### YOU KNOW THE DRILL

### **CHECK YOSELF**

Here is a quick and free way to see if your clubs fit your swing with a sharpie and an old ball. Draw a thick straight line about an inch or two long on the ball. Place the ball with the line straight up and down so that the face of the club will strike the sharpie line on the ball. Hit the ball and you will see the remnants of the line on the face of your club. If the line is straight up the face, you are all set. If the line points more towards the shaft your club is coming in too upright. If the line is point more towards the toe of the club, your lie angle is too flat.

Now you know the drill!

### YOUR PATH TO

#### **GOLF IS PARADOXICAL.**

You strike down on the ball to get it up. The more muscular effort and tension you exert the more you reduce, accuracy, speed and power. Less is more to lower your score. The "secret skill" in golf is to set aside ego and aspirations and learn to simplify your efforts not magnify them. Learning to do this is best done away from the course. It is the perfect "golf activity" for cold winter months.

Learn to "think inside the box", when the weather drives you indoors. All golfers engage in three distinct processes in making a shot. First, you determine what you want to do. You calculate the variables and determine club selection and target. Second, you prepare to make the swing to the target. Grip, alignment, ball position, length and tempo of swing are intentions of this phase. Finally, you make the shot. Highly skilled players make the right decisions and preparations almost instinctively when playing well. Tournament players take almost the exact amount of time, typically 25 seconds, to blend these phases on every shot. If circumstances require greater time in any phase the results are usually not good even for the best players. The irony is that recreational golfers are typically required to think about things that are reflexive for the tournament player, simply because the casual player has not practiced and perfected skills to perform them properly without thinking.

This winter take time to practice your set up. Make the process of grip, alignment, posture, ball position automatic. This is a great time to form better habits. If you have been working on technical changes, time spent making the correct technique habitual will improve your game. If you are not making changes focus on being precise and consistent with your existing technique. Define your set up sequence then practice a "check and forget pattern" for each component of the set up. Move purposefully but quickly through each position, check it off and move to the next. This mind set is the same you want throughout the round. Make the shot then forget it and move immediately on to the next challenge and opportunity.

A straight line reference, a line on a carpet, a hardwood floor plank, the edge of a wall, a small box, anything to confirm the clubface alignment is perpendicular to the ball target line is essential to practicing the set up. Set up to the clubface so you can comfortably swing along the ball target line. Even if your technique and position is faulty being consistent it is better than being random and clueless. You can adapt and learn to improve from a consistent starting point.

On the course you will be able to "think inside the box" and "play outside the box". You will consciously identify the target, make you club selection, and commit to the shot while standing "inside the imaginary box" behind the ball. Once you step out of the box you will move through the set up with an awareness of purpose but not the paralysis of thought. There will be no second guessing. No questions: Is this right? Establish the target line, set up, be confident and comfortable, and then just swing.

MarkTurgeon

...is entering his seventh season at the helm of the University of Maryland men's basketball team after leading the Terrapins to their third consecutive NCAA Tournament. Turgeon, who has won 24 or more games in four different seasons with the Terrapins, owns a 388-227 (.631) overall record in 19 seasons as a Division I head coach. He has led three different programs to 12 postseason appearances, which includes the Terps advancing to their first Sweet 16 in 13 years in the 2015-2016 season. Turgeon signed a fouryear contract extension through the 2022-23 season on Oct. 27, 2016.

In his first six seasons at Maryland, Turgeon has compiled a 138-67 (.673) record. He recorded the most wins for a head coach in his first five years in program history (114). Turgeon has won 79 games the past three seasons, adding up to the second-most wins in school history over a three-year span. He is the first coach in Maryland history to lead the Terps to three 24-plus regular season-win seasons. Turgeon also had the Terrapins ranked in the Associated Press top-25 for 36 consecutive weeks, including 20 weeks in the top-10. Maryland had previously not been ranked in the top-10 since Feb. 3, 2003, a span of 12 seasons.

