that time behind only Sam Snead and Ben Hogan, and still fifth on the Tour's all-time victory list. He collected seven major titles in a six-plus-year domination, from the 1958 Masters to the 1964 Masters. He also won the PGA Tour Lifetime Achievement Award in 1998, and in 1974 was one of the 13 original inductees into the World Golf Hall of Fame. 90% sold



ORIVE CHIP & PUTT CHAMPIONSHIP @OAKMONT CC, PA written by garrett lydic ON TO AUGUSTA!

On September 11th, we (Mom, Dad, Sarah, Hannah, Grammy and Grandpa) made the hour long drive from my parent's house in Somerset, PA to Oakmont CC for the Regional Drive, Chip, Putt Championships. Grammy insisted that each of us paint at least one toenail Masters green. We did, even my father and I grudgingly had a toenail painted. We got there in time to scope things out, take tour of the clubhouse (amazing history), and to

a guided

warm up. Sarah and Dad went to the chipping area to practice when the guided tour was over. Yes the greens are as fast as they say. The clubhouse guide said that the members want all greens including those in the practice areas to all run the same speed – super fast! We then moved to the putting practice green and worked on the 6', 15' and 30' lengths until the driving range opened up for her group. Competitors were invited to the driving range 15 minutes before their scheduled competitions. The driving area was sloped from right to left with shots too far left rolling out of bounds. Sarah was in her zone although the girl next to her was a powerhouse, hitting the balls at least 40 yards farther. Still, Sarah was consistently hitting hers straight at about 160 -170 yards.

One parent/coach could be with the competitors during competition. Girls and coaches were called to a meeting just next to the driving completion area and were put in alphabetical order from 1 through 10. Sarah was #4.

They stood on their numbers at the driving area with parents and coaches off to the side with no contact. She managed to hit all three of her drives in bounds and earning 30 total points. The number 5 girl (the one next to her during warmups) hit her first shot so far the two spotters had to sprint from Sarah's last drive to get her ball. She was a much bigger girl with amazing swing speed.



After each competitor finished her 3 drives, officials asked the girls to stand on the same number in the chipping area. Sarah was allowed to have Dad with her during the chipping competition. While waiting for her turn, Sarah and Dad discussed the best landing spot for her three chips. Sarah nailed her first chip to within one foot and in her own words, "I just wanted to reproduce the same swing for the next two tries." She earned 40 points in the chip – the most by any of the competitors in her division.

At the completion of the chipping competition, the officials said that the girls would have new numbers for the putting competition based on the results thus far. We kept waiting for Sarah's name to be called but it wasn't until they called #10 that Sarah got to go stand on her number. We figured that this meant Sarah was currently in first place but by how much was anyone's guess. She still needed three good putts.

They called girls out one at a time to take the 6-foot, slightly downhill putt. The first three girls drained their putts with the next few rolling theirs well past the hole. Welcome to Oakmont! This may have caused Sarah to ease up which



left hers just over a foot short, earning 15 out of the possible 25 points. Next they called the girls for the 15 foot, slightly downhill and breaking putt. Again Sarah was short and earned 10 points. Not the start we were hoping for but one putt was still remaining. Sarah was a bit on edge at this point so dad flipped out his phone and found a funny picture he had taken of her getting on the bus for the first week of school. She laughed and forgot about everything for a moment. When practicing putting at home Sarah always tries to get a certain number of 60-point tries simulating the pressure of competition. Earning 75 points is the max if you hole each of your three putts. Getting a 60 is also tough but Sarah gets several of these each practice. Sarah is not done until she gets a certain number of 60's. Before her last shot dad told her that we are not leaving Oakmont until she gets a 60. She laughed and then went out to take her final putt – a 30-foot slightly uphill small breaking putt. She lined it up and went through her pre-shot routine and nearly made the putt earning a total of 45 points for her three putts. Fifteen shy of the 60 she wanted but still a pretty good showing.

