
# TOOLS OF THE TRADE



# "HIT IT WITH YOUR," PRACTICE SWING"

To hit it or to swing, that is the question. Each day on the course or the range I see the most beautiful practice swings only to be followed by a violent thrashing of the club when a player attempts a shot. What changed? Players take these smooth, flowing practice swings attempting to brush the grass before they take aim at their target. Then when they get over the ball the next swing resembles the sledgehammer game at the local carnival. It's the addition of the ball, that is what changed. The addition of the ball to the swing interrupts our swing. It is the equivalent of driving from Atlanta to Los Angeles but making a quick stop in Chicago. The golf ball should "get in the way" of the swing. This phrase means that the flow of the swing shouldn't change when there is a ball in front of you. A simple trick to get this feeling is to swing the club with your eyes closed when you are practicing. Notice how smooth the feel is through the contact area. If it isn't smooth, then there is a good chance you're hitting and not swinging. Another way to tell when you are interrupting your swing by griping and hitting is to hit golf balls with your mouth open. When your mouth is open your jaw relaxes, your shoulders and forearms can become more relaxed and the swing can flow freely. Pay attention to when you may feel your mouth close during the swing. That is when you are adding hand force which will add to your chances of inconsistency. I have put many of my students on a launch monitor and challenged them to swing relaxed then swing as hard as they can. The club head speed difference is nominal, in many cases the relaxed swing is faster. The smoother you swing, the better contact you make and the better the outcome. As Ty Webb said in Caddyshack, "the quickest way from point A to point B isn't always a straight line and a doughnut without holes is a danish". Swing easy my friends.

# YOUR PATH TO

# 'DO YOU HIT IT BETTER ON THE RANGE THAN ON THE COURSE?''

Do you hit it better on the range than on the course? Do you hit it fat, top it, swing with a "chicken wing", pull it. slice it, push right. Can't get to the target with all your might. There are numerous reasons for our golfing travails, but the very beginning is where we often fail.

Limiting the scope of examples to only major champions over the last 100 years reveals widely diverse technical and strategic approaches. Even among champions static position fundamentals such as grip and stance are so varied, that it is easy to be confused and easy to debate contradictions to conventional wisdom. Yet, one ability, one fundamental concept, shared by all good golfers is the ability to define and discern the target. This seems so simple and obvious, how can we misunderstand it? Yet, we do. Even good players sometimes get careless with targeting, and despite flawless technique, end up in trouble.

Targeting begins by defining a straight line from the ball to the target. Visualizing an "intermediate target" a few feet in front of the ball helps define a more precise ball target line. The club face is aligned perpendicular to the ball target line. Now just set up to the club and swing the club head through the ball to the target. So simple. The challenge is in the concept of setting up to the true target.

Many players mistakenly think the lead shoulder should be aligned to the target. If fact, it should aim left of the target for a right handed player. To use a baseball analogy for a right handed swing: if you want to hit to center field the shoulders align to shortstop. If you mistakenly align you shoulders to centerfield, and make a perfect swing your ball will go over the second basemans head. The lead shoulder will naturally align to a slightly "open" and elevated position because the lead hand is higher on the club than the trail hand. If you try to "square" the shoulders parallel to the target line, or mistakenly align the lead shoulder to the target, you will be fighting your anatomy as your body tries to maintain balance and natural mechanics during the swing motion.

This is further complicated by your metal image of the target and intention to swing to it. If your shoulders align to center field and you try to swing to center field the inevitable consequence is to come "over the top", create and outside in swing path, and disrupt the natural weight transition needed for a consistent and powerful swing. All sorts of problems result.

One simple way to "target" without the geometry is to make a practice swing a few yards behind the ball. Setting up so your actual ball becomes the "intermediate target" for the practice swing. As you complete the practice swing, your chest should face your ultimate target. If it doesn't reposition until you can swing and finish to the target. Now move up to the ball and make your shot. When you address the ball your arms naturally form a triangle. Focus on swinging the arm triangle along the ball target line and finishing facing the target. Your ability to define the target line and swing to the target is essential to consistently accurate shots.

# "MID PITCHES CONNECTION DRILL"

Having troubles mastering that half wedge shot? You know, that tricky 30-70 yard tester that can turn easy birdie into easy bogey? Yeah that one! Here is how to become deadly with that shot. Just get connected. Get a longer bath towel and trap it under each of your armpits. Line yourself up and let the chest rotation move your arms through the shot and don't let the towel drop. This will get you connected and erase those miss hits. It will eliminate your arms separating from your torso and chopping at the ball. You will cover the shot with your chest and hit crispy little spinners at your target.

Now you know the drill!

## UMES UPDATE!


Nearly 100 years ago, the United States Golf Association (USGA) hosted its first major championship at Pebble Beach Golf Links - The 1929 United States Amateur. The course gained attention more recently when it became the first public golf course to host a US Open in 1972. The USGA has now returned the US Open to the most idyllic setting in golf six times-1972, 1982, 1992, 2000, 2010, and 2019.

#### Widen Your Gaps


I've often said that distance is the fringe benefit of proper technique. It's the by-product of several factors in the swing. First and foremost, solid contact is the most important factor for distance. If you do not have the clubface striking the back of the ball squarely, you have some sort of a glancing blow. If you're swinging hard in an effort to get more speed, it is unlikely you'll hit it solidly, thereby wasting your effort.

To create speed more efficiently we need to maximize the size of our swing wheel. Think of the hub of a wheel turning at a certain speed to make it's one revolution. The outside of the wheel is going faster to make the same revolution. A bigger wheel is naturally going faster on the outside. To do this in our swing, we need to maximize our gaps or create width in the swing with our bodies.

When we begin our swing by turning the upper body away, above a stable lower body, you create a gap between your left shoulder and left hip (for right-handed golfers). Your body is in a twisted position. We also need

to maintain arm extension, holding the handle as far away as possible. To maximize this width in the forward swing, we then separate the hip away from the shoulder maximizing the gap created in the back swing. Doing this while maintaining arms extension helps created the bigger swing wheel that equals more distance. At impact, you should feel your left hip twisted away from your left shoulder and your arms fully extended, holding the handle stretched to maximum width of the arms.

If you try to apply more force using your upper body as you make your forward swing, you end up closing the gaps. While it may feel powerful because you're using energy to do it, you are actually decreasing the swing wheel size. That means more effort for less speed! Maximizing your width takes less energy to deliver more speed. Try focusing on separating your hip from your shoulder to start the forward swing instead of trying to make your arms go faster. Your arms will respond to faster hips, but your hips won't respond to faster arms. They're just in the way.