Under Turgeon, Maryland has also thrived in its first three seasons as members of the Big Ten Conference, earning three top-3 finishes and compiling a 38-16 (.703) conference record. Turgeon's teams boast a 22-5 home record in conference play, including a perfect 9-0 mark in its inaugural season. He was named the 2015 Big Ten Coach of the Year.

Since taking over the program in 2011-12, Turgeon's Terrapins have amassed a 90-18 (.83.3) home record overall, marking the best home winning percentage by a coach in school history. Under his direction, Maryland recorded the most consecutive wins at home in program history (27) from Dec. 6, 2015 - Feb. 13, 2016.

Turgeon has led the Terrapins to a 30-11 record through their first 41 Big Ten games, becoming the fastest Big Ten coach to reach 30 conference wins since former Illinois



mentor Bruce Weber guided the Illini to 30 victories in his first 35 conference games at the helm during the 2003-04 and 2004-05 campaigns and the first three conference games of the 2005-06 season.

Turgeon has led his teams to a winning season in 16 of his 19 seasons, including a current streak of 15 consecutive winning seasons. The Terps won 27 or more games in back-to-back seasons for the first time in program history during the 2014-15 and 2015-16 campaigns.

In 2016-17, Turgeon led Maryland to a 24-9 record, an impressive 11-2 mark away from XFINITY Center and its aforementioned third consecutive trip to the NCAA Tournament. With a 20-2

record through 22 games in 2016-17, Turgeon topped the 1998-99 squad for the best regular season start in program history. Additionally, Turgeon was instrumental in the development of three-time All-Big Ten guard Melo Trimble, who became one of just four players to post 1,600 points, 400 assists and 150 steals at Maryland.

Under Turgeon's direction the 2015-16 team finished with 27 victories and opened the regular season with a 15-1 record – the best start in program history. Maryland featured five All-Big Ten performers, including guard Melo Trimble (Second Team All-Big Ten) who was also named to the Associated Press Honorable Mention All-America Team. Center Diamond Stone was a Third Team All-Big Ten selection and was named Associated Press Big Ten Newcomer of the Year. Forwards Jake Layman and Robert Carter, Jr., as well as guard Rasheed Sulaimon each earned Honorable Mention All-Big Ten honors.

Maryland posted victories over five teams that advanced to the 2016 NCAA Tournament. In addition, the Terrapins also defeated rival Georgetown in a monumental game played on the College Park campus for the first time in four decades.

Maryland, ranked No. 18 in the Associated Press and No. 12 in the USA Today/ESPN Coaches poll, finished 27-9, marking the first time in program history the Terps have put together back-to-back 27-plus win seasons. Maryland's 4-0 start in conference play marked the best start since 1996-97.

The Terrapins also led the Big Ten and ranked fifth nationally in attendance in 2015-16, averaging 17,863 fans per game.

Maryland posted a school-record 26 wins during the regular season in 2014-15 and notched 28 total, an eight-game improvement from its 17 victories during the 2013-14 season. The 11-game win total was the second-highest improvement among all Power Five schools. Maryland also advanced to the third round of the NCAA Tournament.

The Terps finished their inaugural season

in the Big Ten with an aforementioned 9-0 home record, which included victories against then-No. 5 Wisconsin, Michigan State and Indiana. Overall, Maryland concluded with an 18-1 home mark at XFINITY Center.

Maryland's 14-1 record in 2014-15 marked its best start in 18 years (1996-97). Turgeon posted 25 or more wins in a season for the fourth time in his career.

Since arriving in College Park, Turgeon has signed five consecutive nationally-ranked recruiting classes, including a top-10 class in 2016. He played a lead role in signing center Diamond Stone (Milwaukee, Wisc.) – a McDonald's All-American who was one of the highest-rated recruits to sign with the Terps in program history.

Under Turgeon, the men's basketball team posted its highest single year APR score of a perfect 1,000 in 2012-13 and has also graduated all 11 of his student-athletes who have exhausted their eligibility at Maryland.

