...is a 16 year old Senior who attends Mardela High School in Mardela Maryland and will graduate, a year early, in May of this year. He began his athletic career, at the age of 7, playing ice hockey for the Delaware Stars and later, Delaware Prep. At the age of 14, he was introduced to the game of golf. He quickly developed a passion for golf at which time he decided to stop playing hockey to focus solely on golf.

While working on his game, he noticed the advertisement for the Under Armour Junior Tour on The Shore on Facebook. Initially apprehensive about joining the tour, due to his limited experience, he made the decision to join to gain experience and meet other local players. That decision, to ioin the Under Armour Junior Tour on the Shore, changed his life.

Immediately upon arrival for his first match, he was approached by Ray Taranto and his staff. Their positive attitude and friendly demeanor immediately put him at ease. The staff ensured he was paired with other players of comparable skills and ability. Their supervision of the game and players, allowed him to grow and mature as a player. As his scores lowered his confidence rose. He immediately recognized how vital the Under Armour Junior Tour on the Shore was to the development of his game as well as every other player.

The friendships and relationships made, throughout the tour, have been a vital resource as he continues to develop as both a person and golfer.

The exposure and level of competition was critical to his development and allowed coaches to see his level of play against higher competition.

Ultimately, he was offered a full athletic scholarship to the University of Maryland Eastern Shore where he will play golf and has been accepted into the PGA Golf Management Program. He credits the Under Armour Junior Tour on The Shore for allowing him to develop and making this opportunity available to him. He signed his National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Maryland Eastern Shore on February 7, 2020

Moving forward, he has already registered for the Under Armour Junior Tour which begins in April. He is excited to see the friends he has made with the staff and players from last year while competing at the highest level. With the new National Championship at Disney World in play for the top 12 golfers, he is focused and determined to be one of the players representing the Maryland Eastern Shore team in July at Disney World in Orlando Florida.

Tour, he will immediately turn his full attention to the University of Maryland Eastern Shore golf team and the PGA Golf Management Program as he enters in the fall alongside fellow UA Junior Tour on The Shore player Sam Turner.



"THE TEE" MUST READ OP ED

Currently there is much talk by the governing bodies of golf about rolling back distances that the ball can travel or clubs can hit the ball. The claim is that traditional golf courses are being over powered by the current equipment rendering the courses helpless. The design of the courses wasn't intended for 300-350 yard drives. These same bodies (the USGA and R & A) were the ones that granted the gradual improvements to take place every year. The expansion and redesign of most courses is either too costly or not possible in many cases due to real estate parameters. I offer a very simple solution. Just take away the tee. Yes, the wooden peg you put the ball on to start each hole. Get rid of it. Make professional players hit it of the deck. Don't let them kick up the turf like Laura Davies. Just make them hit it off the ground with zero advantage. This will bring all those hazards back in play. Be tough to carry it over that bunker sitting at 265 yards when you don't have it on a tee. It's also tougher to keep the ball in the fairway without a tee. **Problem solved.** There is no need to redesign all the courses, no need put restrictions on clubs or golf balls. Simply take away the most inexpensive, under appreciated tool in every tour players bag, the tee. I am only suggesting this for the premier tour players, let the amateurs keep using the tee. We see things like this done in every sport. When you start playing baseball they put the ball on a tee, then you grow and play without a tee but an aluminum bat. When you make it to the big leagues you use a wooden bat. It's the same progression. But let's let all these all knowing governing bodies that have "protected" the integrity of the game come up with a solution. I will bet that it will be at a high price tag. The cost to implement the program, ZERO. But I've been told many times that I cloud the issue with logic.



Go Deep!

One of the scariest shots in golf, doesn't have to be. You've got a green-side bunker shot with water on the other side of the green. What's the worst thing that can happen? Obviously thinning the shot right over the green and into to water, and with all your buddies watching. So, with a bit of fear and apprehension you play the shot and do just that.


This shot doesn't have to be so fearful because it's one of the few shots in golf that give you plenty of room for error. Hitting the shot thin or clean means you didn't let the sand push the ball out. You picked it clean because the hesitation or apprehension can cause you to tense up and pull your arms in. When your ball is resting on the sand, our goal is to swing so that the clubhead enters the sand on a downward path, striking the sand before the ball. As the clubhead enters the sand with downward force, the loft pushes the sand and ball up and forward. The good news is, you can go as deep as you want, ensuring that you hit the sand first and not the ball. There is plenty of room for variations of depth when playing bunker shots.

