While our golf course is open 12 months out of the year, we Delawareans really only have a 7-month playing season. So for most of us fair weather golfers, we haven't touched a club for 5 months because April is basically the start of the golf season. It's very easy to pick up bad habits if you just step up to the driving range and start ripping drivers. After a long layoff, it's very important that you focus on your fundamentals and start small. Here's a checklist of things to look at before you even swing the club:

Ensure that on the left hand (top hand for the RH golfer) you can see 2 knuckles.

Ensure that the pad of the right thumb (bottom hand for the RH golfer) rests on top of the left thumb.

This should allow both hands to feel as though they are working as one unit.

# SETUP/STANCE

Start with your feet at shoulder width apart Make sure the knees have a little flex Bend from waist

Don't get too technical here - everyone's setups going to be a little different. A good setup will allowthe golfer to feel like his or her arms are just hanging while they address the golf ball. Once you've got your hands on the club correctly and your setup feels good, start taking some half swings with a 9 iron. Spend 15 -20 minutes hitting balls without the club going past waist height. Ensure you're striking the ball first, and then brushing the grass. If you've accomplished this, then spend 15-20 minutes swinging the club  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the way back and thru. Ensure that, once again, you're making solid contact and keeping your balance. If you're feeling confident after this step, start the process over with a longer club.

> This practice session is a great way to get you back into the swing of things and start your season off right!

I'd suggest doing this process with a short iron, a mid iron, and then a fairway wood.


Over the years in this article we have discussed specific clubs. Today we are just going to talk about the importance of clubs in general. Your golf clubs are accessories much like your golf shoes, hats or even socks. The thought of the club in the swing should be equal to the thought of your shoes as you walk. Have you even seen the internet videos of dogs trying to walk with little shoes on? Thinking of how to use the club looks equally as awkward during the swing. What I find is that most people are trying to "use" the club and make it their primary thought during the swing. Can you imagine if your first thought in the swing was how to wear your shirt? This mode of thinking makes you too mechanical in your swing. Basically you are living in the wrong area of your brain. Over the ball your primary thought should be the target. The clubs'

main purpose is to follow your body and swing when your body stops at the target. The body releases the arms and club. It's also probably why you wondered why Touring Professionals make the swing look effortless. Do yourself a favor, take a look at a slow motion video of your favorite tour star and pay attention to how much movement there is in their body after impact. Then video your swing and do the same. I bet you will find all the answers you are looking for. If that doesn't get it, go to

your favorite teaching pro.

They will get you on track.














# HOW TO CREATE SPIN WITH YOUR CHIPS & PITCHES AROUND THE GREEN

You just short sided yourself and are looking at a chip or pitch that requires some touch. Your options are limited though because there is little green to work with. You could try to pull off the incredible and open your clubface, take a full hack, and try to pop the ball up but that is a risky endeavor. Instead I suggest trying to hit a lower checking shot and take the gamble out of trying to slide the club under the ball just right with a flop or lob shot.

First, you need to select the proper club. Lofted clubs are much easier when trying to create backspin on chips. Using the correct wedge with the proper amount of bounce is essential in mastering this shot because while you are striking the ball with a descending blow you do not want the leading edge to dig into the turf or contact the ball above its equator.

Next you need to have a good setup and address position. You want to have a narrow stance and a slightly open setup with most of your weight being on your lead leg. The ball should be positioned somewhere from the middle to the back of your stance. Keeping your weight forward on your lead leg and the ball slightly back of center will ensure a descending strike which is critical for this shot. Take note that we are not trying to take a divot with this shot we are trying to brush the ground. I have found that a shallower/flatter swing allows more room for error and also stops the "digging" action we are trying to avoid. Try to keep the club low to the ground during your backswing and follow through. This will create that brushing stroke we are looking for.