In 2013, he captured his 300th career victory with an 85-74 defeat of Tulsa on Dec. 29, before leading the Terps to a thrilling overtime win against No. 5 Virginia in Maryland's final ACC regular season game.

Turgeon's winning percentage of .600 (42-28) was the best mark by a Maryland coach in his first two seasons, ahead of Bud Millikan (.592) and Gary Williams (.574). After bringing in a top-15 recruiting class in 2012, he led the Terrapins to a 25-13 record (most wins in six seasons) and appearances in the ACC Tournament semifinals and the NIT semifinals in 2012-13.

Turgeon directed Maryland to three wins over a ranked team in 2012-13 after Maryland had gone two seasons without one. The Terps were the only team in the nation to beat Duke twice, while also knocking off then-14th ranked NC State at home in January. Maryland's win over Duke at home on Feb. 16 was its first over a No. 1 ranked opponent in five years.

Turgeon, who came to College Park after directing Texas A&M to four consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament, led Maryland to a 17-15 record in 2011-12. At A&M, he posted a 97-40 record in four seasons and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in both 2010 and 2011. He is the only coach in Big 12 history with at least 24 victories in each of

his four seasons.

In seven years at Wichita State, he built the Shockers into a power in the Missouri Valley Conference, earning the league title and an NCAA Sweet Sixteen appearance in 2006. In that NCAA Tournament, Wichita State beat Seton Hall and Tennessee before losing to eventual Final Four participant George Mason.

Turgeon has developed eight former players into the NBA: Gal Mekel (formerly of the Dallas Mavericks and New Orleans Pelicans), Donald Sloan (Washington Wizards), Khris Middleton (Milwaukee Bucks), DeAndre Jordan (Los Angeles Clippers), Alex Len (Phoenix Suns), Jake Layman (Portland Trailblazers), Diamond Stone (Chicago Bulls) and Melo Trimble (Minnesota Timberwolves). Len was selected in the first round (fifth overall) by the Suns in the 2013 NBA Draft while Stone and Layman were both picked up in the second round of the 2016 NBA Draft. In addition, Dez Wells (Oklahoma City Blue) and Rasheed Sulaimon (Greensboro Swarm) played in the NBA D-League in 2016-17.

Turgeon amassed a 128-89 record at Wichita State (2000-07), posting the third-most wins in school history. The Shockers advanced to three straight NITs from 2003 to 2005 in addition to the 2006 NCAAs, the first time WSU had four straight postseason appearances in 40 years.

He began his head-coaching career at Jacksonville State, going 17-11 in his final season there (1999-2000) after going 8-18 in his first year.

Turgeon was an assistant at Kansas for five seasons, first under Larry Brown (1987-88) and then under Roy Williams (1988-92). The Jayhawks made the NCAA Tournament in four of those seasons, winning the national championship in 1988 and finishing second in 1991. KU also won Big Eight titles in 1991 and 1992 with Turgeon on staff.

He was the top assistant under Jerry Green at Oregon from 1992-97 and was an assistant coach under Brown with the Philadelphia 76ers in 1997-98 before taking the head coaching position at Jacksonville

A point guard at Kansas from 1984-87, Turgeon was the first player in Jayhawks history to play in four straight NCAA Tournaments. KU went 108-33 under Brown in that stretch. Turgeon served as team captain in his junior and senior seasons, leading the Jayhawks to the 1986 NCAA Final Four.

As a student-athlete, he was selected to the Big Eight All-Academic Team in 1986 and was a Big Eight All-Freshman pick in 1984. He earned a bachelor of science degree in personnel administration from Kansas in 1987.

A native of Topeka, Kan., Turgeon led Hayden High School to back-to-back Class 4A state titles in 1982 and 1983, earning all-tournament honors each year. A first team all-state pick as a senior, Hayden went 47-3 in his high-school career.

