Eligibility:

This tournament is open to male amateur golfers.

Competition:

54 hole stroke play event. The format will feature the following divisions:

- OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISION
- **SENIOR DIVISION** (must have reached 55th birthday by June 15)
- SUPER SENIOR DIVISION (must have reached 65th birthday by June 15)
- JUNIOR DIVISION (under 18)

The Regular Division will compete from the Blue Tees, the Senior Division will compete from the White Tees and the Super Senior Division will compete from the Gold Tees. The Senior and Super Senior Divisions will not be permitted to compete for the overall Championship Title.

The Overall Championship Division, Senior Division and Junior Division will be flighted based upon their handicap index and will be played as gross score flights. The Super Senior Division will be a GROSS and NET Scoring Division. Handicaps must be verified by their club pro.

Owning It!


A few years back, I was talking with a former major league baseball pitcher about how he trained to learn a new pitch. I was curious because the sequencing of the throwing of a pitch is very similar to the golf swing. He would train by having the catcher stand a short distance from him as he slowly went through the sequencing of motion that would give him the spin on the ball that was required for the success of the pitch. As he got better at sequencing, the catcher would move farther away. They would continue this process until they reach the sixty-foot distance of the mound from home plate. Then, he would begin to build speed. This process could take months before he was ready to use the pitch in the game. It takes discipline and patience to work in slow motion at short distances, but this is the way to improve faster, even for golfers. By going in slow motion and not worrying about distance, your mind becomes more aware of the motion you are trying to make. This is training speed. Tour pros don't hit good shot after good shot because of some secret or luck. They do it because they are very aware of how they are sequencing their body motion. They are very

aware because they have trained their minds and body in

slow motion to be aware. Some of the top teachers in the game, working with touring professionals, may have the pro hit only 5-10 balls in an hour. The rest is slow motion training.

A simple thought for the golf swing is that we are using our body, to swing our arms, while they're holding a club. The club moves only because our body, not hands, moves it. We have many shots facing us that require a softer, slower, but still free motion. Many people have difficulty in shorter, partial swing shots because they're trying to slow down the arms and still "hit" the ball. If you have your body swinging your arms, you can dictate you body to swing the arms at whatever speed is require. Whether it's a full swing shot or anything less that full swing. You own it when you can do it slowly and still have a free arms swing through the bottom. So, rather than being bored with soft, easy shots and trying to bang them as far as possible, work to own it by working short to longer. If you can't do it slowly, you don't own it yet. The good news is, you'll end up gaining distance with accuracy and develop a great short game along the way.

HELLO SPRING! WE'RE READY TO PLAY!

The 2019 season officially begins with the Spring General Meeting on Tuesday, April 23, at Green Hill Country Club in Quantico, MD. Representatives from all 23 member clubs attend. Following the business meeting and lunch, the reps head out to the course to hone their skills for the upcoming WPGA team matches and tournaments.

One of the most popular events sponsored by the WPGA are the spring team matches. Member clubs notify the WPGA Team Match Chairperson, by April 15, the names of their 16 lowest handicap players, who will comprise their team roster. To qualify, a team member must have an 18-hole USGA certified handicap index.

Matches begin on Tuesday, May 7, and the regular season runs through June 4. This year, twenty-one teams are competing. They are divided into four geographic Divisions. Each week, the lowest 8 handicappers from their 16 player team roster will play. The format is four ball match play. Scoring per hole is one (1) gross point and one (1) net point for wins and ½ point for a tie in both gross and net.

At the conclusion of the regular season, Division gross and net winners are declared, based on those with the highest number of points. These winners go on to play in the Championship matches to be held in mid-June. The Semi-Finals will be held at Mulligan's Pointe with the East Division winners playing against the West, and the North Division winners playing against the South. The Finals will be held





BALL AT REST

Ball Moved During Search

No penalty for accidentally moving your ball during search.

No Penalty for Moving Ball on the Putting Green

No penalty for accidentally moving your ball or ball-marker on the putting green. Standard for Deciding Why a Ball Moved New standard to determine if you caused your ball to move.

Replacing Ball When Original Spot is Not Known

When the original location of your ball is not known, replace it on its estimated spot.

