KEY I

The golfer must create wrist hinge during the backswing. This typically happens naturally with the correct grip and lite grip pressure. If you struggle with this step make sure you have the grip in your fingers not the palm of your hand and ensure you can feel the weight of the club head.

KEY II

The golfer must pull down with their lead arm (left arm for the right handed golfer). If the lead arm can pull down you will retain some of that wrist hinge you created in the backswing giving you the proper angle of attack.

KEY III

The golfer must maintain their posture until impact. Most golfers address the ball with their club directly behind it laying on the ground. That means they've created some type of spine tilt / knee bend to get it there. If the golfer straightens up the spine or locks up the knees the club cannot return to the back of the ball at impact. It's important to work on keeping the trail shoulder down through impact (right shoulder for the right handed golfer). When you finish the swing try and get your trail shoulder lower than your lead shoulder.

KEY IV

Last but not least the golfer must transfer their weight to the lead leg (left leg for the right handed golfer). This will allow the bottom of the swing to occur in front of the ball, creating the ball first / divot combination that compresses the golf ball. Think about getting the right toe dirty when you finish the swing. This will ensure your weight is transferring to your lead leg.

Brainstorming over coffee Justin came up with the idea of using jeeps as golf carts and Jeep golf was born at that moment! The idea was to create nine holes of golf in a family friendly environment where jeeps are driven on the course instead of traditional golf carts.

"MASTERING BUNKERS"

Having trouble getting out of tricky green side bunkers? Maybe you don't have the right tool for the job. I carry 4 wedges in my bag and each does a specific job much like a tool box. I have a pitching, gap, 56 degree and 60 degree wedges. For bunkers I mainly use the 56 and 60 degree wedges. Each has a different degree of bounce. The sand dictates which wedge I will use. If there is a lot of sand in the bunker I will choose the 56 degree with 12 degrees of bounce and if it is thin or firm sand I will use the 60 degree sand wedge with 6 degree of bounce. Rule of thumb; little sand, little bounce, lotta sand lotta bounce. Now that you have chosen your weapon you need proper technique. Follow these simple fundamentals and sand will be a breeze. Widen your stance and "sit" down. This means you should set your knees like you are bow legged. Lower you hands at set up and place at least 60% of your weight on the front foot, then use your wedge like a mirror. Open the face of the wedge so you can look into it at address, you should also be able to look at the face of the club through the back swing and down swing. I am not suggesting that you watch the club as you swing, but when you practice check that the club



HIGH SCHOOL GOLF

By William Knopf, Head Coach Washington High School

May the Course Be With YOU. See the line, be the line! Putting with ice in your veins!

There are not many things in the world that can scare more players than a 6 foot putt that is a must make! You look at the line, see the slope, see the break, and take grip of the flat stick. Then you get yourself over the putt and every thought imaginable starts racing through your mind on 4x FF. Usually the last thought however is something negative; the putter head goes back and then boom, you miss the putt. We watch it happen all the time to the pros on TV and think "how did they miss that putt?" So how can you change this to make a "must make putt" easier and just another shot? Well here are some hints and tips that can help you conquer and make more putts. Before I begin, I want to share with you that since I have been playing (35 plus years) I have only owned 3 putters. The first putter came with my Ping knock off set, the second was the Calloway Tuttle (still own it), and my current putter for the last 20 years has been my good old Odyssey Dual Force Rossie I (1994).

HERE IS MY PRE-SHOT ROUTINE:

1 Mark my ball and CLEAN it.

You would be surprised how many players putt a ball with dirt, mud, crud or other stuff still on the ball. That extra weight makes a difference and will cause the ball to go off line.

2 Observe and read the putt.

When I look at putts, I try to see the line and visualize how the ball will travel. There are times I can see the line like a road leading to the hole. I examine the side slope of the green, whether it is uphill or downhill and even the grain of the grass. Once I have done this I pick my line.

3 Picking your line, aim small miss small!

When I am looking or picking my line, I prefer to gauge how many inches out the ball is from the hole. For example if I see the line moving from right to left (my favorite) I will aim a half inch to inch outside the right edge.

4 Address the ball.

When I address the ball I hold the putter in my right hand, center my body with the putter, adjust my right sleeve up to relieve any pressure, say the line to myself in my head, attach my left arm, repeat the line to myself, look at the putter head for my alignment, repeat the line again to myself and finally beginning my putting stroke.

Finally what I feel is important but not part of my routine (directly)

5 Hear the putt hit the bottom of the cup.

Putting everything out and hearing that sound as it drops, builds a very pleasing sound to my ears.

One more thing that I will said is that my routine is solely mine and works for me. You will need to find yours and make it work for you to conquer those must have putts!

Until next time May the Course Be With YOU!

The only and major reason I still have it is because I putt great with it! For a round of 18 holes, I average 1.67-1.8 putts per hole (30-32 per 18). That might not sound good, however the PGA average is 1.61 or 29.1 putts per round. My players past and present will tell you that I can beat them all day long with my putter! So how do I do it? Perhaps my pre-putting routine can help you too.

A pre-shot routine is essential to getting your mind and body to fall in line with each other. All athletes (no matter the sport) have some sort of pre-shot routine and the reason is that is take the nerves and stress out of the shot and focuses the mind/body on the shot itself.



Routine Matters By Rob McDonald


Recently some research was published on touring professional's pre-shot routines and how it affected their performance. Essentially, it was found that spending less time over a shot and having the routines be consistent in amount of time spent helped their performance.