The most important aspect in this shot is to hinge your wrist slightly during your backswing and maintain that hinge throughout your swing. This will keep the clubface still at impact. Keeping the clubface "Quiet" throughout impact allows the ball to ride up the clubface and gets the grooves to slice through the golf ball. I have found that this aspect of the shot is the hardest for amateurs to

comprehend. Most players have the tendency to release the club head which breaks the hinge and creates a "wristy" swing and an inconsistent strike. To combat this I tell people that you want to keep the back of your top hand (Left hand for righties, Right hand for lefties) facing the target during your follow through and the clubface should be pointing towards the sky when you finish. It will feel as if you are pushing your top hand towards the intended target.

The last characteristic of creating spin is speed and tempo. You must maintain the speed of the clubhead throughout impact while also being careful not to release the clubhead and break your hinge. This likens to the same motion as the striking of a match where there is a lot of acceleration and then a sudden stop. Maintaining a good tempo and acceleration throughout impact will directly relate to how much spin you are putting on the ball. Under no circumstances should you try to create more speed by flicking or using your wrist! That will only create inconsistent results.


When I explain all this to most golfers they find it almost impossible to not break their wrist in their follow through. One of the best drills I have to fix this issue is to either take an alignment stick or another club and put it behind the shaft of your wedge having it extend far beyond the end of your grip. It will look as if you have another shaft extending past your grip. Proceed to hit chips while holding the stick behind your grip. If the stroke is done properly then the extended stick will never touch your body. But if you let your wrist break the extended stick will hit you, most likely in your side. The best thing about this drill is that you can actually hit golf balls while doing it so you can get instant feedback and results. Using this drill and learning how to maintain your hinge throughout your swing will keep those wrists "Quiet" and in turn create crisper more consistent shots. Mastering this shot and practicing it with different clubs in your bag will make no pin position unreachable!









In attendance will be representatives from all 23 member clubs. Following the business meeting and lunch, members will head out to the course to hopefully get back into the "swing" of things after a long and cold and windy winter.

One of the most popular events provided to WPGA members are the spring team matches. Member clubs notify the WPGA Team Match Chairperson, by April 20, the names of their 14 lowest handicap players, who will comprise their team roster. To qualify, a team member must have an 18-hole USGA certified handicap index and have posted 20 scores within the previous 24 months.

Matches begin on Tuesday, May 1, and the regular season runs through June 5. This year, twenty-one clubs are fielding teams, including three first timers. We welcome Bayside, Heritage Shores and River Marsh. The teams are divided into four geographic Divisions. Each week, the lowest 8 handicappers from their 14 player team roster will play. The format is four ball match play. Scoring per hole is one (1) gross point and one (1) net point for wins and  $\frac{1}{2}$  point for a tie in gross or net.

At the conclusion of the regular season, Division gross and net winners are declared, based on those with the highest number of points. These winners go on to play in the Championship matches to be held at Heritage Shores in mid-June. The Semi-Finals will have the East Division winners playing against the North, and the West Division winners playing against the South. The Finals will be the winners of the Semi-Finals playing each other for the coveted title of Team Match Champion. Engraved Championship plaques are awarded to the winning gross and net teams.

# **BALANCE INQUIRY**

Did you know that having too much weight in your toes or heels greatly reduces your chances of hitting it solid. Here is an easy way to check your balance. Grab your alignments sticks out of your bag. (If you don't practice with alignment sticks, you are making the game harder on yourself.) Place two parallel to your target line. Make sure you are able to stand on one so that it is under the arches of both of your feet. Try to stabilize your weight onto the alignment stick so that you have equal weight in your toes and heels. Having solid balance at address gives you your best chance to make a great swing!

Now you know the drill!



# What Kids Can Learn from Golf By Rob McDonald

I was very fortunate to have been introduced to golf at a young age. My father would take us to the range as youngsters, but around age ten we began to get on the course. At age twelve, once I passed a Rules and Etiquette test I could play on my own. That's when life's lessons started for me. As a kid, golf can teach us many lessons that can prepare us for later in life.

Golf teaches kids that patience, perseverance and practice pay's off. It seems the only thing that comes quickly in golf are high scores. Getting better takes time. You have to be dealt some hard knocks before you realize something must change. Once you begin that change, you must practice diligently to get better. After Tiger won his first Masters Tournament, he went to Butch Harmon to improve his swing. It took the best player in the game, with one of the top teachers in the game, a year and a half to where Tiger could say "I have it now". I bet Tiger understood very early in the process what Butch wanted him to do. It took a year and a half to engrain it and to own it. In life, the achievements we reach through hard work are more rewarding than honors just handed to us. No participation trophies in life!