We were thrilled she finished strong and with no regrets about any of her shots. She did as well as could be expected under the circumstances. As we made our almost quarter-mile walk up to the clubhouse where the scores would be written and announcements made, Daddy told Sarah that no matter what happened, we were all extremely proud of her journey and her accomplishment and that she would learn a lot from this experience win or lose. It seemed like forever till the results were posted and Sarah earned 1st place and a spot at the National Championships at Augusta National the Sunday before the start of the Masters. While daddy and mommy cried Sarah smiled. Her dream came true. **AUGUSTA-HERE WE COME!!!**

The 2016 Stephen Decatur Golf Team had a very successful season earning the titles of Bayside South Champions, Bayside Conference Champions, and District 8 Champions. In addition, Matt Kristick earned Boys Medalist Honors at the Bayside Championship (Glen Riddle) and Emily Malinowski earned Girls Medalist Honors at the District 8 Championship (The Hyatt - River Marsh). Four players, Kristick, Kinsey, Leonard, and Snelsire will compete at the State Tournament (Oct 24 - 26) at the University of Maryland, College Park course as a team as well as individuals, and Malinowski will compete at States as an individual.



LOOKING BACK, WHAT IS THE THING THAT YOU ARE MOST PROUD OF WHEN IT COMES TO YOUR CAREER IN GOLF? am most proud of the growth in our Chapter's membership: from 34, when I first founded our Chapter, to the current 319 members. This has happened through a shared vision. I am proud of our abilities to overcome the difficulties that this vision of an increased membership can cause for a Chapter. It was during my term as membership chair, as we entered the new millennium, that I noted the beginnings of a growth spurt in our county. When I returned to the EWGA Eastern Shore Board in 2004, as Vice President of our Chapter, membership was taking off. I began to get the feeling that our Chapter needed a new vision to carry us on the tide of our growth. When I became President in 2006, I wanted our membership to feel that they were getting a great value and benefit from belonging to EWGA

and especially our Chapter. Therefore, I knew that it was important to create shared visions for our Chapter. After all, research has demonstrated repeatedly that an essential characteristic of good leaders is their ability to mobilize people around a shared vision. feel you will become what your vision is, and our Chapter has become our vision. We have increased our growth, and we have created great teams to work with our increased membership. Second would be founding the ACS Pink Ribbon Classic events, I chaired the full classic events from 1997-2004 along with chairing the Pink Ribbon golf event 1997-2016. Receiving the EWGA Nancy Oliver Founders award this past April 2016 in Williamsburg, VA. What a wonderful tribute to be honored from the organization that I spent the last 20 years volunteering with and was dedicated to the growth & game of golf in our community. My husband Chuck was very instrumental in supporting me and helping me through all of my accomplishments. I feel that the Lord didn't bless us with children but gave us the vision to give back to our wonderful community, so that is what we set forth to do.

WHO WERE THE MOST INFLUENTIAL PERSON/PERSONSTHATPLAYED A PART OF YOUR GOLF CAREER? First would be my husband Chuck who introduced me to the game of golf. Next would be Bob Baldassari who had the vision for us to start the EWGA Eastern Shore Chapter which has brought us to where we are today. Bobby Beckelman who was instrumental in helping me with the first ladies golf clinic in order to form our first chapter and has continued to be one of our biggest ambassadors for EWGA Eastern Shore Chapter.

Jill Starr who in 1996 was my EWGA Sectional Director who was my mentor and took me under her wing and guided me to understand the vision of EWGA on a local and national level.

Harrison Group for my job as golf director which has allowed me to establish a business relationship with the golf course owners and golf professionals in our community. WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO YOU TO BE RECOGNIZED BY YOUR PEERS AND BE INDUCTED INTO THE EASTERN SHORE GOLF HALL OF FAME? I am very honored to be receiving this award and to be recognized for the 20 years of volunteer service I have done in the golf community.

WHAT MAKES THE EASTERN SHORE SUCH A SPECIAL PLACE FOR GOLF?

We are so privileged to live on the eastern shore surrounded by the most amazing landscape; not to mention what a giving & caring community we live in!

WHO WOULD PLAY IN YOUR DREAM FOURSOME? Well what comes to mind right now would be my husband Chuck, one more round of golf with him.

