Celebrates a Rich 60 year History

The Pepsi Invitational, more than any other women's golf tournament on the Delmarva Peninsula, has a long history of championship golf.

That competitive spirit really surfaced in 1971 - one of the most nail-biting years in the 60 year history of the two-day tournament.

Rain or shine, competitors always gathered around the scoreboard following their rounds at the annual Pepsi Invitational Tournament.

Jane Mason, in 1989, after receiving the Pepsi Cup for her 9th win at the Pepsi Invitational. Mason went on to win the tourney a record ten times over the 60 year tournament history.

In that 14th year of the Pepsi, 135 women entered from 28 clubs in Maryland, Delaware, Virginia, North Carolina, New Jersey & Florida. There were 18 entries with 10 & under handicaps, and only two of those were from the Eastern Shore.

One of those two was our local four-time defending champ Jane Mason . She entered with a two handicap. She was the 1965 Maryland State Champion & the 1965 & 70 Mid Atlantic Champion. The second local golfer was junior golfer Beth Hughes of Denton. She twice won the Jr. Girls' Championship of Maryland and was the reigning Eastern Shore Girls' Champion.

Other standout competitors were Robbye Youel, of Charlottesville VA, with a handicap of one. She was the 1964 Virginia State Champion, the District of Columbia Champion in 1962 & 1963, the Maryland State Champion in 1964 and the Middle Atlantic Champion in 1963 & 1964.

Mary Alice Canney of Centerville, VA was expected to be a threat. She was the O'Sullivan Open Amateur Champion in 1970 and the 1968 Virginia State Champion.

The 1967 Maryland State champion and the 1968-69 Baltimore City champion, Joan Winchester, was also competing. "It was the best quality championship flight ever," reported co-chairs Betty Lou Steffens and Madeline Perdue.

After the opening round, Youel led with a 74, Canney with a 76, and Winchester with a 78 followed close. Beth Hughes and Jane Mason stood at fourth and fifth places respectively.

Many thought the "Women's Golf Queen of Delmarva" Jane Mason would close on the second day with determined grit to win.

Mason, who in 2016 was named the Honorary Pepsi Chair, shared, "The most important thing in golf is the friends you meet."

"I always try to be sociable and friendly when I play. The spirit of the game is important," she added.

"You get 'feelings' about golf tournaments," wrote reporter Blair Holley in 1979. "The Pepsi Invitational at Green Hill always offers an upbeat feeling almost as soon as one drives into the handsome club in Quantico."

Jane Mason has been a local ingredient

Jane Mason has been a local ingredient to that success, and so has been the financial support of Pepsi Bottling Company over the past 60 years.

Today, the Pepsi Invitational continues with a different format. The one-day tournament format is now a Best Ball of 2. This year, the Pepsi Committee will honor those past champions in celebrating their 60th year of hosting this event.

Discounted practice rounds and special hotel rates are available.

Back to the 1971 nail biter . . . Mary Alice Canney came from second place to win the Tournament. She posted 76-76 —152 scoring five birdies along the way. Runner-Up Youel carded a 156, and Mason won the championship flight tallying a 160.

After that year, Mason went on to win the Pepsi six more times, proving that "nice" golfers really can finish first.






2018 KICK-OFF EVENT

EASTERN SHORE GOLF HALL OF FAMER

1ST AFRICAN-AMERICAN SO HONORED SATURDAY, DECEMBER 2, 2018

MARSHALL CROPPER UMES MEN'S GOLF COACH IS AMONG SIX PEOPLE IN THE CLASS OF 2017 INDUCTED INTO THE EASTERN SHORE GOLF HALL OF FAME.

Cropper, who grew up in Accomack County, Va., is the first African-American to be so honored by the recognition program Eastern Shore Golf Magazine started in 2011.

Proceeds from the induction banquet at the Ocean City Golf Club, which attracted a gathering of 150 people including a contingent of UMES supporters, benefited the university's PGA golf management program.

Golf management student James Robinson received a \$2,000 scholarship during the ceremony.

Cropper, a 1967 graduate of then-Maryland State College, studied physical education, played baseball and football - and found his interest in golf.

Cropper played wide receiver for three seasons with the Pittsburgh Steelers, including one year under pro football hall of fame coach Chuck Noll. He found gratification playing golf during summer training camp in Latrobe, Pa., best known as the late Arnold Palmer's hometown. Cropper fondly recalls using a driving range where he received tips from Palmer, widely considered the game's most popular player.

