Let Your Kid Out



I was very fortunate to begin playing golf as a kid. Around age eight my dad would take me to the driving range or out for nine holes in the evening at the club where we belonged. At age ten I got more invitations and at age twelve, after passing a Rules and Etiquette quiz, I could play on my own, without an adult present. Yes, it was a great childhood!

There is a big difference in learning as a kid versus learning this game as an adult. As an adult, what is the worst thing that can happen to you? You take a swing and miss the ball. Golf is a very personal game and missing a ball in front of other people, even your friends is devastating. So what do you do? You shut down the body motion and use just your arms to make sure you hit it. You may actually hit the ball, so you've accomplished that goal, but there will be no consistency or distance. When learning as a kid, all you want to do is whale away on the ball, trying to hit it as hard as you can. If you miss it, so what, you just whale away at it again. I've watched kids with no instruction, naturally step the weight forward and clear their hips in an effort to "kill it"! As you continue playing, eventually you learn some technique that

will help you hit it straighter and with more consistency, but you never lose the freedom of an arm swing that whaling away brings you.

As a teacher of the game, sometimes it can be difficult to get the adult to generate more arm speed by using the legs and the body to swing the arms. They want to "control" the motion to make sure they hit the ball. Sometimes we need to just let the kid come out in us. Step up to the ball and just start whaling away at it. Try to "cream it" over the driving range fence! We can straighten it out later after you get used to the freedom of the motion. To get a feeling for this, take your stance with any club, but no ball. Make a swing and just try to make the "Swish" noise without any thought of striking an object. Then, try to make it louder. You will naturally use your legs and hips to get the louder "Swish" noise. Then place a ball on a tee, set up and just focus on making the loudest "Swish" noise you can. The ball may go off in a few wayward directions but let it. The object is to get used to using the lower body to create arm speed. Once you do that, we can work on direction.

YOUR PATH TO

"IS THERE REALLY A PERFECT GOLF SWING?"

IS THERE REALLY A PERFECT GOLF SWING? If you study the mechanics, aesthetics and results of a particular swing it is easy to start a raging debate. In the 70's a survey asked players who had the best swing on tour? Jack Nicklaus was quick to select Lee Trevino as the best, even though Trevino's motions seemed to be a series of perfectly balanced contradictions. Why? "Because he is the same through impact every time," was Nicklaus' response. Trevino would affirm Jack's assessment winning the US Open, British Open, and PGA in head to head duels with Nicklaus. In the current era Jim Furyk, Dustin Johnson, Bubba Watson seem to defy classic technique, yet achieve enormous success. Tiger Woods has gone through 5 major swing style changes seeking perfection.

THE REALITY IS THAT THERE ARE MANY EFFECTIVE TECHNIQUES.

But the secret is harmony of position and motion, that is predetermined by the way you place your hands on the club dictating all the other motions of your unique swing. Golf greatest players evolved swings that accentuated their strengths and diminished error tendencies. Observing a players grip and especially the position at the top of the backswing transition provides insight to the swing motions that must follow.

THE CLASSIC POSITION WITH THE LEAD WRIST FLAT AND INLINE WITH THE FOREARM (Snead, Nicklaus, Tiger, Rory) enhances are and momentum.

The classic swing is smooth, gathering potential power deliberately and unleashing it effortlessly with gradual, but enormous acceleration, as the club shaft and lead arm align just past impact.

THE "SHUT FACED" STYLE WITH THE WRIST "BOWED" OR PALMAR FLEXED POSITION. (Trevino, Dustin Johnson), enables aggressive arm and body motion. A restrained wrist arm motion of "dragging the club head through the ball" thus restricting any premature hand release. It is easier to time. It decreases the effective loft at impact, which may be effective with irons, but is a challenge with the driver and less lofted fairway clubs.


THE "CUPPED" OR DORSIFLEXED LEAD HAND POSITION (Hogan, Couples) enhances lag and leverage but requires a specific combination of wrist movements to and through impact. Done correctly this can provide effortless power and pinpoint accuracy, exaggerated it can be inconsistent even disastrous.


