H.B. REW JR. GOLF TOURNAMENT BY, BILL STERLING

The 29th H.B. Rew Jr. Golf Tournament benefiting the Eastern Shore Community College Foundation at the Eastern Shore Yacht and Country Club in Melfa, Va. had a fitting winner Friday, June 16.

When the first place prize was announced for the first flight, it was the 86-year-old Rew who was among a group of 80-year-olds to collect the prizes. In addition, Rew was also awarded the prize for being closest to the pin on the 17th hole with a shot that stopped six feet from the hole.

"We putted unbelievably," said Rew, who has played the ESY&CC course since it first opened in 1960. "Everyone contributed with some long putts. And I can't remember the last time I even hit the 17th green from the tee," added Rew, a resident of Onley who spent 50 years, much of it as president, with Farmers and Merchants Bank, now PNC.

Rew was joined by longtime golf buddies Gerald Davis and Vince Piazza, both 84, and also newcomer Herb Barnes, also 84. The foursome shot a tournament best 9-under par 61

with the best ball format, meaning each player would hit a shot and then use the best shot of the group. Using the players' handicaps, the group had a net score of 52. Rew said, "We had some guys who could make putts, but you've got to remember our combined age is 338 years. That's guite a handicap right there."

Rew said he had been on the winning team "not all that many times" since he helped to launch the tournament in 1988. Traditionally held at the ESY&CC course, the tournament benefits the Eastern Shore Community College Foundation, a group that supports the community college and provides scholarships to students who may not otherwise be able to attend college. Rew served on the board for many years.

Rew, who has been involved in Eastern Shore sports since his early youth, said, "At my age, I am working as hard as I can not to make this the H.B. Rew Memorial Golf Tournament."

CHECK & TRICKLE By Rob McDonald

It's an impressive shot. The player is about 15 yards off the green and hits a low shot, somewhat aggressively at the pin. You think it's going to run past the pin and off the green, but suddenly it checks up and trickles towards the hole. It's a shot that, if you learn it, will help your long game as well.

The most important thing to remember is that even though you are using a lofted club such as your sand wedge or lob wedge, you are not getting under the ball but striking down on the back of the ball. Pinching it against the ground with the club de-lofted. It's the de-lofted, high loft club that gives you the trickle instead of run out.

Setting up properly is an important key to hitting this shot successfully. Take a narrow stance with your target side foot pulled back slightly. Lean a bit more on your target side leg to get your weight on that leg. Have the ball slightly back in your stance with the handle leaning forward, in line with your target side arm.

This is a shot with minimal motion. There are very few moving parts. Leaving your weight on your front foot, use your shoulders to carry your arms and club away with a slight hinging of the wrists. Let the club head stay outside the hands on the way back.

Then, as one unit let your legs and hips carry the arms and club down and through the impact zone without releasing the wrist hinge. It is a non-release shot! You should feel your knuckles remain facing the ground though the bottom of the swing and the handle staying right with your sternum as you continue your rotation. If you picture the shaft label string down on the upper back half of the ball, this will help you with the idea of striking the ball with a downward force. Keeping the club head outside the hands on the finish will help in preventing a release.

As with everything in this game, spend time practicing to get a feel for this shot. Once you feel it with the short shot, you can begin applying it to longer shots as well.




















"ARCCOS VIRTUAL CADDIE"

TOOLS OF THE TRADE

In the past I have written articles on the Arccos Golf GPS and tour analytic sensors detailing what they can do for your golf game. The company has added a new feature that is incredible. They have paired with Microsoft and introduced the Arccos Virtual Caddie function. Best part, they did it for free. If you already own the system, you just got an instant upgrade. Those of you unfamiliar with the product, here is what is does. It puts sensors in all of your clubs that you pair with your smart phone. You turn the feature on and your work is done! It will track every shot you make and keep distance and percentages of every shot you play. Now here is the cool addition. The Virtual Caddie can now plot through your data to determine your best way to play each hole, maximizing your chances to play your best round. I have found this function to be extremely helpful on courses that I have not yet played. Not only will the GPS show you an aerial view of the hole, you can access the caddie feature and it will suggest what you should hit off of the tee to give you the best chance of hitting the fairway and making you best score. It already knows how far you hit each club through your usage. It also knows your percentage of hitting fairways and greens with each club. It also uses billions of data points collected by all of the Arccos community. Course management is no longer an issue. Arccos is by far the best shot tracker/ GPS in the game and it just got a whole lot better. Can't believe it is still only \$249. Must have for the serious golfer!


YOU KNOW THE DRILL

BY STEVE MENZ



Here is an old trick to help you "roll the rock" better in your putting stroke. Simply focus in the front of the golf ball through the stroke. That means, look at a spot on the ball closest to the hole. This will let you stroke through the ball and help the ball roll better off of the putter face. It also reduces ball skid and lets the ball roll more true to the line. This tip will also help in keeping your head more steady through the stroke. Sometimes our eyes tend to follow the putter through the stroke causing head movement and missing the sweet spot of the putter.

The heat is rising on the Shore, in degrees and competitiveness. The skill and commitment on display is higher than ever and everyone's looking for an edge. How can I lower my score, beat the "Dog Days" and enjoy the process enough to stay the course? Winners, Researchers and Game Coaches agree: At every level of development, Mental Toughness is a critical component.

Challenges come from all angles - physical demands, learning curves, time management, and competition - conspiring to zap the desire and drive that lifts athletes toward their potential. To power through the stumbling blocks, consider these three techniques to strengthen your mental approach.