FAVORITE FOOD: My family owned a restaurant growing up, so I have a love for all food. Everyone in my family cooks in the kitchen. When we get done preparing and enjoying one meal & cleaning up we're already busy talking about the next meal. We can't help ourselves. It's in our blood!

FAVORITE TV SHOW: Love so many shows; HGTV, Food network, Golf Channel

FAVORITE MOVIE: Chuck and I enjoyed going to movies. It was our date night, movie & dinner so I have way too many movies to choose from. Our first date was Cape Fear (not my favorite movie). It was good for Chuck since I was so scared he had me in his arms immediately.

HOBBIES: Golfing, Skiing, biking, cooking & decorating. Taking care of my sweet boy Bogey, Dog Park, and beach. He loves to swim and would retrieve all day long if he could.

FAVORITE GOLF COURSE: Don't have one because there are too many that I love.

FAVORITE PRO GOLFER: Phil Mickelson. Isn't he everyone's favorite?

ANYTHING PEOPLE DON'T KNOW ABOUT YOU? I'm a very social person and very involved in the community volunteering so I think everyone knows who I am. I live a very open life.

JUDY REMENTER

Judy grew up in Dover Delaware. She always loved sports and tagged along with her older brother. He always included her in neighborhood ball games and she could usually keep up in the informal baseball, football and basketball games with the older boys. Her first formal athletic competition was winning the Dover Jaycee track sprint championship at the age of 8 years old. Later, as a student at Dover High School she lettered in field hockey, basketball and golf. Judy continued to play basketball and golf at Wesley College. Golf began as a family activity. In fact Judy's best memories were the very first years learning the game. Her dad joined the original 9 hole course Maple Dale Country Club. She remembers attending a junior clinic conducted by Rick McCall Sr. as an introduction to the game. Her dad taught her brother how to play and they played often together, but she was too young and inexperienced to tag along on the course. Judy learned the fundamentals from her dad and brother. Her brother and she spent an entire season playing an imaginary course using wiffle practice balls in their backyard. One of the great things she learned was the wiffle balls flew better launched with a smooth swing than a hard swing. They would "play" the wind to get the ball to fly around the house, punch out low shots under tree limbs, and set the ball on tall grass to loft it over the roof. It was creative and intuitive. Judy caught on guickly and never really got too involved with technique or mechanics. Good grip, good set up, hit it with her hips, swing to the target, these were her keys. When they did go to the course, they would practice putting. She cherished her paddle grip 8808 type flanged blade putter.

The result of this year of basic training was great. Playing on a real course with a real ball was different, but she knew how to hit the ball at a target, and never got caught up in hitting for distance. Her brother said she played "sport smart" playing one shot at a time to a specific target, staying away from trouble and focusing on just getting the ball into the hole with the fewest strokes. Her first round score for 18 holes was a 98. A few years later, she became involved in Maple Dale's Junior Golf Program and would go on to win her first Jr. Club Championship at Maple Dale CC.

During her competitive years Judy never hit a driver. She always teed off with a three wood. It was easier to control and keep in play. She could hit her persimmon Powerbilt 3 wood 250 yards with ease, so distance was not a problem, but it was never a goal. During the 1970's Judy Robinson was one of the top women golfers in Delaware. A fact underscored when, prior to Title IX she became the first young lady to play for the Dover High School Men's golf team and later the Wesley College Men's golf team. She learned golf while a member of Maple Dale Country Club from 1972 through 1974, joined Garrison Lake from 1975 through 1978, and Caroline C.C. from 1979 through 1987. She was undefeated in club championship play for a total of 15 years and held ladies course records at each club. She had also set the course record at Hog Neck Golf Club and at Casa De Campo in the Dominion Republic.

Golf Digest identified Judy as Delaware's Most Improved Amateur four times from 1974 through 1977 and she was included in the top 150 nationally ranked players in 1975.

In 1975 she accomplished the "Eastern Shore Slam" winning the three most prestigious ladies championships at that time: Delaware State Women's Amateur, Women's Peninsula Golf Association Championship and The Ladies Blue Hen Golf Classic all in the same year. The Ladies Blue Hen Golf Classic held at Garrison Lake invited top lady amateurs and at the time was a "downstate" companion championship to the State Amateur traditionally held at a Wilmington area country club.

