## GOLF TOURNEY PAYS TRIBUTE TO H.B. REW BY BILL STERLING

A full field of 86 golfers, beautiful fall weather, and wonderful memories paying tribute to a revered benefactor were the highlights of the 31st annual H.B. Rew Jr. Golf Tournament held at the Eastern Shore Yacht and Country Club on Oct. 4. The tournament is the largest fundraiser of the year for the Eastern Shore Community College Foundation.

Rew, who passed away in May of this year at the age of 88, was a long-time supporter of Eastern Shore Community College and served on the Foundation Board from 1990 to 2003. An avid golfer, Rew organized the golf tournament in 1988; it was named in his honor, helping to raise funds for student scholarships, the Project Horizons program to benefit at-risk youth, program expansion, and facility improvements at the college.

Winning the first flight of the advance best ball format was the foursome of Bill Chandler, John Morgan, Dave Griffith, and Tom Watkins. Finishing second in the first flight one stroke behind were John Fiege, Glenwood Pruitt, Sinjin Jones, and Matt Parker.

Winning the second flight were Tom Hare, Steve McClaskey, Frank Grande, and Rick Haug. Runners-up in the second flight were Jim James, Terris Kennedy, Margie Byrd, and Paul Hughes. The "Rew" foursome included Rew's son, Benji, who wore his father's familiar plaid hat, Benji's wife, Elise, and Rew's granddaughter, Claire Rew Eder, and grandson-in-law, lan McLean.

Winning the putting contest and the \$200 first prize was Rew's longtime partner in this tournament, Gerald Davis, 86. "H.B. and I played this tournament every year it has been held, so it was special for me to win the putting contest," said Davis, who estimates he has played "thousands of rounds" with Rew, averaging three to four times a week for the past 40 years.

Davis and Rew won the 2018 tournament along with playing partners Vince Piazza and Herb Barnes, all in their 80s, and finished runner-up last year with Rick Matthews substituting for Barnes. "We were putting lights out the year we won it and made 18 birdies that day," said Davis. "Last year, H.B. could only putt, but he helped the team quite a bit. He was quite a character, and I have many great memories with him on and off the golf course."

Davis, who now has a 16 handicap after he and Rew once both played to a six handicap, said he beat his much younger competitors in this year's putting contest with a 75-foot putt that stopped a foot from the hole, six inches better than a putt by scratch golfer and 20-something Sinjin Jones. "I guess it was meant to be," said Davis.

Following the round at the Boathouse Grill, Julie Badger, who worked with Rew at Farmers and Merchants Bank, and George McMath, a lifelong friend of Rew's, paid tribute to a man whom they said had a profound effect on the Eastern Shore of Virginia.

McMath said Rew often stated, "I am who I am.' We are glad he was who he was and for the benefit of the Eastern Shore thankful for his passing this way."

McMath added, "He was a man of the highest values and never met a stranger." McMath noted Rew was the co-founder of the highly successful Seafood Festival sponsored by the chamber of commerce, president and CEO of Farmers and Merchants Bank in Onley, president of the Virginia Association, Worshipful Bankers Master of the Onley Masonic Lodge and District Deputy Grand Master, an active member of Drummondtown Baptist Church, and treasurer for 30 years for the Accomack-Northampton Baptist Association.

Patty Kellam, executive director of the ESCC Foundation, said, "I was thrilled with the turnout of golfers and the huge show of support from our 41 sponsors. It really re-inforced for us the value that our local business community sees in the college, and we are grateful to all who supported the tournament as players, sponsors, prize donors, and contestants for our various raffles."

# HALLOFFAME

## 2019 Inductee SUSAN BOHAKER

- ► In recognition of Susan's teaching and coaching the game of golf in our local community and beyond for a period of close to forty years.
- ▶ Born in Chestertown MD, Susan grew up primarily in Portsmouth, VA where she began playing golf at Elizabeth Manor Golf Course when she was 16 years old. She then pursued her game as a member of the James Madison University Women's Golf Team rom 1976-80.
- ▶ Her primary career has been teaching and coaching at all levels, as Susan has taught at the elementary through college ranks. During the 80's while teaching at Saints Peter and Paul, she was a member of Talbot CC and Harbortowne GC. She then spent six years in Harrisonburg, VA as the women's golf coach at James Madison University during which time she realized her love for working with kids and golf. For 13 summers she spent her summers serving as a coach at the Penn State University Junior Golf Camp as well as numerous camps throughout Virginia and Maryland.
- ▶ Susan returned to Easton in 1996, teaching at the Country School, during which time she joined the Easton Club and is currently a member at Hog Neck Golf Course. Upon retiring from teaching, she began working with kids after school daily, escorting them to local courses and working with them for an hour on the range and practice facilities, then heading out to the course for the second hour. She is also currently the golf and basketball coach for The Country School Middle School with 20 boys and girls on the golf team. They have divided the group into a travel team and a practice squad thus eliminating "cuts" and encouraging everyone to play golf.
- ▶ "The Golf Nanny" has become her title and for the past six years, has not only worke with local kids, but has also served as a caddy for some of her students in US Jr. Kids tournament throughout the East Coast as well as in Scotland. ### SURPRISE!