THOUGH ALL GOOD PLAYERS MAY START DOWN FROM DIFFERENT

POSITIONS, they adjust and go through the ball the same way. The hands lead the club head at impact moving toward the target. The club head never passes the hands until after the ball is struck. They hit hard through the ball not at it, optimizing leverage, speed and club face path. The average player "rips it" with a " fast premature release at the ball" often with significant muscular effort, only to diminish the very factors that contribute to a powerful and accurate swing. The tendency to do this is exaggerated in the cooler months of autumn. Weather will reduce the distance the ball flies. Enjoy the cooler season by adjusting club selection not increasing physical effort.

You can choose to copy any style, but you must also perform all the compatible actions to make it effective. You need to develop compatible swing motions that suit your physique. The quest is to find your personal path to par. Perhaps the most valuable aspect of personal instruction is sorting out the thousands of quick fix "secrets" and finding the right combination to unlock the keys to your path to par.

TOOLS OF THE TRADE



"EYE, EYE CAPTAIN"

Use your eyes to "right the ship". It's happened to all of us. Sailing along playing well when out of the blue you start slicing or hooking the ball. Maybe all of the sudden you start topping it or hitting it fat. Your first instinct is to make a quick swing change. Now your mind is focused on mechanics and the round sinks to the bottom of the ocean with the whale dung. Here is a great way to save your round. By simply training your eyes to focus on a specific spot on the golf ball during the address and through the swing can change your impact arc and fix any midround hiccups you may experience. It will also (hopefully) keep your mind on your target and free of swing thoughts. Focusing on a specific dimple on the ball can have a great effect on your swing. Looking at a spot on the inside of the ball (photo 1) will help fix a slice. Looking at a spot on the outside of the ball (photo 2) can fix a hook. Focusing on a spot on the back of the ball (photo 3) will help with those thin or topped shots. Focusing on a spot on the front of the ball (photo 4)can fix the dreaded chunk or fat shot. Keeping your eyes focused on a specific spot on the ball will also help with keeping your head still through the swing and create better ball striking. So keep these things in mind for those mid round quick fixes and you will have smooth sailing.



YOU KNOW THE DRILL

These simple things can turn your green side bunker game on fire. Golf is a game of fundamentals. Speed and weight are pivotal to a good bunker shot. Try to widen your stance when you dig your feet in and "sit" down a little. I normally bow my knees outside my feet to accomplish this. Load some weight on the front foot and leave it there though-out the swing. Now rotate your trunk so that the club is acting like you are striking a match to move the sand out of the bunker. Done properly your ball should come out nice and soft with enough spin to keep it where you want it.

When asked what he's done to regain his championship swagger, Mcllroy credits his most recent successes to an attitude adjustment and a trusted but under-utilized skill-development activity. He still maintains a vigorous physical conditioning routine, but now he's meditating, reading books on Sport Psychology, and practicing an elementary exercise Mental Coaches have long supported as a universal gamechanger for athletes of all ages, across all sports: Juggling.


In addition to the obvious and invaluable benefit – increased hand-eye and overall coordination – studies suggest that juggling increases the brain's gray matter and may prevent Alzheimer's disease, making it an awesome exercise for brain fitness. Juggling also sharpens concentration and focus by engaging problem-solving skills, and it's been called the ultimate stress-reliever because learning to juggle requires tremendous attention to detail – a great avenue to escape worries and hardships on and off the course. Regardless of how long it takes to master juggling, engaging in the exercise tones the body, strengthens the core, maintains/increases range of motion in the shoulders and arms, and burns 280 calories per hour, all while boosting brainpower.

Mcllroy said he's focusing on the little details instead of riding the rollercoaster of emotions that follow a sport where losses come far more frequently than wins. He almost spends more time practicing his mind-set so that he's in the right mental space than the time he dedicates to being on the golf course. By adding juggling to his fitness routine in order to strengthen his mental game, Mcllroy's back in the championship swing of things, and we're all better for it!