In 1978 she won her second Delaware State Amateur championship and competed in the United States Women's Amateur.

While Judy did not pursue tournament competition after this decade of excellence, she was involved in golf course operations at Hunter's Oak Golf Club and Queenstown Harbor. Annapolis magazine sought her out for comment on the future of women's golf in 2007.

Judy Robinson's contribution to Eastern Shore Golf was more than mere golfing skill and titles. She brought focus to the potential of ladies golf in Delmarva. She represented equality for women's golf "east of the bay and south of the canal", not as political statement but as a reality of talent and determination. The banner headline of the front sports page of the Wilmington Evening Journal was simply: Judy, Judy, Judy! The point for Delmarva ladies golf had been made, not by taking shots for attention, but making shots worthy of notice. The Delaware Women's Amateur and one of its champions had risen above all else in sport at that moment.

Judy was noticed. She excelled at any sport she played. Rick McCall Sr. encouraged her early development and often said, "Judy was one of the most, naturally talented women golfers I worked with." lpga member Carrie Russell remembered Judy as both a golfer and basketball player. Carrie was Judy's basketball coach at Dover High. Carol Kelly was her Wesley College basketball coach and agreed with Carrie Russell that Judy was one of the best athletes she ever coached. "She was among the best players in every sport she played. Explain the game, give her the equipment, and she would be excellent."

While on a trip to Casa De Campo, Judy and her friends celebrated a day of golf with fine dining experience. When she took her seat, a gentleman next to her at an adjacent table, said; I understand you had a great round today, a score under 70." The gentleman had a picture taken with Judy and autographed her menu. It was a memorable moment. The admiring golf fan was President Richard Nixon.

Judy Robinson brought recognition and honor to women's golf in Delmarva. She has a place in the history of the game that is consistent with recognition as a member of the Eastern Shore Golf Hall of Fame.

Cancer and the challenges of raising children as a single parent effectively ended all but occasional participation in competitive golf. However, Judy kept close to the game working at Hunters Oak and Queenstown Harbor. Her daughters were both honor students and athletes in high school and college. Both Kristin and Kim played volleyball and softball at Salisbury University. Her youngest Kim has the distinction of being a two time Academic All-American in two sports. Today her challenges and joys are in caring for her two granddaughters, Allyson and Aubrey, and her grandson Carson. **BIRTHPLACE & HOMETOWN:** Born in Philadelphia Pa. Moved to Dover Delaware, at age 6. Currently live in Denton, Md.mmFAMILY: Daughters Kristin and Kim were both honor students and played volleyball and softball at Salisbury University. Today, there are many truly great courses, designed by Hall of Fame architects, offering a diversity playing challenges including, links as well as parkland designs. Yet, the essential quality of Eastern Shore golf is a legacy of friendly enthusiasm for the game. More than competition and prestige, the best aspect of Eastern Shore golf is, as it was years ago, the sincere love for the game among those who live and play here.

SHORE UP WITH THE GAME COACH

FINISH STRONG! Coaches and athletes are very familiar with this instructive and motivational phrase. Distance runners and sprinters, body builders and synchronized swimmers, running backs, race car drivers and weekend warriors of all ages aim to close out challenges near peak performance. As we enter the final rounds of 2016, let's lean on the research to see how golfers Finish Strong.

THE PHYSICAL: Now that we're reaching the end of the competitive season, are you tired at the end of a round? Is fatigue leading to a swing breakdown? Nutrition and hydration before, during and after rounds are critical for success down the stretch. Revisit the conditioning plan you set up to begin 2016. Are you sticking to it? Does it need adjusting to improve strength, cardio, nutrition and flexibility? This process of evaluation will provide valuable feedback for the last drives of 2016 and in preparation for the 2017 season.

THE MENTAL: You're in the mix with four holes left. Research says keep doing what your doing - if you joke around or whistle or you're a grinder, stay in the same space and keep the pace. Pressure can cause competitors to change the speed of the game - some slow down and start to play careful, adding waggles and over reading angles. Others speed up to rush away the stress and miss relevant cues. The greats rely on the gains made during practice and allow their skills to pull them through the finish. Finishing strong is a matter of trust.

