THE MOMENT

By Rob McDonald

Often, during a golf tournament telecast, you will here the announcer say that the player must stay in the moment. Usually it's during a major championship where the player has a chance to win it. What is in the moment? In the moment is the ability to be engrossed in the process of the swing, during the swing, letting the results just happen. I don't mean thinking of each technical aspect of the swing, but having a thought process that allows you to create your swing within a rhythm and sequence that is carrying the arms and club away and through to the finish. Striking the ball is a consequence of the motion, not the main focus. Have you ever had a great round going and at the turn, your buddy says "Hey, you're two under on the front!" and then lost the momentum? It's because you came out of the good thought process you were in and started thinking about results. You have to realize that you actually performed at your potential. You fell apart because you changed the way you were thinking that got you to the two under score.

In the moment can be a very fleeting thing. All it takes is

an outside distraction or inside thought in a split second during the swing to pull you out of the moment. So how can you avoid that? By having a solid, consistent pre-shot routine. By setting up the same way every time, you clear your check list so there is no lingering, distracting thought of something not being right. With a clear mind of having the set up be exactly right you are free to concentrate on a swing que involving the rhythm of the swing or the dynamic balance within your feet.

Your good shots have a feeling of ease, or smoothness to them. They take a certain amount of time to create. Let each swing that same amount of time every shot. When you hit a shot like that, that is your successful rhythm that you want to repeat. By focusing on your successful pace and rhythm, you're not allowing the bad thoughts or distractions such as "I hope I get over the water" or "If I par in I can shoot a (pick a number) " to enter your mind. To get comfortable with the pre-shot procedure, be sure to use it on the practice range as well.

TOOLS OF THE TRADE

"THE TAKEAWAY"

In a COVID based year the word "takeaway" or "take out" has become very popular. Takeaway is what our European counterparts call take out but, is also our backswing in golf. A consistent problem I see many golfers experiencing is an aggressive takeaway. They throw that club back like they are trying to hit something above their head. This is usually done by snatching the club back with the dominate hand. I've actually seen shaft flex in many players backswings. Golfers have been preached to about creating club head speed for years. So naturally players have began to violently swing the club back. The club should be a feather, not a hammer. In a game where accuracy and consistency is paramount, please take note of what other weapons of projectiles do during their backswing. For example can you imagine how accurate you would be with a bow and arrow if you pulled the arrow back as quickly as possible? How about a slingshot? If you snatch it back as quickly

as possible would you expect to hit your target? Not a chance. To see evidence of this just watch any tour broadcast. Watch those pros swing with effortless power. It is because they are treating the club like a feather instead of a hammer. They are not "throwing" it back With hopes of crushing the ball. They are turning it back very lightly and letting the club relax or compress near the top of the backswing. They are releasing the power through the ball instead of "at" the ball. You've probably experienced this from time to time when you three quarter easy shot flies the green. Learn how to takeaway the club with ease and you will find effortless power and accuracy.



YOU KNOW THE DRILL

FIX THE "FATS"

Here is an easy drill to help you overcome heavy shots. "Chunks" or "Fat" shots are a result of poor weight transfer usually caused by excessive grip pressure and/or poor weight transfer. Place a tee about a club head length behind the ball while practicing. The tee will provide a good visual while swinging to help you strike the ball first and cause the divot to happen after the ball, which is desirable. Try this at the range and you'll be making sweet spot contact.



Jay Williams has lived a golfing life that has now led him to be the new teaching pro at Eastern Shore Yacht and Country Club.

Growing up in Virginia Beach, he tagged along with his father on weekend golf outings before he was old enough to swing a club, later hitting from the forward tees.

When he was old enough to play on his own, his father would drop him off on summer days at Kempsville Meadows Country Club, where he was given the choice of swimming in the pool or playing golf. "I think I went swimming once and spent all the other days playing golf. It was a great place to grow up," recalled Williams, now 66.

Williams loved baseball too and played on a Little League team with twin brothers Curtis and Allan Strange. That trio would later help lead Princess Anne High School to back-to-back state golf titles in 1971 and 1972. "Allan was as good a golfer as Curtis," said Williams, "but Curtis was more determined and concentrated on golf. Allan was also the quarterback of the football team."