# When you are hitting the lay-up shot, you're not trying to go for maximum distance, so you take an easier swing. This easier motion allows a better chance for proper sequencing and for your arms to stay in a more relaxed state. Loose arms travel faster than tight arms. Loose arms become extended through the bottom and follow through which equals more speed. Tight arms contract, which means they shorten, slow down and make solid contact less likely. Distance should be a surprise. Right after impact, you'll say to yourself "I got that one!". If you're at the top of your swing thinking "I'm going

Have you ever tried to lay up short of the water or rough, only to hit is so good, it went in any way? If so, you probably thought to yourself, "Gee, I barely swung at that!". When it comes to distance, speed is not the most important factor. Optimal transference of energy from the clubface to the ball is most important. In other words, solid contact! The optimum transferring of energy happens when the center of gravity of the ball is struck by the center of gravity of the clubface. Anything else is a glancing blow. Hitting a home run in baseball is the same thing. If you apply the center of gravity of the bat to the center of gravity to the ball (hitting the sweet spot) the ball carries a long way and it feels easy. Any other contact and you have a grounder or a weaker fly ball. In baseball, the pitcher is trying his best to make it hard for you to have solid contact by curving the ball. In golf, we have an advantage, the ball is resting in one spot. So, if we can set up in a position ready for solid contact and move in a manner that doesn't change our spine angle, knee flex or arm extension, we have a much better chance for solid contact.

The next time you go to the range, try making easy swings with the thought of laying up to a certain position versus just seeing how hard you can hit it. Focus on creating your two turns (upper body away, lower body through) in a smooth manner, "letting" your arms swing. Quiet hands away, quiet hands through. If you're square at address and you don't change that with your hands, you have a better chance for square coming through the ball. In other words, less is more!

to kill it!", you're in trouble. While we're at it, ball contact

THE WINTER SEASON IS A GREAT TIME TO FOCUS ON THE STATIC FOUNDATIONS OF A POWERFUL AND DYNAMIC SWING: GRIP, STANCE, POSTURE, ALIGNMENT. PERHAPS THE LEAST CONSISTENT STATIC FUNDAMENTAL IS STANCE. POSITION NEEDS TO BE VARIABLE TO ADAPT TO THE TERRAIN AND SHOT YET, UNDERSTANDING THE PRINCIPLES OF THE STANCE CAN HELP YOU OPTIMIZE PERSONAL STRENGTH, FLEXIBILITY, BALANCE AND SHOT REQUIREMENTS.

#### "CREATING THE POWER TRIANGLE

THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF STANCE WIDTH IS TO ENABLE BALANCE IN RESPONSE TO BODY ROTATION AND LATERAL SHIFT. WIDER ON FULL SWINGS, NARROWER ON SHORT SHOTS.

If you place your feet together and gradually widen your stance by moving your trail foot only, you will notice how your head, hips, and torso move away from the lead foot. As your feet move "outside" your hips your leas begin to slant or angle toward the center of your body forming a triangular position that will support rotation of the body, lateral weight shift, and arm swing momentum without losing balance. Connect the dots: lead foot, trail foot, belt buckle to form a powerful isosceles triangle with your legs at address

When the feet are directly under the shoulders or narrower, rotation seems easier, but maintaining balance in response to full swing forces and may cause undesirable upper body motions. This challenge is why swinging with feet together is a great drill for balance and tempo. Short, less forceful pitches and chips are played with narrower stances, but, for a powerful full swing, the leg triangle is foundational.

#### **FOOT ALIGNMENT**

The primary purpose of the square, open, or closed stance is to facilitate proper rotation. Anchor the lead foot at set up adjusting stance width and alignment with the trail foot. Moving the trail foot away from the ball target line to a "closed" position enables better backswing rotation and restricts over rotation through impact. Conversely, positioning the trail foot closer to the ball target line restricts backswing rotation but enables easier rotation to the target. Players flexible enough to make a full backswing may prefer the open stance to control the backswing and preview the swing finish. If making a full backswing is a flexibility challenge the closed stance may help.