The experience includes the kindness and gentleness of each and every staff member we encounter; the nicest wooden rocking chairs in the waiting rooms; peaceful meditation rooms and healing gardens; comfortable recliners and loungers with warm blankets; a healthy lunch is even served. And then there's the special touches—the familiarity gained with your caregivers and their attentiveness; space for a loved one to join you during treatments; and the way the place is laid out so that you have your own space, with your own headphones, television and place to plug in your phone and connect to the free Wi-Fi.

These special touches and the thoughtfulness behind them—are the salve to our souls and the foundation for healing during these most tender, raw moments of a cancer journey. The Richard A. Henson Cancer Institute at Peninsula Regional Medical Center offers the most advanced cancer services on the Delmarva Peninsula. Our capabilities have earned us accreditation by the American College of Surgeons, an honor we have earned continuously since 1970. There were more than 1,100 diagnosed cancer patients who received treatment at the Richard A. Henson Cancer Institute in 2015. Of those, nearly 40% reside in Worcester and Sussex County.

Cancer patients are often very sick. Traveling to Salisbury for treatment can be difficult. In fact studies have shown that when individuals must travel more than 25 miles for treatment, patient engagement drops significantly. Cancer patients in Worcester and Sussex Counties often have a commute that is greater than 25 miles.

Time to reflect on what Bulldog, beloved Ocean 98 Morning Show host, has accomplished this year and also to set new goals for next year! We began the year with aspirations of getting Dog from a 20 handicap to a 12, pretty lofty expectations. He also wanted to move up from a "D" flight player to the "C" flight in tournament play. We also wanted to break 80 for the first time. I am pleased to report we have reached a season low 13.9 handicap index, moved up to the C flight and shot his season best 83 multiple times. Unfortunately he shot the 83's when he was my opponent rather than my partner, alleviating me of that green paper I try to keep in my wallet. Now comes the time to re-evaluate and set new goals for the upcoming season. I recently added an indoor teach station to the Nutters Crossing location of The "A" Game Golf Academy. This winter we are going to help Bulldog get down to a single digit handicap and move up to the "B" flight. These are incredibly lofty goals and it will take plenty of diligence, but I know how hard Dog will work to achieve his goals. Thank you for following our 2016 progress and looking forward to a great 2017 season!

This project has been without a doubt the biggest eyeopener for me with regard to the game of golf. When we began the season I was a pretty solid bogey golfer. Steve worked on tearing me down and building me back up. There are so many facets of the game that I truly do have a much greater appreciation for not only the pros on tour but the Tour on the Shore players who consistently shoot low scores. Consistency is key. I ran a string of low to mid 80's for several rounds then had a blow up shooting over 100! Yes, it sucks! The one thing it did was totally destroy my confidence. It's a big difference standing over a ball knowing you can hit the green versus standing over a ball and hoping you don't break a window!

I'm going back to work this winter and I WILL get into a single digit handicap in 2017. I WILL break 80 in 2017. And I WILL win a Tour on the Shore trophy in 2017! This all takes a big commitment and I'm all in.





A Round of Struggle By Rob McDonald

It is commonly mentioned that people play golf to "relax". Sure, doing something that you love to do is relaxing. Enjoying some time spent in beautiful surroundings with your friends, away from the pressures of world is a form of relaxation. If you want to play your best though, you may want to change that approach to the game. If we changed the name of the game of golf to the game of Struggle, we could approach it with an entirely different mind set. The object of golf is to overcome obstacles in the fewest amount of shots possible. The obstacles come in many forms. Some, put in place by the architect are there to purposely challenge your every skill. Tees are aligned away from the center of the fairway

to challenge your alignment skills. Bunkers are strategically placed to test your accuracy as well as your visual perception by having them appear closer to the green than they really are. Water hazards sometimes are positioned in a way to dare you to carry them. Some obstacles are imposed by nature. Wind, cold, heat, rain, all play a role as an obstacle. Some obstacles are self-imposed. Fear of the outcome or placement of importance on the results contribute. It's a tournament so you try to play perfect golf.