BALL IN MOTION

Ball in Motion Accidentally Deflected No penalty if your ball in motion is accidentally deflected by you, your equipment, or your caddie.

TAKING RELIEF

Measuring the Size of the Relief Area Where a Ball Must Be Dropped and Played

Your relief area for dropping a ball is a fixed size of either one or two clublengths using the longest club in your bag, other than your putter.

New Procedure for Dropping a Ball

Your ball must be let go from knee height and fall through the air without touching any part of your body or equipment.

Where a Dropped Ball Must Come to Rest

Your ball must come to rest in the relief area where it was dropped, or else it must be redropped.

Fixed Distances to be Used for Measuring A fixed distance of the longest club in your bag, other than your putter, is used for measuring.

Time For Search Before Ball is Lost

Your ball is lost if not found in three minutes (rather than the previous five minutes).

<u>Substitution of Ball Always Allowed</u> <u>When Taking Relief</u>

You may always substitute a ball when taking relief.

Relief For an Embedded Ball

Relief allowed without penalty for an embedded ball anywhere (except in sand) in the "general area" (a new term for "through the green").

Procedure for Taking Lateral Relief

In taking lateral relief, drop within two club-lengths of where your ball entered the penalty area. The size of a club-length is always measured using the longest club in your bag, other than your putter. Procedure for Taking Back-on-the-Line Relief

One of your options for relief from either a red or yellow penalty area is called back-on-the-line relief.

AREAS OF THE COURSE

When to Replace a Ball That Moves on the Putting Green

After your ball has been lifted and replaced, if it then moves, always replace it on its original spot even if it was blown by the wind or moved for no clear reason. Repairing Damage on the Putting Green Repair of almost any damage is allowed on the putting green (including spike

marks and animal damage).

Touching Line of Play on a Putting Green No penalty for touching your line of play on the putting green so long as doing so does not improve the conditions for your stroke.

Ball Played From Green Hits Unattended Flagstick in Hole

No penalty if your ball played from the putting green (or anywhere else) hits the unattended flagstick in the hole.

Areas the Committee May Mark as Penalty Areas

Areas of desert, jungle, lava rock, etc. (in addition to areas of water) may now be marked as red or yellow "penalty areas." Touching Loose Impediments or Ground

in a Penalty Area

No penalty for moving loose impediments, touching the ground, or grounding your club in a penalty area.

Expanded Use of Red-Marked Penalty Areas

Committees have the discretion to mark any penalty area as red so that lateral relief is always allowed.

Elimination of Opposite Side Relief for Red Penalty Areas

Relief from a red penalty area no longer allowed on the opposite side from where the ball last entered the penalty area.

Moving or Touching Loose Impediments or Touching Sand in a Bunker

Relaxed Rules relating to loose impediments and touching the ground in a bunker.

Unplayable Ball in Bunker

Relief allowed outside a bunker for an unplayable ball for two penalty strokes.

EQUIPMENT

<u>Use of Clubs Damaged During Round</u> A club damaged during a round can continue to be used, even if you damaged it in anger.

Adding Clubs to Replace a Club Damaged During Round

You are not allowed to replace a damaged club during a round if you were responsible for the damage.

Use of Distance-Measuring Devices

The use of DMDs is allowed unless a Local Rule has been adopted prohibiting their use.

PLAYING A BALL

Caddie Standing Behind a Player to Help Line the Player Up

A caddie is not allowed to stand on a line behind you while you are taking your stance and until your stroke is made.

Caddie Lifting Ball on the Putting Green

Your caddie may lift and replace your ball on the putting green without your specific authorization to do so.

WHEN TO PLAY DURING A ROUND

Encouraging Prompt Pace of Play

It is recommended that you play "ready golf" and make each stroke in no more than 40 seconds.

Maximum Score Form of Stroke Play

A new "Maximum Score" form of stroke play is recognized, where your score for a hole is capped at a max score.

PLAYER BEHAVIOR

Expected Standards of Player Conduct

The Rules speak directly to the high standards of conduct expected from players.

Code of Player Conduct

Committees are given authority to adopt their own code of player conduct and to set penalties for breaches of that code.