Of course, most golfers know Curtis Strange went on to become an NCAA golf champion at Wake Forest and then had a Hall of Fame pro in a career that included back-toback U.S. Open titles.

Williams earned a partial golf scholarship to the University of Maryland, where he received a degree in communications. His father was a production manager at WTAR-TV, now WTKR, but Williams felt pulled to golf, and with his father's blessing, competed on the Mid-Atlantic Tour and the Florida Mini Tour before pursuing a career as a teaching professional, attending three levels of PGA Business School.

My father and I were like best friends, and he had a huge influence on my tife, supporting me in whatever I chose to do, said Williams.

Starting as an assistant golf professional, he spent time at a number of Virginia Beach golf courses, including Stumpy Lake, Red Wing and Bow Creek before becoming head professional at his home course, now Kempsville Greens Municipal Course. One of his favorite playing partners in the Tidewater area was the legendary Chandler Harper, winner of the 1950 PGA who won the Virginia State Open a record nine times and spent his entire life in the Portsmouth area.

More recently, Williams was an associate teaching professional at Cypress Point Golf Club in Virginia Beach. About a year ago, he moved to Harborton because he liked the slower pace of the Eastern Shore. When an opening came up at Eastern Shore Yacht and Country Club for a teaching golf professional, he applied and got the job.

"I feel like I have a Luck Dragon following me around," said Williams. "I love teaching the fundamentals of golf to anyone from young kids to seniors. I feel like I have patience — which golf teaches you — to work with golfers of all skills."

Williams said he works from the feet up, emphasizing balance as the key to a golf swing. "I've seen it all when it comes to swings, but you need balance to find a swing that works for you. I try to fix two or three things with one tip," added Williams.



YOUR PATH TO

RICHARD ROBINSON INSTRUCTOR THE ORIGINAL GOLF SCHOOL

IN DAYS OF OLD, MAINTAINING CONSISTENT GREEN SPEED AND SMOOTHNESS FROM DAY TO DAY, EVEN FROM HOLE TO HOLE, WAS DIFFICULT.

To meet the challenge putters were designed with more loft and players tended to exhibit a distinct tap at impact. A common putting image was to "tap a tack in the back of the ball". Today, the emphasis is on a smooth even tempo to the stroke and roll the ball into the hole. Not only is this evident watching top players, but also in hearing their description of putting. "I rolled the ball well today". However, the phrase "tap in" persists referring to short putts, and it deserves consideration in the right circumstance.

Two of the greatest putters of all time (with Eastern Shore connections) Bill Casper (Ocean Pines) and Gary Player (River Run) were proponents of the the "pop" or "tap" stroke. Their techniques sustained excellence during the transition from slow and bumpy, to fast and smooth green conditions. Brandt Snedekar, is a top current player who "taps" his putts. Is this style worth trying?

There are advantages. A variety shot techniques for pitches and chips, is widely encouraged. The notion of having "special" putting strokes is not. Yet, putts from under 4 feet, from 4 to 10, and longer are different "shots".

THE SHORT PUTT IS THE SCORE MAKER OR BREAKER.

The "tap" is a short precise putt. The putter head moves just two or three inches back and returns to the ball with little follow through. It is a "quick" stroke because the putter moves a short distance, but keep it smooth do not rush it. There is no time or distance to make a mistake. No tension trying to keep still. No time to second guess the line as you execute the putt. No distance to open or close the putter alignment during the stroke. Distance control and target focus, just trust you natural sense as if throwing a ball. You will only mess up the distance if you think about it.

FOR LONGER PUTTS THE SMOOTH EVEN PACED STROKE IS BETTER.

But, a basic principle applies to both long and short putts, the length of the backswing controls distance. In close, you do not need much backswing length and the notion of "tapping the ball" is just insurance against slowing the stroke through impact. Know that if you mistakenly hit a 4 foot putt 5 feet, if it hits the cup, it will drop. Your natural sense of effort will be good enough to control distance on short putts, well within the margin of error. Roll the ball into the hole, not deliberately past it, but be confident if you go a little past you will still make the putt.

The calculation of par includes 2 putts per hole. You may achieve this more often by using 2 putting a styles and just tapping in the short ones. Trust your instincts and remember every putt that goes in is good!