His encounters with the man affectionately known in golf circles as The King in the late 1960s paid off in the long run.

Having a passion working with youth, he used golf as a tool to teach life skills, and also used golf as a fundraiser during his NFL days to finance youth camps

Following his stint in the NFL, Cropper eventually found his way back to Princess Anne, where he helped lay the groundwork for a degree program at UMES that would introduce more African-Americans to the game of golf.

In 2008, the PGA golf management program was established, making the university the nation's first historically black institution to offer a PGA-accredited degree.

Cropper's experience with fundraising continued to flourish with work for the Art Shell Golf Classic, an event that attracted a broad spectrum of golfers from all walks of life and introduced them to UMES.

Now serving as head coach of his alma mater's men's golf team as well as the university's Golf Academy coordinator, Cropper started a Hall of Fame Golf Outing this past fall. The star of the inaugural event again was Art Shell, his former Hawk teammate and a pro football Hall of Fame member.

True to his fundraising roots, the proceeds were set aside for men's golf.

The University of Maryland Eastern Shore's athletics Hall of Fame inducted Cropper in 1984 to for his contributions to the Hawks.

Other honorees inducted Dec. 2 along with Cropper were: James Apple, Bob Baldassari, Laura Dibbern, Edmund Quillen and Sandy Scitti.

YOU KNOW THE DRILL

I see many players struggle with the club face position through out the swing. It is difficult to feel how to keep the club face square through the swing so here is a drill you CAN do at home, in the house with a hard covered book. Make a "C" out of your left hand and place the book inside the knuckles. Take your address position and square the book to your target line. Practice your take away to the top. The book will show you a great representation of what your club face is doing through out the back swing. If you have unnecessary hand action it will be identified rather quickly. Repeat the process with your right hand. You should be able to feel and see what your hands should be doing throughout the back swing.





New Season Prep By Rob McDonald


Warmer days are finally upon us and instead of watching the pros play in short sleeved shirts in Hawaii and California, we are finally able to get out there and tee it up ourselves.

After a winter without golf, how can you prepare for a great season? First, you should check your grips. Over time your hand oils and dirt creep into the grip and make it firm and slick. This causes you to hold on tighter and tightness is detrimental to your swing. Having your old grips replaced with new ones is a simple process that will make it feel like you have a new set of clubs. With less tension in your hands, you can have more club head speed, with less effort. You will also have the opportunity for better feel around the greens.

When you take a break from golf, the first thing to leave you and the last thing to come back is your short game touch. Rather than running to the driving range to hit a few balls before heading out on the course, find an hour or two earlier in the day or in the week and hit the short game area. Hit some partial wedges from different distances. These are the types of shots that will give you the most

trouble after a layoff. Head to the putting green and work on some of the basics. Making sure your body and hands are quiet through the stroke will help to get more solid contact. A little motion with the head through impact is subtle but can be enough for a missed putt. Check your alignment. You can make a great stroke but if you're aiming wrong you'll miss. Get control over the pace and length of your back swing. Your rhythm should be smooth away, smooth change of directions, smooth acceleration. Your tendency may be to have a quick back swing which could throw your distance control off kilter.

An attitude awareness check could also be in order. Don't go out there expecting mid-season form. You will make mistakes and if you're okay with that, your enjoyment level will be higher. If your enjoyment level is higher, you have a better chance of playing better golf. Be happy that you're finally getting out on the course. FYI, this should be the attitude in mid-season as well! Remember, if you free yourself up to hit bad shots, you free yourself up to hit good shots as well! Now go have fun!!!

GOLF PSYCHOLOGY - GET YOUR HEAD IN THE GAME

A golfer commits to a strength and conditioning program and can see and feel growth. The desired effect - increasing power and endurance - is easily measurable, on and off the course, and the athlete's effort is positively reinforced, letting the golfer know her decision to workout is a good one. She hits the ball further, has more energy, and is less likely to experience injuries.

She works with a Swing Coach who uses state-of-the-art technology to capture and analyze movement efficiency, and the audio and visual feedback gives the golfer a real-time diagnosis of the smallest details of each golf swing. The Instructor can quickly evaluate the athlete and prescribe a precise plan for better results.