In golf, when we practice new mechanics, the bad shots are just as important as the good shots. We begin to feel the difference between the two and can gravitate more to the good swings. In life, we have hurt feelings and losses, but learn to dust ourselves off and move on with more experience to help us out the next time.

Young golfers learn to respect the course, other golfers in front and behind them and the nature around them. You learn to take care of the course by raking bunkers, filling divots and fixing ball marks so that those behind you have a fair lie as well. You learn to keep pace so that those behind you can have a good pace to their game. Many people on our roads could learn from this! You learn to enjoy the natural surroundings and not disturb them. You learn to respect your fellow golfers by keeping quiet while they play their shots and acknowledge their good shots.

You learn that honesty is an important quality. We are our own referees in golf. We call penalties on ourselves and add up all of the shots. We don't argue with the officials or try to hide the penalties as they do in other sports.

A youngster can learn that life is not fair and how to deal with it. You can hit a ball right down the middle of the fairway and it takes a hard bounce left and into the water. Get over it buttercup, move on. Batten down the hatches and proceed the best you can.


You learn humility. No matter how good you are, in this game, on any given day, someone can beat you.

Most importantly, you learn it is all up to you. It's you versus the course. All that matters is that the lowest score wins. Anyone, big, small, male, female, black, white, orange or purple can put up the lowest score. That person can be you if you put the time and effort into getting better.

# GOLF PSYCHOLOGY SHORE UP! WITH THE GAME COACH

It's Tournament Time! Every goal on the first third of this year's game plan has been reached. Confidence is high, hope springs eternal, and we feel ready to compete. The first challenge is to maintain this optimal mindset, and to do so, the research suggests sticking to the basics: Reading, Writing and Arithmetic.

**READING:** Study the game. Stay current with advancements in golf. Besides the acquisition of new and important information, studies have shown that thirty minutes devoted to reading reduces stress by as much as sixty-eight percent, a significant tool in managing emotions. Reading is not limited to the written word. Read the game by watching and learning from the pros. Television and Internet streaming devices give athletes access to nearly every professional golf tournament in the world. See how the best golfers perform under pressure and think of ways to emulate what makes them winners.

**WRITING:** Keep a Journal. Writing allows the athlete to experience outcomes twice: during the performance and in retrospect. Also, writing has been shown to improve memory

by activating the temporal lobe of the brain, increasing focus on the subject matter and maximizing reading comprehension.

ARITHMETIC: Get into The STEM
Zone. Recognizing the critical importance
of Science, Technology, Engineering and
Mathematics (STEM) in the world of sports, The United States
Golf Association has dedicated resources for the creation
of digital and interactive experiences to show how science
and sports collide. Golfers of all ages can gain advantages
with a greater understanding of topics such as Speed,
Aerodynamics, Club Engineering, Friction and Energy,
Bounce and Angles.

Knowledge is power, and a pre-game primer including "The Three R's" may Shore Up the foundation for a Championship Tour.

## Effortless Power: Full swings without over swinging & avoiding casting

Two of the main things that I see with players and fellow golfers is OVER SWINGING and casting the club. Everyone wants more distance, more power and to have everyone in your group go "WOW" after you bomb your tee shot. So what do you do, you swing harder and start to cast. Casting is good for fishing, however is a power drainer in golf. So how do you get power without over swinging? First let's look at the golf swing. The golf swing should be a very simple thing, yet we know it is not. You take the club back for a full swing in a pendulum motion and move it forward on the same path and make contact with the ball. The even more amazing part is the ball is stationary and not moving, sounds simple right? It's not! All the pieces of your body and club have to be in complete harmony and rhythm in order to make solid contact. When you make solid contact the swing transfers all the energy from the club to the golf ball and the power is visualized. Did you know that you can still make solid contact (in the center of the club head) and not have all your power transferred? This is where casting comes in and robs your power even with a solid strike. Did you also know that when most players are swinging 34 swing it is actually a full complete swing? So how can you avoid these two problem areas and increase distance and accuracy? I have 2 drills that can help you and you don't even need to hit a ball to feel the results.