If we change the name to Struggle, we might properly prepare our mind for what we are about to undertake. If we get bad bounces or end up in a bunker or hazard, we aren't upset. It's part of the struggle. It's the next challenge, in an effort to overcome the obstacles. If we have difficulty with particular obstacles, we work on enhancing our skills in that area to be better prepared the next time we face that challenge. We can battle harden ourselves to go into the game of struggle and overcome the obstacles. When we do come out on top, not just in the over-all round but each individual challenge, it is very rewarding. We have shown ourselves that we can, through practice, perseverance and determination, face the struggles and reap the rewards!





YOUR PATH TO PAR



Winter rules! The common description of invoking a local rule to permit preferred lies or enabling a player to lift, clean and place the ball when course conditions are considered adverse. Often derided by the purists and typically embraced by the casual player, advocacy for your choice to play or eschew "winter rules" is important to your progress as a player. Certainly the rules give structure to the

game, but the focus is on competition not skill development. To be considered a skillful golfer you must play by the rules. Yet, to develop your golfing skills you should do what helps you acquire the physical ability to make good golf shots unencumbered by impediments to learning.

Learning to play from bad lies is important. The process involves expanding techniques of shot making, understanding club selection options, improving strategic decisions in match, medal or Stapleford play, and maintaining the integrity of your scores and handicap for tournament competition. Learning to determine how various types of grass affect the ball flight and club performance is an art in itself. Whether the ball is in knee deep fescue, on "concrete firm" hardpan, or loose scattered pine needles bad lies are inevitable challenges to your skill and judgement. One key skill is learning to set up to the ball so you do not ground your club. This is beneficial to effective shot making from bad lies and has positive implications for all shots once you develop a tension free address position and the

confidence to incorporate this skill into your swing.

Learning to play shots from perfect lies is also important. This is especially true for players seeking to develop better swing technique. Introducing variable lies, never mind, poor lies is detrimental to developing an effective consistent swing. Improve your lie without guilt, until you are consistently striking the ball effectively then progress to more challenging lies. Golf should be fun and progressively challenging, not a masochistic exercise of conformity to dictated expectations. If you consider this view golfing heresy, consider that USGA and PGA tournament course conditions virtually preclude bad lies in fairways due to excellent maintenance, application of ground under repair designation for less than perfect conditions, and yes, "winter rules" or permitting the player to lift, clean and place the ball, when "adverse conditions" exist.

Maximizing your chance to hit solid shots hastens skill development and the enjoyment of the game. So give you self a break in casual rounds and improve your lie if you are working on swing changes or just learning the game. If you are a more advanced player take on the challenges of bad lies. Develop the skill of not grounding you club at address. In general, bad lies require a slightly steeper angle of attack and taking a more lofted club for such shots yield better results. Whether you are improving the lie or playing it down in a casual practice round remember your purpose is to develop a swing that will handle all conditions consistently. Do this well enough and you will see fewer bad lies, as you play more and more shots from the fairway.

"PUT CREDIT WHERE CREDIT IS DUE"

We have talked in past articles about general pain management, which in golfers is most often in joints. I'm sure you are all reading about the present problem with overuse of opioids; these are probably not the kind of things golfers would use unless under extreme duress ("got to make that 3 P.M. tee-off time").

One never knows. There are also problems` with the overuse of over-the-counter meds. Aspirin can cause stomach irritation, ibuprofen can adversely affect the kidneys, etc. But there is a relatively safe product that is non-prescription that can help. I have been using it for years to prevent joint discomfort, although that is not a big problem for me. It is a supplement called Turmeric containing a compound used in Eurasia for centuries, called curcumin. It, in addition to reducing joint pain, is also a powerful antioxidant, in addition to other benefits. I am not going to belabor the details; they can all be easily accessed on-line. The only drawback I could find is its use in people on blood thinners, so it needs to be checked with your LMD if you are thinking about using it. Certainly it is a lot safer than a lot of other stuff out there, but do yourself a favor and check it out before you consider bigger guns. I am always on the side of things that can provide benefits with minimal risk. Take care.` **by: Pete Zemo**