Elimination of the Requirement to Announce the Player's Intent to Lift a Ball

When you have good reason to mark and lift your ball, you are no longer required to first announce your intention.

Reasonable Judgment in Estimating and Measuring

A player's reasonable judgment will not be second-guessed based on later evidence.

NEW LOCAL RULE

Local Rule: Alternative to Stroke and Distance

A new Local Rule provides an alternative to stroke-and-distance relief for a ball that is lost outside a penalty area or out of bounds.

"DO YOU PLAY GOLF OR WORK FOR IT?"

Most golfers do both, working to improve understanding and technique and playing to test our skills. Scoring is typically the measure of success. But, it is not the only measure.

WALKING SCORERS who follow tour players during a round, recording and reporting hole by hole results, are typically instructed not to speak to players unless asked a direct question. There are several reasons for this instruction. A key one is that many players do not want to know the score, or at least be reminded of it. The player records a score of one of his playing competitors on each hole, not his own, then moves on. Score keeping is often delegated to the caddie. The players intent is to focus on each shot with minimal distraction. In other word focus on playing the shots not counting them.

In the days of mashies and niblicks a low lofted wooden club, today known as the driver, was called the **'PLAY CLUB'**. It's purpose to put the ball in play on each hole. When clubs transitioned from cherished partners known by names to become mere numbers, the putter and wedges avoided numbering, and the number 1 wood became the "driver". Ironically, these named clubs are still the keys to good numbers on the scorecard.

It is most useful to reconsider the **'DRIVER'** as the **'PLAYCLUB'**. It's purpose to put the ball in play with a chance to reach the green in regulation. The putter and wedges can save you strokes. The driver is the most wasteful. Yet, redefining its purpose as the "playclub" is a score reducer and enjoyment enhancer.

MAKING A BETTER 'PLAYCLUB'. Know that a stiffer shaft reduces the feel for the club head and tends to quicken the tempo of a swing. Higher lofts tend to increase both accuracy and distance for the average player. A common swing flaw is flipping the wrists and getting the club head to the ball before the hands. The consequences: increased effective loft at impact, reduced leverage and swing speed, weak, high, erratic shots. If you play a 9.5 or 10.5 stiff, you would likely improve with an 11.5 or 12.5 regular. The are multiple reasons why this is so. One of the most important is that it can encourage better technique. You may find yourself reducing the urge to flip the ball in the air, catching it on the up swing. A more level impact position, and working to have you hands pass the ball slightly before the club head does, will improve leverage and effective loft at impact, thus greater distance and accuracy.

Consider playing a **'PERSONAL SCRAMBLE ROUND'**. Play your tee shot as if playing in a scramble event, where you know an errant shot doesn't matter, since your partners can keep the team in play. If you do hit a poor shot, pick it up and move it to the center of the fairway and play from there. This will accomplish two goals. It will reduce your expectation of "needing" to strive for the perfect tee shot and give you a sense of how being in play effects your enjoyment of the game. The irony is that most people tend to hit better shots in the "scramble" format because the expectation is to make your best effort without concern for the consequence of error. As a result, fewer errant tee shots than normal. Score how many fairways you hit. This attitude is as important as technique and equipment.

PUT THE BALL IN PLAY AND ENJOY THE DAY!







"WANT CONSISTENCY?" THE FRISBEE VS. THE TOP

Are you willing to do what it takes? As an instructor I normally ask new clients what they are looking to achieve by taking lessons. The vast majority claim they are looking to be more consistent in their ball striking. My follow up question is, "Are you willing to do what it takes?" This is why most golfers struggle to obtain consistency and I will break it down using simple toys that perfectly describe the common flaws in the swing. If you can imagine the arc of a golf swing, pretend it's circular path is either a frisbee or a top. With a frisbee you apply pressure to the outside of the circle, with a top you apply pressure to the inside to get them to function. The troubles I normally see are people applying pressure in their golf swing to the outside of the arc with the hands and arms making the club face erratic and the ball flight inconsistent. The best players in the world treat their golf swings like a top turning around their spine and applying the pressure to the inside of the arc. This allows the club face to remain constant through the


