

Eastern Shore Golf Magazine establishes "The Tour" Minority Golf Legends Scholarship

I would like to think that everyone that reads the Eastern Shore Golf Magazine (ESGM) on a regular basis knows that Holly and Ray Taranto along with the ESGM has a very good relationship with the University of Maryland Eastern Shore (UMES) and more specifically the PGA Golf Management Program.

A little history, Ray visited UMES in July 2008 pitching his idea of the magazine. the UMES Update, has written numerous stories on golf related issues at UMES, has given thousands of dollars in scholarships through the Eastern Shore Golf Hall of Fame, and has promoted the program by putting us on the cover of the magazine, twice!

As we know, Holly and Ray have successfully established the "Tour on the Shore" and the "Junior Tour on the Shore". In turn, a number of our students have participated in the "The Tour" events and we offer a full scholarship to the winner of the "Junior Tour on the Shore". This is just one example of how we support each other. Our latest endeavor will culminate next week in Port St. Lucie, FL at the "The Tour" Championship held at PGA Village. UMES is proud to be sponsoring "The Tour" Championship. In return, Holly and Ray have established "The Tour" Minority Golf Legends Scholarship which in its initial year will consist of a \$5000.00 donation to go to scholarships that support minority students enrolled in the UMES PGA Golf Management Program.

This is a huge help in diversifying an industry and assisting those that are fulfilling their dreams of working in the golf industry as members of the PGA of America.

Since 1954, The Women's Peninsula Golf Association (WPGA) has been promoting women's golf all across the Delmarva Peninsula. Founded over sixty (60) years ago, the WPGA has as its objective "to promote and regulate golfing activities for members having an eighteen hole certified USGA Handicap Index at a participating club on the DelMarVa Peninsula". Never wavering from its mission, the members of WPGA continue to promote women's golf. Through 23 member clubs, a network of women devoted to golf has continued to recruit new member clubs, encourage new women to join their clubs and WPGA, and play in WPGA sponsored tournaments.

The WPGA is governed by a Board of Directors made up of women representatives of member clubs. Officers are chosen from the member clubs on a rotating basis, determined by the order in which the member clubs joined WPGA, so every member club has an opportunity to participate in the leadership of the WPGA. Each year eight of the member clubs hold tournaments, also on a rotating basis, which provide WPGA members opportunities to play at clubs all around the DelMarVa Peninsula, to meet women from other clubs, test their skills, and experience a variety of courses. The formats of these tournaments are better ball (1BB2, 1BB4, 2BB4) plus a Championship, and a Senior/Super Senior Championship.

Member clubs provide open days during the active golf season.

On Open Days, WPGA members can play at other member clubs for cart fee only. This provides clubs with exposure to women from all around the Peninsula, and generates some additional revenue for the member clubs in cart fees, Pro Shop sales, and food and beverage purchases.

In the spring of each year, member clubs field teams of eight women to engage in match play against other member clubs. Teams compete within four divisions, based on geographic location of their clubs. At the end of the season, there are gross and net winning teams who will compete in semifinal and final play-offs to determine the overall gross and net winners for the season.

The golf season culminates with an Officers Appreciation tournament, held annually at the home club of the current WPGA President. This tournament provides an opportunity to thank the women from each member club who work tirelessly to make WPGA events and their own club events successful each year.

There are two general membership meetings annually, spring and fall, during which all member clubs participate in the governance of the WPGA, vote on new initiatives, and get an overview of the upcoming season.

Current members of the WPGA owe a huge debt of gratitude to the visionary women who, in 1954, saw the need to promote women's golf on the Peninsula. Membership in the WPGA is open to all golf clubs on the Peninsula, at an annual cost of \$30. Women members of those clubs are encouraged to join WPGA. Annual dues for individuals are \$15. Information about member clubs, tournaments, and club and individual membership is available on the WPGA website.



YOU KNOW THE DRILL

BY STEVE MENZ



"WEDGES FOR BETTER PUTTING? DO TELL!"

We are going to use wedges for better putting, but not the clubs in your bag. These wedges are shapes between your forearms and the putter grip. For this drill grab a putter and set up. Now I would like you to notice how your left forearm is on the club with relation to the grip. You should see a wedge-like space between your arm and the putter, there will also be another wedge like shape between your trail arm and the putter. The key to a solid, consistent putting stroke is to keep these shapes constant throughout the stroke.

Now you know the drill!




IF YOU TEND TO MAKE GOOD SHOTS WHEN TEEING UP WITH IRONS OR FAIRWAY WOODS ON PAR THREES, BUT STRUGGLE ON NORMAL OR **TIGHT LIES IN THE FAIRWAY YOU MAY** WANT TO T-UP YOUR ADDRESS POSITION AND STAND TALL.