- **1.** ACCEPT YOUR GOLF GAME FOR WHERE IT IS **TODAY:** The climb to be your best happens in phases acknowledging, accepting and appreciating your stage of development fights off the extreme self-analysis and comparison mentality that can destroy ambition.
- **2. EMPLOY "THE TEN-STEP" STATUTE:** Like counting to ten when frustration strikes, many top golfers allow the frustration from hitting a poor shot to run its course during the next ten footsteps only. After the tenth step, move into the present and leave the angst behind.
- **3. SMILE-** it sounds simple, but empirical evidence supports the notion that happiness breeds success. Pay attention to the small pleasures all around you: the warmth of the sun's rays, the great group of friends in your foursome, the beauty of the Eastern Shore. Take control of the moment.

As the greens and fairways get hotter, be cool. The most important real estate in the game is the six inches between your ears.

THE MORAL REMEMBER THE JOY!



THIS MONTH I want to revisit a very common problem not unique to the golfer but to people in general – back pain. We all know there are multiple causes, some more serious than others, such as herniated disc, etc. Treatments are varied, ranging from rest, medication, physical therapy, etc. up to surgery. For the golfer, modalities to improve the problem can be as simple as using proper back mechanics when lifting your bag to slowing down your backswing, using a longer putter and so on. However, I want to address another treatment option – exercise.

There was an article in the health section of the Washington Post that discussed this. The bottom line was strengthening the muscles of the "core" - the back and abdomen - can help to improve it and prevent future disabling episodes. The stronger these muscles, the more they can help stabilize the spine, build stamina, reduce the need for pain meds, etc. We have talked about these exercise programs in the past. They include yoga, pilates, aerobic training and water aerobics. The aforementioned article describes a study where yoga and aerobic strength training programs were compared to a self-care program guided by a book. After 26 weeks, the yoga and exercise groups reported more pain relief and return of back function than those doing self-care. Similar studies were done with pilates and aerobic training such as treadmills, stationary cycling and stair climbing. Water aerobics, of course, shifts weight away from the back so strengthening can occur for those who experience too much pain with treadmills, etc.

The bottom line, if you consider these options, is to find a quality fitness facility and hook up with a trainer experienced in these techniques. And let me emphasize experienced. 

YOUR PATH TO ACCELERATE YOUR GAME! SPEED SEEMS TO UNDERSCORE MOST OF THE MARKETING CAMPAIGNS IN GOLF. BALL DESIGN, SHAFT SPECIFICATIONS, FLEX CLUBFACE INSERTS, CLUB HEAD CENTER OF GRAVITY, GRIP WEIGHT, SWING TRAINERS AND TECHNIQUES PROMISE AND ENCOURAGE MORE SPEED AND BY INFERENCE GREATER POWER, DISTANCE AND LOWER SCORES. IS VELOCITY REALLY SO IMPORTANT?

SWING WITH INTENTION. The way you swing is a reflection of your attitude and intent for the shot at hand. Of all the things you can focus on as a swing key, velocity is arguably the least important and most destructive. When you intend to swing fast, the results are rarely good. A purposeful effort to swing fast causes most people to increase muscular tension in preparation for a herculean "effort". General tension slows your capacity for fast motion. The ability of your muscles to contract quickly is part of the equation, but the ability to contract only the muscles needed to affect the motion while otherwise remaining in a general state of relaxation is a complimentary component. Another critical impediment created by the intent to swing fast, is the disruption of optimal sequential movement. The arms swing gets ahead of the supportive action of the legs and rotation of the body reducing leverage and potential power.


"SWING EASY, HIT HARD!" Julius Boros offered this advice after winning his second U.S, Open, in 1963, defeating the penultimate power swinger Arnold Palmer in a playoff. It was the title of his third book, written at a time when power golf was ascending. Ironically, Boros' began his career at the top. His first win was the U.S. Open, in 1952 over challenges by Ben Hogan and Sam Snead. Following this initial victory Boros wrote: How to Play Golf with an Effortless Swing. Did Boros change his perspective or intent over the decade between Open Championships? No. What he did perhaps better than any player, was to personify how apparently effortless motion can develop powerful effects. Among modern players, Ernie Els seems most similar.

ACCELERATION IS THE PATH TO VELOCITY. The goal of swing technique is to create optimum mechanical positions within your personal physical abilities that can be released through the club into the ball. You best chance to do this consistently is by moving at a comfortable pace in the backswing and start of the downswing. Great players who have commented on the subject of swing speed indicate a level of perceived effort of 80% or less. Annika Sorenstam instructed her caddy to say the word "six", when a critical shot was at hand as a reminder that she wanted to swing at level 6 on a 10 point scale. However, the same players concur that once the downswing is comfortably initiated, the swing through and past the ball should accelerate progressively and without restriction. Just let it go. Swing easy, hit hard. Bobby Jones called this uninhibited action "freewheeling through the ball". If you start down fast from the top of the backswing, you will not achieve greater speed than starting down deliberately maintaining a balanced sequence of motion. To the contrary if your arm swing feels fast it is probably slowing club head speed.

UNDERSTANDING YOUR PERSONAL "**SWING TIME**", the overall time it takes you to move back and through the ball, is the challenge to creating progressive acceleration. Practice swinging at a speed comfortable to you. Move back down and through at an even pace. You may sense acceleration as you feel a two count tempo, back and through. However, as you swing back on count 1, you must change direction, swing down and through on count 2. More physical movement in the same amount of time and space, the transition, down, and through swing is 3 times faster than the backswing, without the perception or intention to increase the arm swing speed. Some fascinating research by John Novosel confirmed that individual differences in "swing time" among great players from Bobby Jones through Tiger Woods exist, yet they all shared a common backswing to down swing ratio of three to one.