You have just a couple things to consider when going deep. First, because you are going deep, there is more

sand to deal with so you have to commit to finishing the shot. You may feel more resistance at the bottom. Committing to finishing with the handle higher will help you get through the resistance. If there isn't much sand below the ball. It feels firm below a very thin layer of sand, choose a pitching wedge. The pitching wedge has a dig sole instead of a bounce sole. Open the wedge slightly and using less force, strike down into the sand at a spot slightly closer to the ball than normal. Again, commit to finishing with the handle higher. Use less force because there is less sand to dissipate the energy. While the condition may be firm, the dig sole in the pitching wedge will still drive down into the sand instead of bouncing into the ball. Note, always look at the spot where you want the club to enter the sand, not at the ball. You will tend to hit what you are looking at.

As with any shot you must practice it to get more comfortable and gain distance control. Entering the bunker with the idea of going deep, at least you'll get the ball out safely.

Now you can go into the bunker and impress your buddies with your fearlessness!





GROUNDFORCE PRODUCTION IS NOT A NEW DISCOVERY.

It has been studied for decades in many sports, but recently has emerged as a new "secret" in golf. "Old School" golf recognized effective, repeatable and powerful golf swings require a firm foundation.

The notion that you "SWING WITH YOUR FEET" was especially correct for the time, when wind and weather, tweed Norfolk jackets and thick woolen sweaters restricted the capacity for upper body coiling, without good footwork. To provide balance on the undulating and frequently wet links land, players added spikes to shoes. The quest was on to find the best combination of technique and shoes to acquire, balance, stability, flexibility and traction to create the foundation for power. Enter the specialized golf shoe.

For most of the 20th century golf shoe design was similar to dress shoes, leather, with heels, and screw in metal spikes. The best were comfortable, but very heavy compared to the modern "ATHLETIC SPIKE-LESS SHOE". Good shoes are as important as good grips to achieve your best chance to play well. It is helpful to know how the shoe design effects your personal swing requirements.

THERE IS A CONTINUUM OF SHOE DESIGN. Some emphasize stability and motion control. Others focus on minimizing impediments to proper foot movement. The stability shoe typically has removable spikes or an aggressive sole pattern, stiffer upper material, tighter and sometimes adjustable heel cups. The fluidity shoe is softer, spike-less, with a flat or contoured sole. The stability shoe gives you the sensation and ability to anchor to the ground. The fluidity designs enhance your ability to feel the weight transfer, as if swinging barefoot.

Matching the shoe style to your swing style is important. If you have a smooth swing, good flexibility and maintain balance without effort, the fluid designs will enhance your natural feel for each swing, likely increasing swing speed. Proprioceptive feedback through your feet is the modern scientific phrase for the capacity to feel how to "swing with your feet". The light molded, flexible shoes enhance this kind of feedback. Consider that the golf swings of Sam Snead and Fred Couples exemplified effortless, elegant, motion. Snead advocated practicing barefoot. Couples was the first to popularize the flat soled, flexible, no spike shoe.

If you are tight, find it difficult to make an unrestricted turn, or struggle with maintaining balance, the stability shoe may be the right choice. Being firmly anchored to the ground is an important contributor to good balance. "Tour power" shoe styles afford players with good flexibility and balance, the traction and stability to maximize power potential. Such design can also help players who need to compensate for physical limitations that restrict range of motion, disrupt balance, and cause power leaks. Anchored footing supports the effort to "wind up the backswing", create torque, and then let it go.

CONNECTING TO THE GROUND IS THE FIRST STEP TO CREATING GROUND FORCE. "Old School" shoes weighed 2 to 3 times more than modern shoes. The simple fact that a heavier shoe contributes to stability is worth noting. Consider practicing while wearing ankle weights. First with weights on both feet, then try just one at a time, lead foot, then trail foot. Doing this will improve your balance, sense of weight distribution and transfer during the swing, to create a firm foundation and power from the ground up.

YOU KNOW THE DRILL



"WIN YOUR NASSAU BY USING 50 CENTS"

Two quarters stacked on each other will make you a better putter. Here is how to do it. Place two quarters on top of each other directly behind your ball. Make a putting stroke, don't hit the quarters. This will encourage you to have an upward stroke on your putt allowing the ball to roll off the face rather that skid. A skidding ball happens when you strike the ball too low on the ball. A skidding ball will hop more often. Stack two quarters behind your ball to see where your putting stroke stacks up.

Now you know the drill!