#### Drill#1: Avoiding the cast

First take a long stick (even a driver shaft without the head) under your forward arm. Then extend your rear arm out straight and place it in front of the shaft. Then you will reach your front arm behind the shaft and place it on your rear bicep. You have now created the setup needed to have a straighter more inside out swing. As you take the shaft back you will have to utilize your back, hips and legs to swing instead of forcing the club around with your hands and arms (see pictures below).

Drill#2: Knowing where your club is during the swing Distance control is what makes the professionals exceptional. Through hours of practice, they know exactly what swing will get them the desired distance. It all comes down to feel and knowing where your clubs are located through the swing. One thing that I try to teach my players is to not over swing, swing 34 and you will get the same distance. In reality what young players don't realize until they see it, is that the 3/4 swing they think they are doing is actually a full swing. This drill can help you feel and understand where the club is through the swing.

First take 2 clubs that are about the same length (7 & 8 irons). Choke down to the bottom of the grip on each club. Start both clubs at your address point and slowly move them backwards to start the swing. As you take the clubs back engage the bottom half and complete to a full parallel swing. Once at the top, start the swing down and finish the swing. Repeat for 3/4, ½, and other desired points. Doing this with a coach or fellow player with a phone/video camera can help you see where you are at each point. After swinging this way for 15-20 times, then take one club and perform the same swing and note the distances for each placement.



## YOUR PATH TO

# THE BEST FIRST STEP TO A GREAT GOLFING SEASON IS TO GET OFF THE RIGHT FOOT! TO HELP INSURE THAT YOU DO, CUT DOWN YOUR DRIVING!

If you want to hit more powerful shots you must improve your ability to make a proper transition from backswing, down and through the ball. There are several components to proper transition technique, but the key is getting weight off the trail foot to the lead foot to enable maximum effect of rotational and linear forces through the ball and to the target.

For most recreational players the greatest barrier to a powerful transition move is not technique it's your body. How much time did you spent sitting in a car to get to the course? Were you driving? How many hours each day do you sit in a chair? The act of sitting leads to muscle tightness and imbalances that inhibit your ability to make an effortless and effective transition move in your golf swing. When driving, the sitting position combined with a near constant extension of the right ankle joint to control acceleration and braking reduces flexibility in the hips and right leg. Holding the steering wheel, adds tension in the neck and upper back. The bottom line, driving is hazardous to your golf swing. But it doesn't stop when you get out of the car. You get to the course make a few swings, then hop in the cart and "drive" to the first tee. You will repeat this "driving" from shot to shot at least 36 more times during the round.

Look for opportunities to get out of the cart and walk to your ball, while your partner drives to his next shot. Make your shot and begin walking toward the green, letting the cart catch up to you. This can speed up the pace of play, especially near the greens. When your ball is in the "no cart zones" one player should walk to his next shot, while the other takes the cart to the green. If you are on or just short of the green, drive the cart behind the green and walk back to the ball. You benefit from the walk, from seeing the shot from a different angle, and speed up play by being positioned to leave the green quickly upon completion of the hole.

Stretching exercises and massage should be part of your pre game routine to reduce muscle tension. Ironically, good things can be done seated in the cart. For example, place a lacrosse ball or massage ball under your thigh and gently move your leg to relax the hamstrings; roll a ball on the top of the thigh to relax the quadraceps; extend your leg contract the thigh muscles, flex your toes toward your shin and hold the position to stretch the hamstrings and calve muscles; cross right ankle over left knee and gently push right knee downward to stretch inner thigh muscles. When stretching move slowly and gently until you feel a point of tension then hold the stretch for 20 to 30 seconds. These exercises won't get you in great shape or correct muscle imbalances but they will diminish the adverse effect of driving and sitting.

The Second Round OCGC defeated Glen Riddle Golf Club 11-7.


The Third Round OCGC defeated Prospect Bay10-8.