Having a routine can help any player have better performance on the course. If you don't have one, the sooner you begin creating one, the sooner it will help your scores.

Remember, one of the key points above was that a shorter routine is more effective. It doesn't have to slow down your round of golf, it can actually help to quicken the pace of the round.

The main purpose of the routine is to allow clarity of mind during the swing. It helps keep the many distractions that come with the game out of your head. Each step is checking a box on the checklist like a pilot preparing for take-off. Step one, from behind the ball visualize the flight of the shot (check). Step two, lead hand on the grip (check). Step three, trail hand on the grip (check). Step four, feet settled into alignment (check). Step five, Balance and athletic posture acquired (check). Step five, check lead shoulder alignment and target awareness (check). And ... TAKE OFF. This whole process from visualization to trigger pull can take just twelve to thirteen seconds. Once you've checked each box the same way every time, your mind is now free to feel the rhythm and flow of your swing and not have questions in your head about your grip not feeling right or set-up is off or any other distraction like a pressure shot you need to make.


I don't believe in muscle memory in a way that you don't have to have any swing thoughts, it's just automatic. You have to have some awareness of your motion. But, having a routine that is the same sequence every time and the amount of time every time will help you to get as close to auto pilot as possible. Go through your routine, two turns. Go through your routine, two turns. Do that every time and every shot will be the same, pressure doesn't have a way to get into your head.

YOUR PATH TO PAR

RICHARD ROBINSON INSTRUCTOR THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL

THE GREATEST GOLFERS THROUGHOUT THE HISTORY OF THE GAME HAVE ALL COME TO THE SAME CROSSROAD IN THE GOLF SWING. THEY APPROACHED THE DESTINATION WITH A DIVERSITY OF STYLES. YET, ALL HAVE COME TO THE SAME CONCLUSION AND TAKEN THE SAME PATH.

There have been great champions whose grip style were strong or neutral, interlocking, overlapping, ten fingers, or versions of the Vardon, Sarazen, and Alex Morrison hand placements. Champions played from square, open, closed, wide and narrow stances. One plane.two plane, looping arms outside to inside, and even slightly over the top (Sam Snead, Bob Jones), rim swing, straight-edge, square to square. The nuanced details seem endless. Yet, those at the apex of the game, chose the same destination at the apex of their swings.

The position of the trailing arm is the keystone of the backswing and all that follows. Like the builders cap stone, it creates and preserves the arc of the swing. It anchors the plane, path, and sequence of the downswing. It is the fulcrum to enhance leverage and the transmission of conversion of angular momentum the power producer of the swing. It helps define your personal optimal backswing position. The best aspect of this underrated key is that it is simple and requires limited kinesthetic talent to perform.

Keeping the trailing arm and elbow close to the body was a proven technique in the hickory shaft era. It helped control the flex and torque variability of the wooden shaft. The development of more consistent steel shafts changed the need for such control. Byron Nelson developed the technique and advised others to "let the right elbow swing free." When Jack Nicklaus began his march through history he was initially criticized for his "flying right elbow" that accompanied his wide arc upright swing. In part this was because his style was visually a departure from the flat compact classic swing of Ben Hogan. Yet, at the "crossroad" Nelson, Hogan and Nicklaus all followed the same path to solid impact.

The goal is to have the right elbow pointing to the ground and the right forearm aligned at least on the same plane as your spine angle. If the right forearm is more vertical than the spine angle it's even better. The elbow "forward" position is analogous to a quarterback or pitcher throwing motion. It creates better leverage.

One way to develop this position is to stop your backswing at a point where you can fully extend your left arm and connect your left and right hand. This may reveal an optimal position less than a full swing. Now, try to bring your right elbow as close as possible to the left and pointed to the ground. If this is uncomfortable or creates excess tension, keep practicing. You will develop the flexibility to achieve the keystone position. Be patient do not expect instant results. It is simple, but it can take time to become fluid and comfortable.

When you can swing to the keystone position, you merely have to initiate the down swing by bringing the right elbow down to just in front of the right hip. For many people, this action unlocks proper downswing technique. Ward Richards, a member at Bear Trap Dunes, made this his key and became Club Champion soon after.

YOU KNOW THE DRILL BY STEVE MENZ MASTERING BUNKERS



Having trouble getting out of tricky green side bunkers? Maybe you don't have the right tool for the job. I carry 4 wedges in my bag and each does a specific job much like a tool box. I have a pitching, gap, 56 degree and 60 degree wedges. For bunkers I mainly use the 56 and 60 degree wedges. Each has a different degree of bounce. The sand dictates which wedge I will use. If there is a lot of sand in the bunker I will choose the 56 degree with 12 degrees of bounce and if it is thin or firm sand I will use the 60 degree sand wedge with 6 degree of bounce. Rule of thumb; little sand, little bounce, lotta sand lotta bounce. Now that you have chosen your weapon you need proper technique. Follow these simple fundamentals and sand will be a breeze. Widen your stance and "sit" down. This means you should set your knees like you are bow legged. Lower you hands at set up and place at least 60% of your weight on the front foot, then use your wedge like a mirror. Open the face of the wedge so you can look into it at address, you should also be able to look at the face of the club through the back swing and down swing. I am not suggesting that you watch the club as you swing, but when you practice check that the club face is facing you throughout the entire swing. Follow these guidelines and you bunkers will become a day at the beach.