Be aware that shoulder alignment governs swing path. Recreational players often align the shoulder and feet on the same path and create a square stance that appears 'closed" or "open" but is actually well right or left of the target. To find your best position begin with a properly aligned square stance parallel to the desired ball target line, then move the trail foot so your toes are aligned with the instep of your lead foot. Don't exaggerate an open or closed position.

#### **FOOT FLARE ANGLE**

The primary purpose of foot flare is balance. Begin with your lead foot perpendicular to the ball target line, then pivot your foot 20-30 degrees angled toward the target. Often players "rollover" the lead ankle in response to swing forces and pivot on the heel of the lead foot, finally planting the left foot in a position that points to the target. Eliminate the excess motion and get better balance and ground force production by flaring the left foot to the target before you begin to swing.

The classic trail foot position is perpendicular to the ball target line. However, flaring the trail foot may enable a better backswing without inhibiting the forward swing if the right foot is properly unweighted through impact.

Returning to his hometown, Anthony Ward, a native of Detroit knew he wanted to do something a little different for his final internship. His experience at the Dominion Energy Charity Classic on the Champions Tour, could only help him land his final internship.

After a long hiatus, the PGA Tour finally returned to the Motor City. The Rocket Mortgage Classic replaced the former Buick Open. At the center of the tournament was the historic Detroit Golf Club (DGC), a Donald Ross designed golf course stretching out to a very challenging 7334 yards. Anthony knew this was a perfect fit that allowed him to stay with his family and pursue his dream by working at a facility hosting a PGA Tour event.

Anthony credits Billy Dillon, Director of the PGA Golf Management Program with teaching him the skills to work a PGA Tour Event during his Tournament Operations class he took during his freshman year at the University of Maryland Eastern Shore (UMES). "Learning the soft skills was essential to my ability to handle the large volume of guests that visited Detroit Golf Club during the Tour event" said Anthony.

Anthony was given access inside the ropes to learn from the best PGA Tour players. He was able to talk to PGA Superstar, Harold Varner, Ill to experience what professional golfers do on a weekly basis to prepare for each tournament. Ward calls his experience working the Rocket Mortgage Classic "life changing". After graduating UMES, he sees himself in a position helping youth golfers learn the game of golf at a Golf Digest Top-100 facility. Rocket Mortgage Classic will return to Detroit Golf Club May 28-31st, 2020 with Nate Lashley defending his title.








#### "THE ART OF CHIPPING -BERMUDA IN THE FALL"

The eastern shore is a great place to live. The golf courses offer many varieties of grasses that offer different playing challenges. In this issue we are going to tackle Bermuda grass. Bermuda is a wirey grass that can give you many different lies. Sometimes the ball can be sitting up like a snow cone, sometimes it can be sitting so far down you are to stand directly over top of it to see it. The grass is especially challenging later in the season when the grass thins and the ball tends to fall to the bottom. The wirey nature of the grass can also grab the club head in a chip causing you to chunk of duff the shot. There are two go to shots when chipping out of bermuda grass and they are the opposite of how you may normally approach a chip shot. The first option is to play it like a bunker shot where you will open the club face, move the ball up slightly in the stance and hit behind the ball an inch or two that pops the ball up nice and high and lands it softly with very little roll. They keys to this shot are keeping the weight on your lead foot and "not" hitting the ball like in a bunker. The second option is to move the ball back in the stance toward your back big toe. Then slightly "hood" the club. You will also want to Mack the club a little more upright at address so that you can use it more like a putter making sure the toe will be the first point of contact and that the heel of the club is slightly higher than the toe. This shot will have much more run out. Getting the heel higher than the toe will help to let the club not get grabbed through the shot and eliminates flubs or dubs. Normally it's the heel of the club that snags in the grass. So there are two great options to help you manage the short game. Bermuda can be lovely in the fall.









#### YOU KNOW THE DRILL



#### "THIN IS NOT IN"

Here is a great tip if you find yourself continually thinning your iron shots. Simply place a couple tees in front of your ball. Place one an inch in front of the ball and a second two inches in front of the ball. Stick them in the ground low enough so the tee heads are about 1/4" above the ground level. Then swing away. If you are not clipping the tees, there is a good chance you are hitting it thin (which is usually caused by poor weight transfer). Focus on hitting the tees – you'll hit it pure. It will show that your club continued down through contact with enough spin to keep it where you want it. Optimal!