She's physically fit and armed with a wealth of knowledge that will help her spring into the competitive season and accomplish her goals. Top golfers say she has one more crucial step to maximize potential: Mental Conditioning.



WHAT IS BOUNCE? WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

HOW DO YOU DECIDE HOW MUCH BOUNCE IS RIGHT FOR YOU?

Bounce angle of a wedge is known by most diehard golfers but not many truly understand what it is and why it is so important. For most wedges you will notice two numbers imprinted on the club. The big number represents the clubs degree of loft and the smaller number represents its bounce. Bounce is the measurement in degrees, from the leading edge, the sole of the club and the ground. In basic terms, bounce is the measurement of how much the sole of the club lifts the leading edge.

As you have probably noticed wedges are made with a much wider sole than your irons. They were created this way to reduce resistance from the sand/ground when attempting to hit behind the golf ball. I like to explain it as follows:

Think of your wedge as being skimboard with the sole being the bottom of the skimboard and the leading edge as being the nose. When you apply your weight on the front portion of the board, the nose digs into the sand and the skimboard comes to a screeching halt. But if you apply your weight to the back of the board it allows the bottom to glide across the sand. Using this analogy apply the same aspects to a bunker shot. In the bunker you want to contact the sand with the sole of the golf club so you can glide the club through the sand. If you contact the sand with the leading edge it will create resistance and dig into the sand which creates inconsistent and "chunky" shots.

Using that knowledge most people believe that the higher the bounce the easier it is to hit good, consistent shots. That could not be further from the truth. Determining the proper amount of bounce that is appropriate for you depends on a few factors.

The first factor is your swing plane or angle of attack towards the golf ball. The simplest way to explain the angle of attack is to ask yourself one question. Do you take divots with your wedges? If so, then you most likely have a steep angle of attack and are commonly referred to as a "Digger". If you do not take divots then in all likelihood you have a shallow swing path and are generally referred to as a "Picker". "Diggers" normally benefit from wedges with a higher bounce and wider sole while a "Picker" will typically benefit from a wedge with less bounce and a narrow sole.

The second factor in determining the proper amount of bounce for your wedges are the conditions of the golf course you are playing. Golf courses that are dry, firm, and cut tight are more suitable for wedges with a low bounce and narrow sole. This is because the tight lie and firm ground will hinder the sole from sliding under the golf ball causing the leading edge of the club to contact the ball at or above its equator, producing thin or sculled shots. A wedge with a higher bounce and wider sole would be more appropriate for a course that is fairly wet, has soft spongy ground or is cut at higher dimensions. The soft ground and higher cutting height will permit some give and allow the sole of the wedge to glide through the turf ensuring the leading edge contacts the ball below its equator.

While bounce angle is nothing new in the golf industry there have been advancements in the type of grinds and soles designed within the past few years. Titleist alone has come out with 5 new sole grinds that should provide options for every type of player. May the **COURSE** be with You!

We have an expression here at Washington High school on our golf team, "Golf es la vida!" (Golf is life). No other sport mirrors life and prepares you better than golf does. Golf is an honor sport, where you are required to do the right thing even if that means giving yourself a penalty. Golf is the only sport you will play that is truly a lifetime sport. The lessons and things that I have learned through golf are priceless in my mind. Coaching golf has been the most rewarding and difficult thing I have ever attempted. With other sports you as the coach can help, assist, correct and modify play when things are not producing results. Golf however mandates that all this

preparation occurs prior to play and the match. I have to develop my player's skills, methods, form, toolboxes and recovery systems during our practice rounds; then hope they can recall the lesson and use it

when the time is appropriate.

This leads me to my first installment of my new column "May the Course be with You," prep work. As the weather starts to get better, most golfers start to get a major itch to get back out on the course and play! One major error that I have seen throughout the years is that players believe that you can pick up right where you left off last fall. Most players are playing their best golf at the end of the season and the small things have been refined and mastered. So where does the prep work start? The range? The gym? The course? Each person is different; however you need a plan or set of goals to start your season off right. I am sure that I am like most of you, reading lots of articles about how to improve my game; watching videos and tutorials to mold my swing and game into a better version for the 2018 season. My friend Eric H gave me an amazing idea, cut all the ideas out of the magazines and glue them into a notebook. This way you have a variety of drills, workouts and focus points to help you out during the late winter and early spring months. Most of all, remember golf is a game that can never be mastered. I will leave you with a great quote from Bobby Jones, "Golf is the closet game to the game we call life. You get bad breaks from good shots; you get good breaks from bad shots- but you have to play the ball where it lies."