MANY players are predestined to hit thin or topped shots before they even begin to swing the club. The culprit is often poor posture. In an effort to "stay down" on the shot, it seems logical to put more flex in the knees, or to lean forward closer to the ground and the ball. However, this is usually counter -productive. Players who do this tend to actually rise up into a taller posture at the initiation of the back swing. This is not intentional, but rather a natural reaction to regain balance from an unbalance start. Often keeping the head in a fixed position and "pointing" the lead shoulder toward the ball is a companion move. These motions will cause the trailing hip and shoulder to rise up creating a "rock and block" swing motion as weight is shifted back, forward and back, resulting in a variety of bad shots.

IF you stand tall at address the centrifugal force of the arms and club swinging and you natural instincts will get you "down" to the ball. It is important to understand that the plane of the arm swing is steeper than the plane of the shoulder turn. The ball is on the ground so your arms must swing back and up, then down and through the ball. Simultaneously, to create centrifugal force the body and the supporting movements of the feet and legs must rotate by simply turning away from the ball then back through the ball to the target. As you come down and through the shot the forces of the swing will extend your arms, the weight of the toe of the club head causes the shaft to flex toward the ground. You must "let" this happen rather than try to "make" it happen. A fluid swing motion will allow centrifugal force and leverage to create acceleration and power. If you consciously tense your muscles to control the swing these forces are diminished.

SO, T-up you starting position standing tall, with just enough knee flex and hip flex to comfortably reach the ball. Feel your head and chest maintaining a constant distance from the ball as you swing. Keep your chin up and head steady, but do not maintain a rigid fixed head position. Strive to improve your ability to make a full turn away from the ball. Keep the arm and chest action coordinated never rushing the rotation or attempting to spin rapidly through impact. Strive for a smooth acceleration down and through the ball to reach maximum speed past the ball not at the ball.


ACHIEVING better posture and swing motion is a process of evolution. It may take time to relax and stretch muscles that have been "taught to be taut or tense" by your current technique or daily life style. Swing a weighted training club to develop flexibility and the feel of centrifugal force. This can help you transition to a taller more balanced starting form, as you evolve to trusting that the "force" is with you when you stand tall and swing to the target.


TOOLS OF THE TRADE

One mistake that I see players make in their golf swings is not utilizing their lower body. They will normally swing the club back abruptly with their hands and arms causing the club to go too far to the inside and their weight to shift outside their back foot. This article is to help you learn how to feel lower body stability. To do this all we have to do is to get on our knees. You are going to simulate your stance and posture but do it while kneeling. No need to use a club, instead try bending you elbows upward and pointing your thumbs at the center of your chest. Now turn your upper body back while keeping your thumbs pointing at your chest. Try to keep your hips from turning. This will create pressure in your upper body versus your lower body and also train you how to turn the club back with your "big" muscles instead or you extremities (arms and hands). The club should be led by the body, usually this will keep it from going too far inside. This tip will also let you test the limits of your flexibility as well as train you how to stop your hips from rotating back too early in the swing. You should feel the lower body stabilize through the pressure. This pressure will have immediate positive influences on your swing such as distance and consistency. It will also teach you how to keep the weight on the inside of your feet throughout the back swing. Give this a try, if you have any questions feel free to reach out to smenz@agamegolfacademy.com. 
THE MORAL LOOK LONG AND PROSPER.



We all know, that in time, most of us develop joint problems, most commonly osteoarthritis of varying degrees. This, of course, presents problems with our golf game. While there is no cure for this condition, it, and other causes of joint pain, are treated by stopping golf (Ugh) or taking various analgesics to reduce the pain, most commonly aspirin or Motrin. While temporarily effective, the protracted use of these has side effects, some serious. I want to introduce you to some other options. I recently acquired a book by a natural physician who is a bonafide M.D., but who has studied natural cures for many problems. I want those of you who are interested to look up a substance called MSM, which stands for methylsulfonylmethane. It is overthe-counter and can be purchased at Wal Mart. My wife was bothered by some joint problems in her hands that our LMD felt, after X-rays and exam, was osteoarthritis. My concern was that she was overusing Motrin, so I had her try this med, which can be used orally and also topically. She used the topical creme on some knuckles that were bothersome in addition to the tablets. To make a long story short, her response was excellent. She still takes the pills, but her pain is mostly gone. Things like dosage and possible conflict with other drugs you have to look up yourself, but we found little, if any problem, with other drug interactions. There are lots of things out there that standard M.D.s don't know about, but if you have some interest in my book, it was written by Mark Stengler, NMD. The title is ":The Natural Physicians Healing Therapies". Good luck and good golf.






ANYTHING PEOPLE DON'T KNOW ABOUT YOU?