In the summer of 2008, Turgeon was inducted into the Topeka Sports Hall of Fame. He was also honored as the 2015 Kansan of the Year in June, 2015.

Additionally, Turgeon was selected as a court coach for the USA Basketball Pan-American Team in preparation for the Pan-Am Games in the summer of 2015. The following year, Turgeon served as an assistant coach for USA Basketball's Under 18 Team, working with head coach Shaka Smart and assistant coach Kevin Ollie, in helping guide the squad to a gold medal. On June 13, 2016, he was named to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) ad hoc committee on NCAA men's basketball tournament selection, seeding and bracketing.

Turgeon is active in the College Park community and has hosted the Coaches vs. Cancer Season Tip-Off Breakfast in conjunction with the American Cancer Society and the National Association of Basketball Coaches for five years. Over the past three seasons, Turgeon worked with the Infiniti Coaches Charity Challenge to raise money and awareness for the Alzheimer's Association. In addition, Turgeon and his team worked with the Special Olympics of Maryland and hosted a basketball clinic for athletes in the organization along with inviting them to home games during the 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons. Turgeon also participated in the Special Olympics Relay Across America carrying the Flame for Hope through the College Park campus in 2016.


#### FALSE START By Rob McDonald

You're almost there, but something is just a little off. The ball striking is not as solid as it was the last time out, so the distance and accuracy are aren't there either. Your swing feels the same so what's the problem?

It could be you're getting off to a false start. I've mentioned often about the core muscles, your inner body creating the take away. As false start is when you think you are turning from the inner body but in actuality, your upper arms and shoulders are making the first move. A shoulder turn is not the same as a coil from the inner body. Your shoulders are just the narrow, upper portion of the upper body and can move independent of the inner body. When you are starting with the upper arms or shoulders, it becomes more difficult to make a complete turn behind the ball. When this happens, your arms are already behind you as you begin the forward swing and your hands and club have to play catch-up. This is where the inconsistent, less solid ball striking happens.

To get back to your core creating the coil, without a club, just relax your arms and bring them into your chest. Set your feet firmly to the ground, knees inward and feel your back muscles twist against that connection to the ground until your shoulders are between your feet, perpendicular to the stance line. This should feel different than what you were feeling with the club for your swing. It should feel well inside your upper body. Now with your club, set up and let a breath out to soften your arms and shoulders and feel the same inner body coil. Let your arms take a ride.

This should help you recover from the false starts and get back on target!

#### 15 MINUTES TO MORE CONSISTENT PUTTING

When a student comes to me for help with their putting I know they have lost some consistency in the way they roll the ball. I typically start each lesson with this 15 minute practice routine to ensure the student is working on getting a more consistent roll off the putter face.

- $◆ 1^{\text{ST}} 5$ MINUTES ◆ For a right handed golfer hold the putter with just the left hand and hit putts at no particular target. Ensure that the backside of the left hand is moving past the lead (left) leg as you hit putts. If not, the wrist is breaking down and adding loft to the putter, which will kill consistency. Ideally you want the left hand and wrist to stay flat and move towards the target. This will keep the putter face square producing a true roll.
- 2<sup>ND</sup> 5MINUTES ◆ Grip the putter with both hands and again roll putts at no particular target. Now as you hit putts again ensure that your lead hand (left hand for right handed golfer) is moving past your lead leg as you hit putts. If you're able to do this you will notice two things: one, the left hand and wrist will be flat and two, the right hand/wrist should be cupped.
- 3<sup>RD</sup> 5MINUTES ◆ Now pick out a hole to roll some putts toward. I would suggest a relatively straight 6-8 foot putt. Use what you've worked on the first ten minutes to try and make some putts. Notice that your lead hand will control the direction the ball will go. If you're able to put this all together I guarantee you will see a bunch of these putts go in!

Obviously being able to control your speed and reading greens are very important but this is the first step to better putting. I hope this tip helps you make more putts. For more like it, visit us at the Heritage Shores Facebook page.


setting up an eagle putt. With Brooks Massey