"TECH WITH A TWIST"


Every year club manufacturers release new products with the promise of more distance, higher launch and increased club head speed. While it's true we have seen many advances in distance through out the years, it also means that we have seen the ball fly further off line. Most humans don't replicate what the golf bots produce in consistency and accuracy. For many years the standard driver and fairway wood club face featured "bulge and roll" tech. Quite simply the face was shaped like an upside down frying pan that is supposed to make High toe hits release right and curve back to the center and low heel hits release left and come back as well. What actually happened was low hooks and high slices. This tech has created a high shot dispersions and less accuracy with fewer fairways hit. TaylorMade has taken that info and over half a million data points and designed a groundbreaking

tech this year. Hello "twist face"! Using their data they realized the three basic human swing patterns resemble an egg shape pattern from the heel of the club face diagonal up to the toe of the face. With this twist they have added loft to the toe and decreased loft in the heel. The face actually looks like a small section of a cork screw, barely noticeable at address. What it has done has been amazing. It has decreased shot dispersion at a record level. Low heel hits will not slice as much and high toe hits will not hook as much. How much? How about "bulge and roll" dispersion of 14 yards right to left compared to "twist face" dispersion of 2 yards using the same parameters.

PGA Tour 6 weeks ago, "twist the first 5 events and came in 2nd, 3rd and 5th in the 6th event. Even though I bought a new driver last year, the first time in 7 years, I'll be putting this one in my bag this year for sure!

IS TIGER WOODS COMEBACK PATH ONE YOU SHOULD FOLLOW?

For the golf historian's and students of the golf swing, Tiger Woods comeback challenge is intriguing. Setting the entertainment drama, hype and peripheral issues a aside, there are significant lessons about golf that are useful to the average player.

The picture attached to my articles was taken at the Hogan statue overlooking the 18th green at Riviera Country Club. A place where Hogan emerged as a great player. A tragic and disadvantaged childhood, a desperate struggle to become a tour player were overcome when he found his swing and won his first US Open at the "Riv" in 1948. In 1949 Hogan was nearly killed in an head on collision with a bus. Doctors said he may never walk again. Within a year Hogan came back to Riviera. Tying Sam Snead for the 1950 LA Open championship. Then to Merion and triumphs in 6 of the next 8 majors he entered. The point is Hogan took nearly a decade to find his game, then lost it to physical injury. Adapting to what he knew was best for him and to what his physical limitations allowed, Hogan earned his revered status.

Tiger's comeback situation is similar to Hogan only in the sense that physical injury has forced swing modifications. Blessed with enormous physical ability he has had the benefit of the best training and playing experiences since childhood and continuously pursued perfection in his game. This year will unveil the 5th major swing modification of his career. Tiger has said he seeks to "own his swing" a quality that he recognized Hogan possessed. In essence, "owning your swing" is to know what works for you and why in the simplest of terms. That Hogan dug 5 fundamentals "out of the dirt", and Tiger embraced nuanced complexities of biomechanics an physics is their histories.

What is evident in Tiger's current technique is an emphasis on fundamentals that are beneficial for the recreational golfer with less demand for extraordinary physical strength and flexibility. The essential components are:

- Standing taller at address to create the foundation for a wide arc arm swing.
- Combining hip and shoulder motion requiring less spinal rotation and stress in the backswing.
- Backswing position is compact shaft of club not reaching parallel to the ground keeping within a comfortable range of motion.
- Making the arm swing motion fluid smoothly transitioning and accelerating through the ball.
- Finishing tall and balanced over the lead foot.

Can Tiger comeback. Certainly. From tee to green he may even improve the quality of his shotmaking. But, one attribute has defined nearly all dominant players in the last 100 years. Putting. The capacity to make the unmakeable putt at just the right moment, and never miss the short ones. Jack Nicklaus incredible career endured in large part because he never lost the gift to make the must make putt. When faced with a breaking 18 foot putt on the last hole of his last competitive round, at St. Andrews, in The Open, it went in like dozens of others in his major triumphs. Tiger had this gift, will he regain it?

For Hogan, for Tiger, for all of us the surest path to golfing success is matching our shot makings technique to our physical abilities, and mastering the flat stick If you want help in evolving your game come see us at the Original Golf School.
